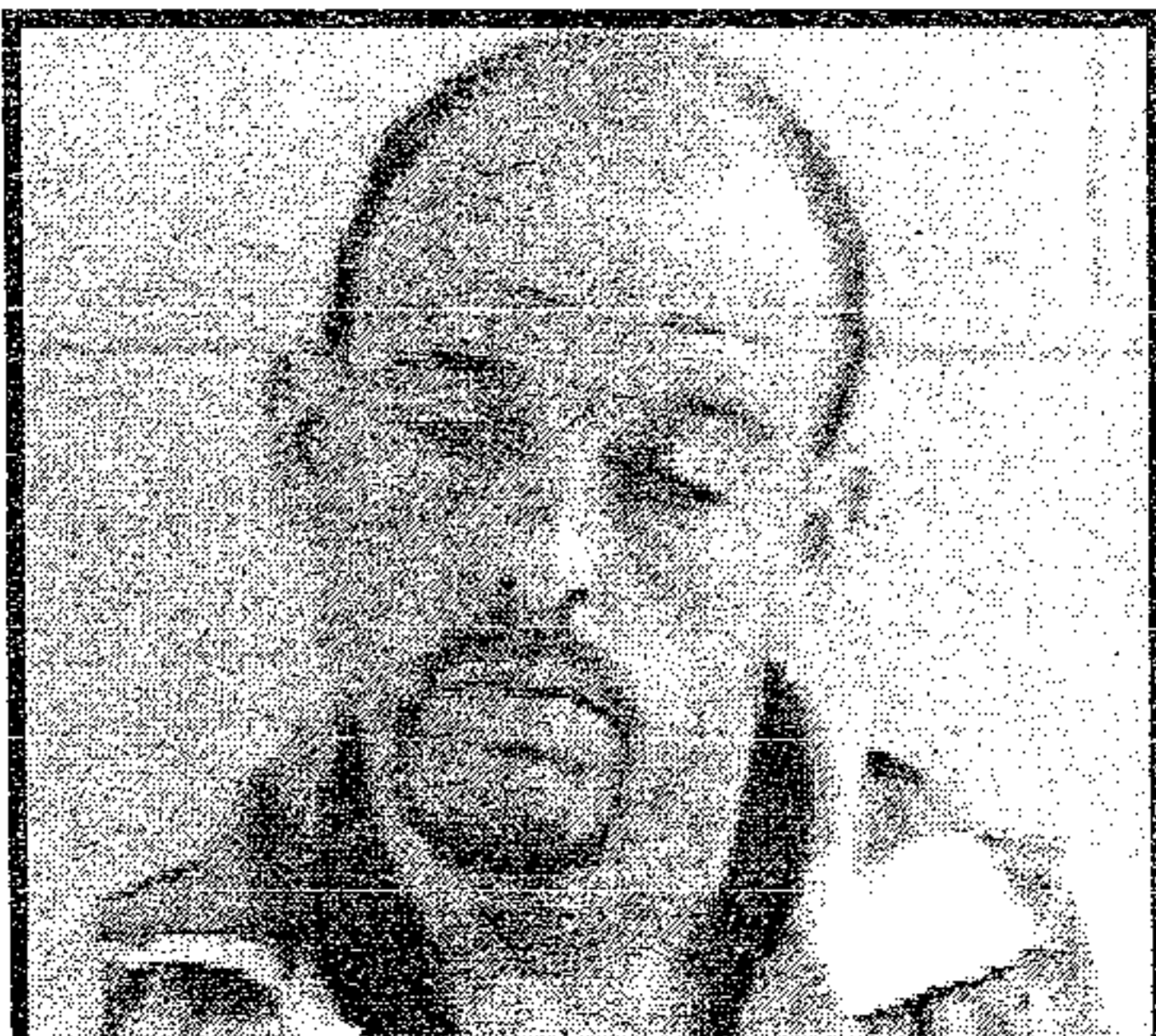

on suspended license, possession of schedule II (methamphetamine), possession of drug paraphernalia, and unlawful possession of a weapon.

According to records, Deputy Rondel Branam, LCSO observed a maroon Chevy Cavalier traveling east on Highway 321 with two dates on the license plate. A check of the plate through NCIC revealed the plates were expired as of June 2010.

The deputy stopped the Cavalier at Unitia Road. The driver, Mr. Miller was identified by his social security card. A check of his social through NCIC showed his license were suspended for failure to satisfy a citation.

