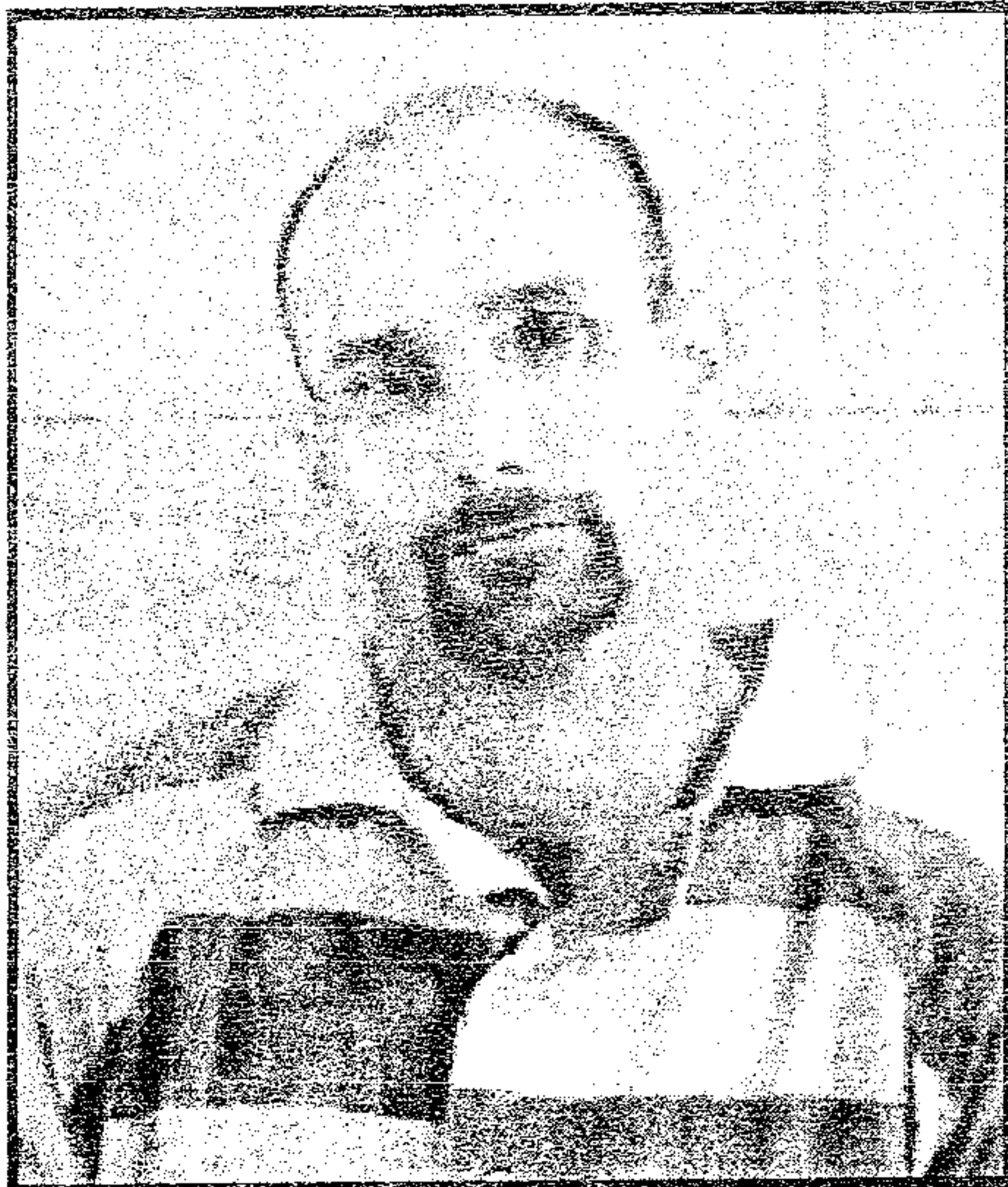
## Meth cooker now charged with vandalism

