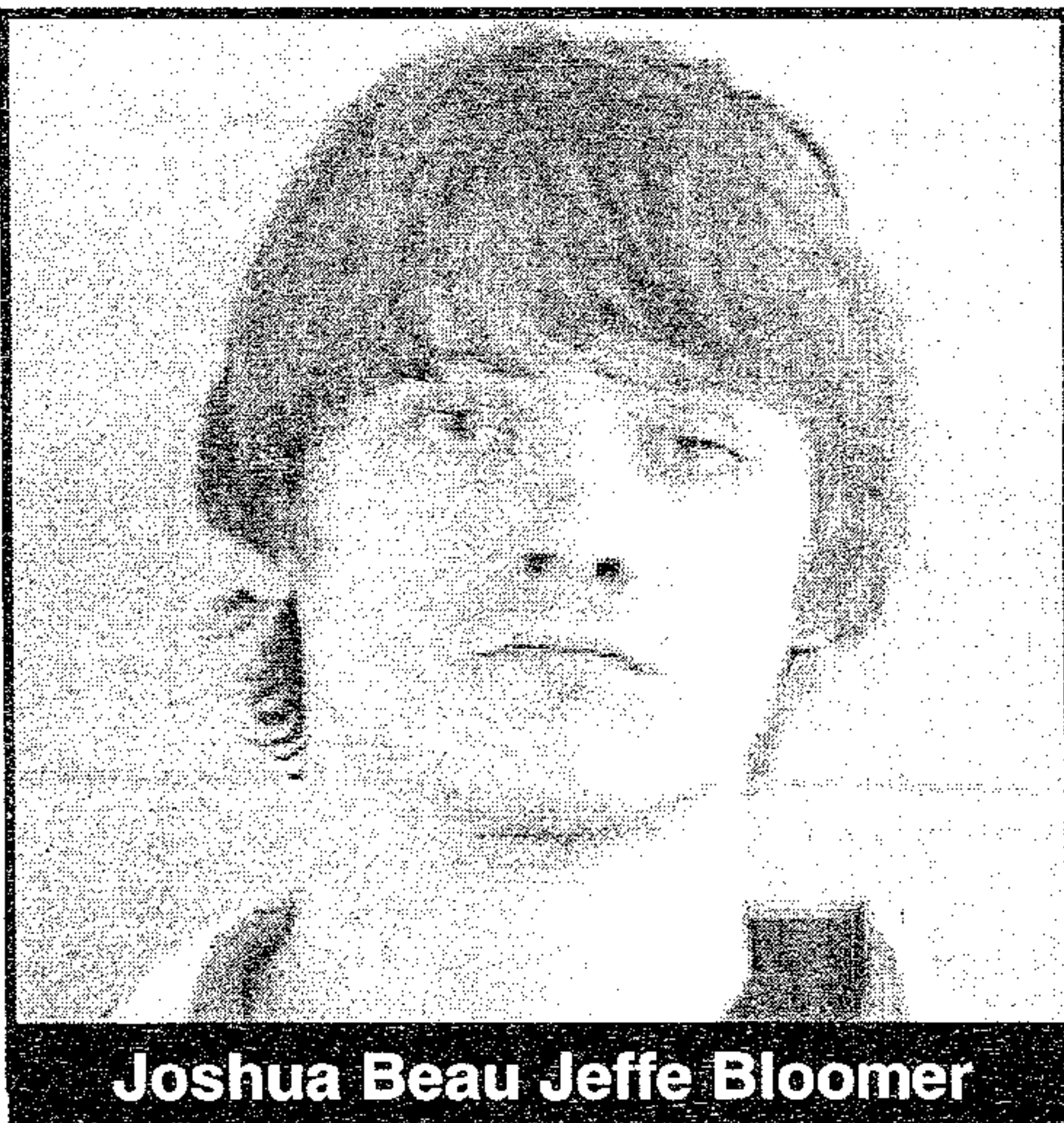

## LPD charges alleged thieves just hours after auto burglaries committed

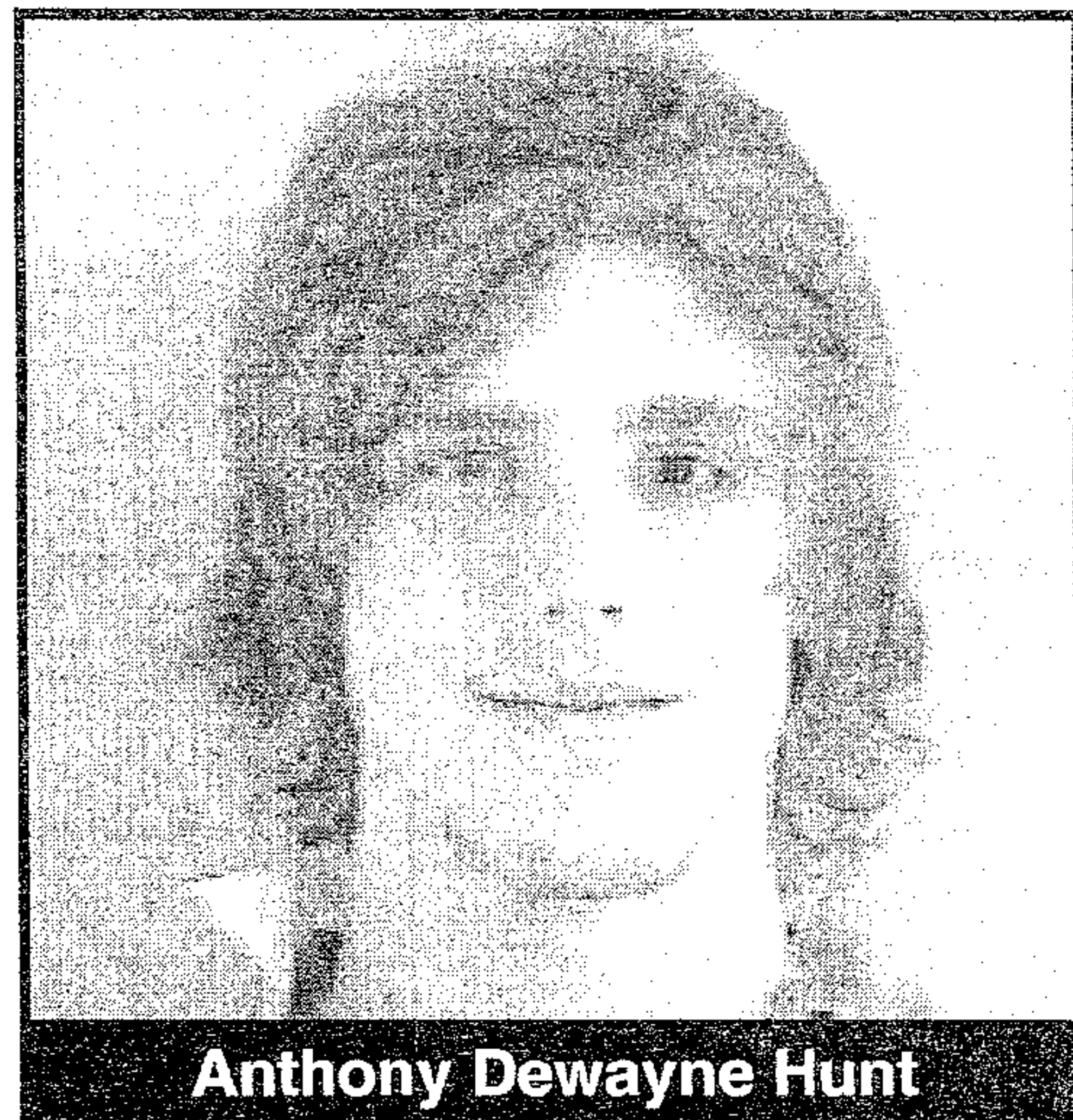
LPD Sgt. R.S. Newman went to a neighboring county jail to retrieve two young Cleveland men who are accused of entering numerous vehicles and stealing items from at least three of them just hours earlier at various locations in the City of Loudon.