Deputy Branam asked Miller to step out of his vehicle so he could speak with him and Miller brought a cup of coffee out with him and placed it on the trunk. Mr. Miller was taken into custody for driving on suspended. Before returning the cup of coffee to the Cavalier, Deputy Branam looked inside the cup and saw a black bag with a silver rope inside. He checked the contents of the bag and found two syringes and two clear vials with a white crystal-like sub-

stance inside.

The contents of the vials were field tested by Corporal Chad Estes, LCSO and the contents tested positive as methamphetamine, weighing not less than half a gram and not more than two grams. A search of the vehicle produced a large fixed blade knife with a black handle from underneath the driver's seat with the handle exposed. The blade of the knife measured approximately nine inches.

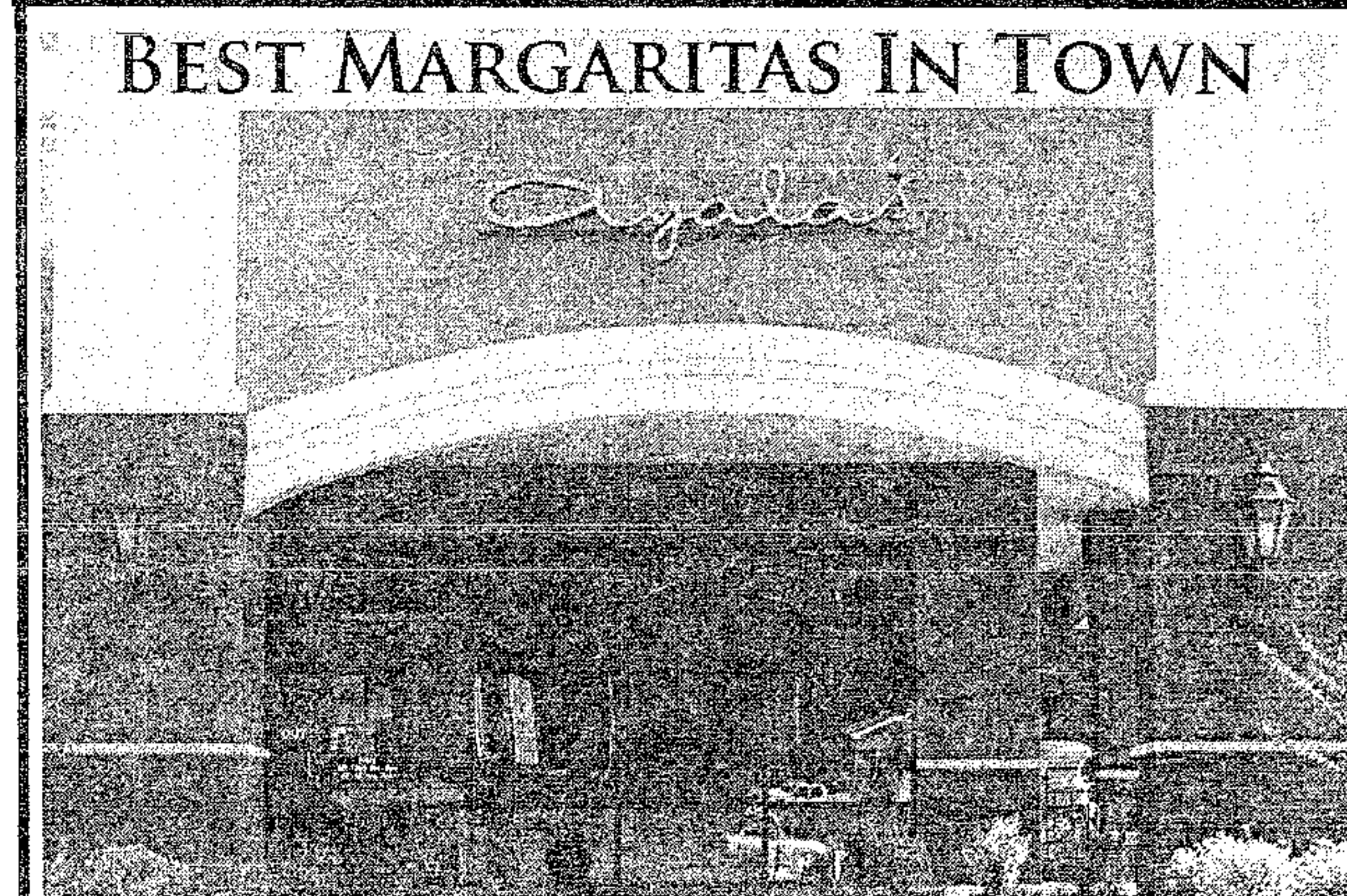

The child was identified as being only 9 months old. Ms. Lynn's actions placed her child's health and welfare in imminent danger.
