
Armed & intoxicated, driver overturns | Man "bites the hand" fully loaded dump truck (see DUI in a Dump Truck pg. 3) that feeds him





charge and converted non-photo driver licenses into photo driver licenses for voters at no charge. Driver service centers in 15 counties were open on the first Saturday of November and will be open on the first Saturday of each month

through March 2012 for voter photo ID issuance. The centers will operate during normal business hours, from 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. for voter photo

IDs only. No other business will be conducted in the centers on Saturdays.


The next Saturday opening for voter photo ID issuance is on December 3, 2011.

Driver service centers will be open on the first Saturday of the month in the following counties: Shelby (East Shelby Dr. and Summer Ave.), Davidson (Centennial Blvd. and Hart Lane), Hamilton (both locations), Knox (both locations), Sullivan, Sumner, Rutherford, Washington, Williamson, Montgomery, Blount, Bradley, Putnam, Greene, and Carter. The centers were chosen based on the counties with the highest number of registered voters who hold nonphoto driver licenses.

Under a new state law, starting in 2012 voters will have to show a state or federal issued photo ID to cast a ballot at the polls in Tennessee. As of October 30, the Department of Safety and Homeland Security had issued 3,071 photo IDs for voting purposes. (This includes original photo IDs and non-photo driver license conversions.)

To minimize the possibility of wait times during Saturday hours, groups or organizations planning to make a group visit to a driver service center are encouraged to schedule an appointment by calling Linda Cone at 731-225-0924 or Wanda Adams at 615-251-5309.


