Edward William Crandall was sentenced to an effective sentence of 44 years to serve in prison for the rape of his two year old son. Crandall was convicted after a day-long jury trial in Loudon County Criminal Court on September 20th of this year on a three count indictment that included charges of Aggravated Child Rape (a Class A Felony), Especially Aggravated Sexual Exploitation of a Minor (a Class B Felony), and Aggravated Sexual Exploitation of a Minor (a Class D Felony). 
Authorities had been tipped to the possibility of child porn images being downloaded to a computer at an address where Crandall was liv-

ing in a camper near the residence of his mother and grandparents. The search led to the discovery of a media card from a camera containing an image of Crandall raping his son. Upon initial Crandall questioning admitted to the sex act involving his son, but at trial tried to claim that the adult in the partial image was not Crandall, but possibly someone else.

At sentencing the 9th eral's Office argued for the maximum possible penalty. Judge E. Eugene dall, who did not have a prior criminal record, to 40 years on the child

rape (class A Felony) charge and 8 years on the Class B Felony charge and ordered that the two sentences run concurrent with one another. On the third count (class D Felony) the judge sentenced Crandall to four years and ran that consecutive with the 40 year sentence for an effective sentence of 44 years. Under Tennessee sentencing law the 40 year sentence had to be served 100% and the fi-District Attorney Gen- nal four year portion of the total sentence has to be served at a minimum of 30%. The maximum Eblen sentencéd Cran- that Crandall could have received would have been 60 years on the child rape charge.


