## Man tazed at Ruby Tuesday after injuring LCPD officer, assailing two others

Matthew Blake Miller of Philadelphia is shown (photo right) in the back of a patrol unit after allegedly injuring a Lenoir City Police officer and assailing a witness when he went to Ruby Tuesday to confront his wife after a domestic dispute that reportedly occurred earlier in the day.

Miller, 28, of Sewell Road was charged with domestic assault, resisting arrest, assaulting an officer and vandalism under \$500 after he went to the Highway 321, Lenoir City restaurant around 8:45 PM, Saturday, where his wife is employed.

Records indicate the female hid in a closet at the business and later told police Miller had punched her in the face already, earlier that day.

Officer Jason Felts, LCPD responded to the call and found Miller involved in an alteration with another man who witnessed



the Lenoir City Police Department and the Loudon County Sheriff's Office.