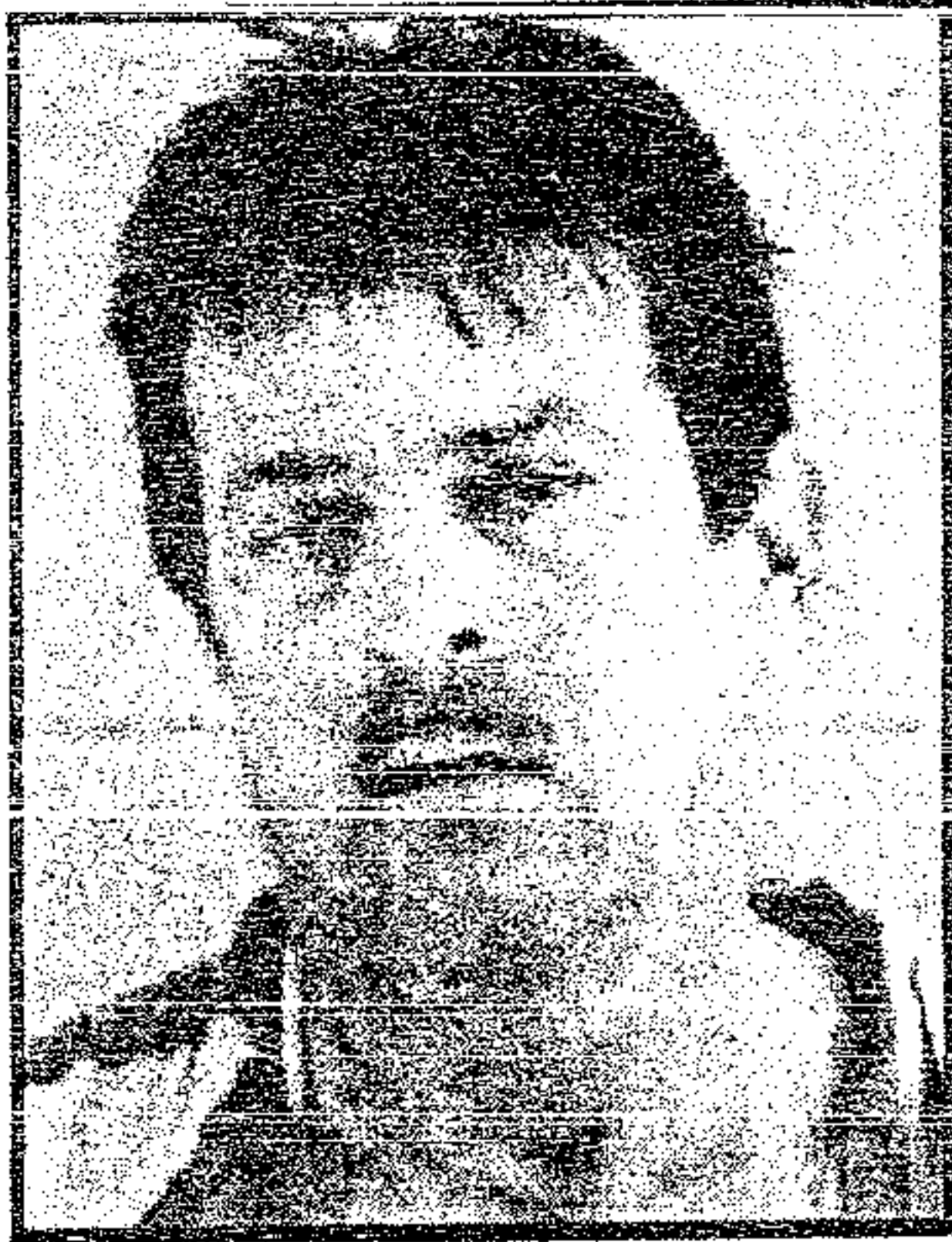

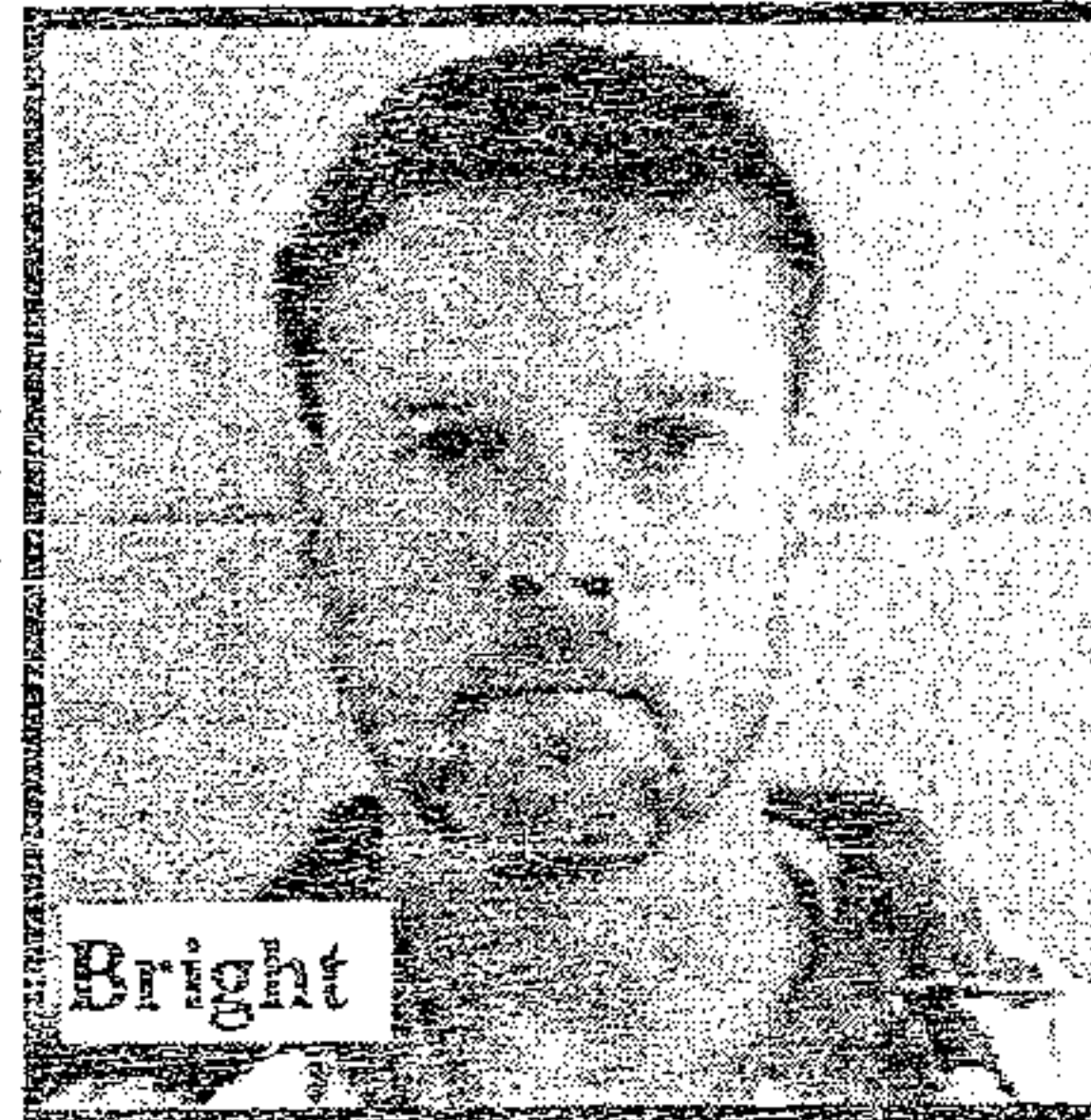
A dispute amongst family members lead the arrest of a Loudon man after he reportedly refused to calm down and was screaming and cursing outside despite being warned several times to desist.

