

their vehicles collided around 3:30 p.m. on U.S. Highway 321 at the intersection of State Highway 95. Reports indicate Autumn M. McGinley,



According to the affidavit filed by Detective

Jack Fine, LCPD, on November 19th, 2010, at approximately 1:45 p.m., Mr. Plemons entered the El Cantarita's Mexican Restaurant, 455 Highway 321 in Lenoir City with a bag of Star Burst Candy hanging out of his back pocket. Mr. Plemons waived at a woman who is employed at the restaurant. After waving at the worker, Mr. Plemons picked up a North Western coin operated gum ball and toy machine and said, "I'm going to fill it up," then ran out of the store, got into a white Infinity

and left the parking lot, going north on Highway 321.

Investigation revealed Plemons went to school with the worker he interacted with and she identified him to police after the heist.

The total value of the machine and contents was \$650.

Deputy Charles Butler, LCSO made the arrest Thursday.