Joshua Beau Jeffe Bloomer, 20, Fairhill Drive, and Anthony Dewayne Hunt, 18, Trunk Street, were charged Sunday with three counts of burglary of auto and two counts theft under \$500.

Sgt. R.S. Newman, LCPD; on March 7th, 2010, in the early morning hours, Mr. Bloomer and Mr. Hunt entered a 2004 Nissan XTR located at a residence in Willington Manor, Loudon, without the consent of the owner. While inside the vehicle, they took without permission a gift card valued at \$25 with intent to deprive the owner of her property.

The pair then entered a 2004 Pontiac Vibe located at a residence on Hill Vale in Loudon where they took two credit cards with the intent to deprive the owner of his property. They also entered a 2005

Ford Explorer on the same property.

Records indicate Bloomer and Hunt entered several vehicles in the neighborhood looking for cash and valuables. Sgt. R.S. Newman arrested both men at the McMinn County Justice Center on Sunday, March 7th, 2010, at 9:00 AM.

According to records, Sunday, around 3:18 AM, Sgt. Joe Foster, LCPD received a call from a clerk at the Pilot advising a shoplifter was in the store. Upon arrival the clerk stated the shoplifter got out of a red truck with a ladder on it.

Sgt. Foster stopped a red truck with a ladder on it on West Broadway. While investigating, the officer stated in his report, he could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage

about Mr. Velasquez's breath and person.

Velasquez was very unsteady on his feet and could not perform any field sobriety tasks, nor could he show a drivers license from any state. Sgt. Foster made the arrest.

Marvin Daniel Velasquez, 28, homeless was a passenger in the red truck and was charged with public intoxication. He had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about his breath and body, slurred speech, red bloodshot eyes and was unsteady on his feet. Patrolman Mark Maxwell, LCPD made the arrest.

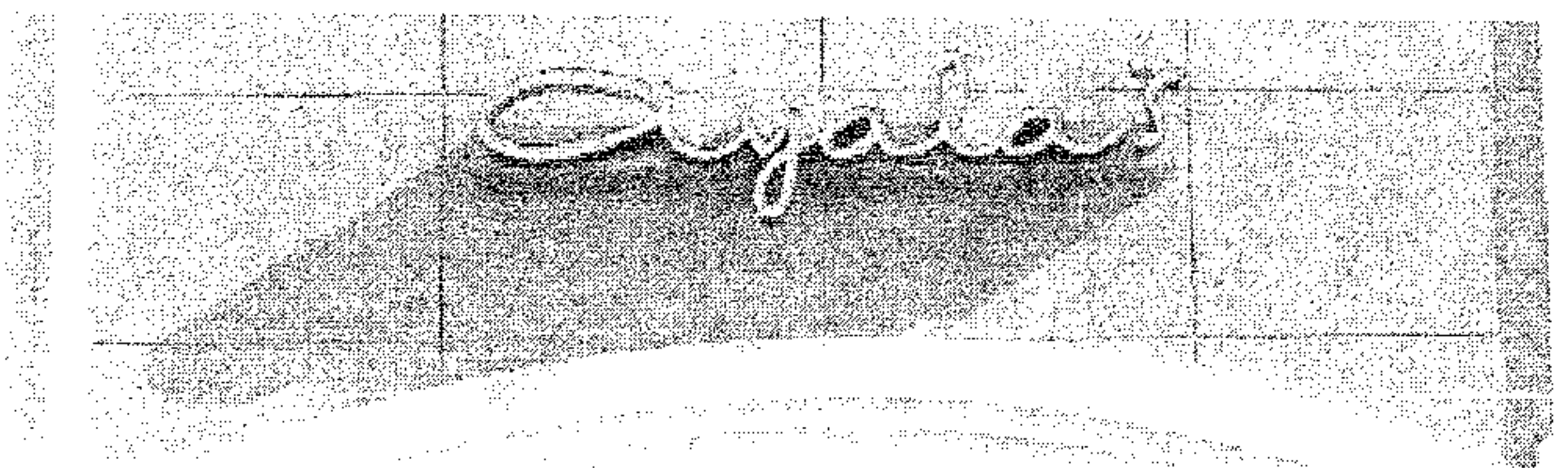

## Police Beat