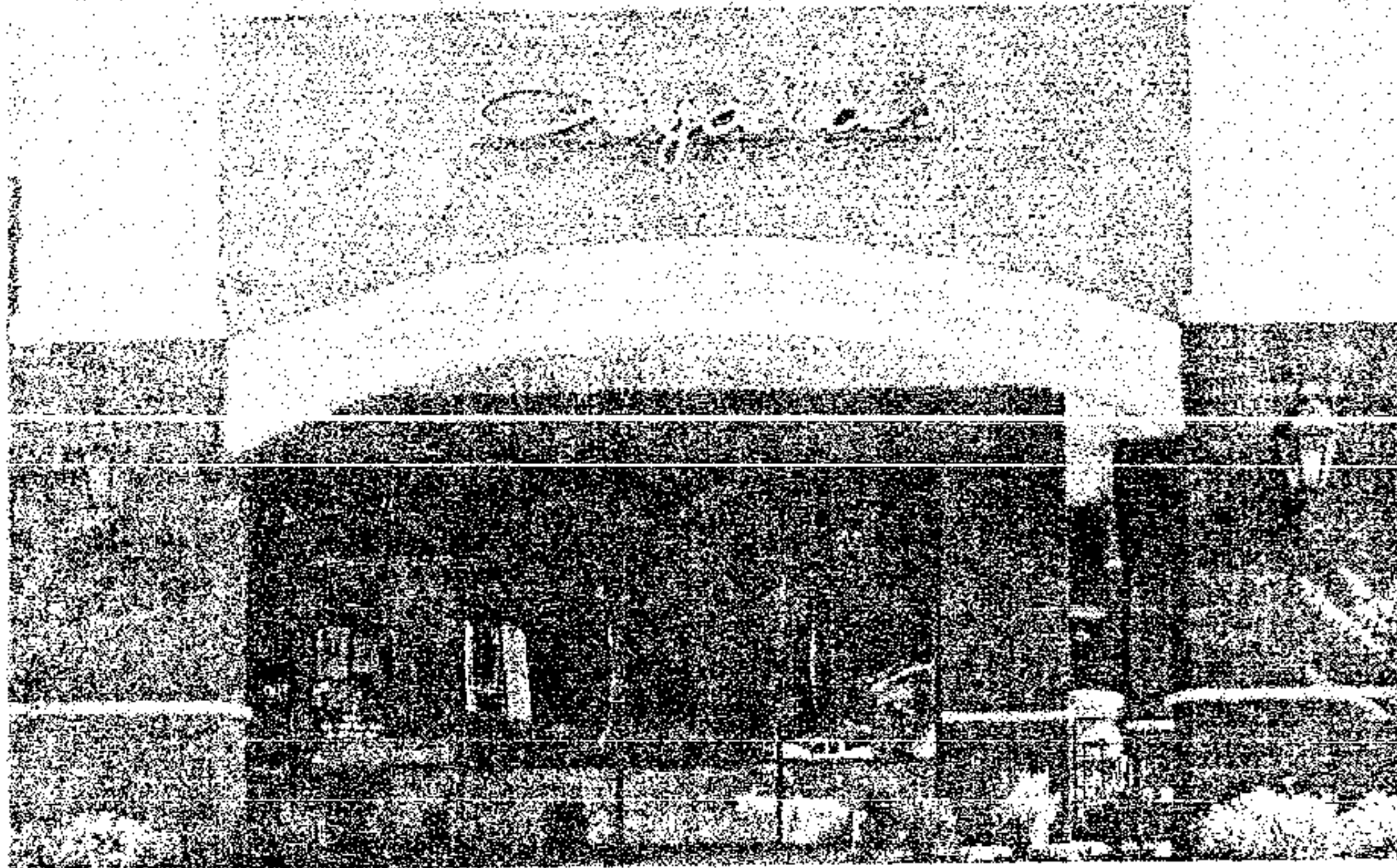

caused damages totaling over \$3500.

Further investigation revealed the damages happened when Coker drove his vehicle into the field while fleeing

from law enforcement with an active mobile meth lab in his possession.

