

The woman reportedly said Stevens began getting aggravated with her and made threats to hurt her, so hiss brother stepped between them and Stevens began fighting with him.


When the officer arrived on the scene, the brothers were no longer fighting, but Stevens' knuckles were skinned from fighting the other man.

#### Buttermilk Pound Cake -

Yield: 12 servings 1/2 lb. (2 sticks) unsalted local butter, softened 2 C sugar 4 eggs

1 tsp pure lemon extract I tsp pure vanilla extract 3 C all-purpose flour

1/2 teaspoon baking powder 1/2 tsp baking soda

1/4 tsp salt 1 C local buttermilk Preheat the oven to 325°F. Lightly grease and flour a 12-cup Bundt pan and set aside.

In the bowl of an electric mixer, beat the butter at medium speed until creamy, around 2 minutes. Gradually add the sugar, beating 5 minutes.

Add the eggs, 1 at a time, beating just until the yellow disappears, Stir in the lemon extract and vanilla extract.

In a separate bowl, combine the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Add to the butter mixture alternately with the buttermilk, beginning and ending with the flour mixture. Beat on low speed just until blended. Transfer the batter to the prepared pan.

Bake I hour and 5 minutes or until a tester inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool in the pan 10 minutes on a wire rack. Remove and cool completely on a wire rack before slicing and serv-