Coker eventually bailed from the vehicle and ran on foot before

being apprehended and charged with manufacturing meth, felony evading arrest, reckless endangerment, felony possession of drug paraphernalia,

misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia and driving on suspended license

Investigator Russell charged Coker with the vandalism Wednesday.

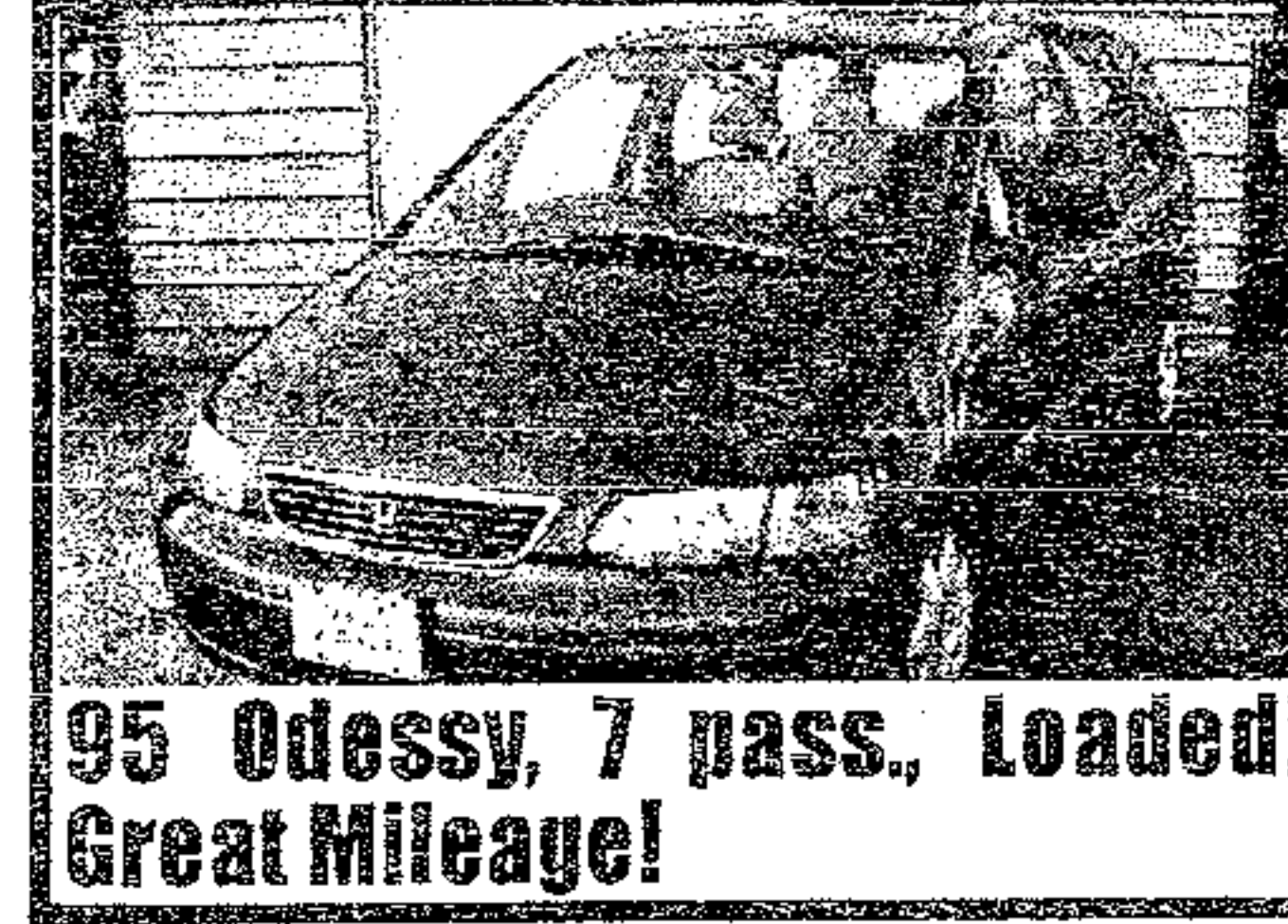
