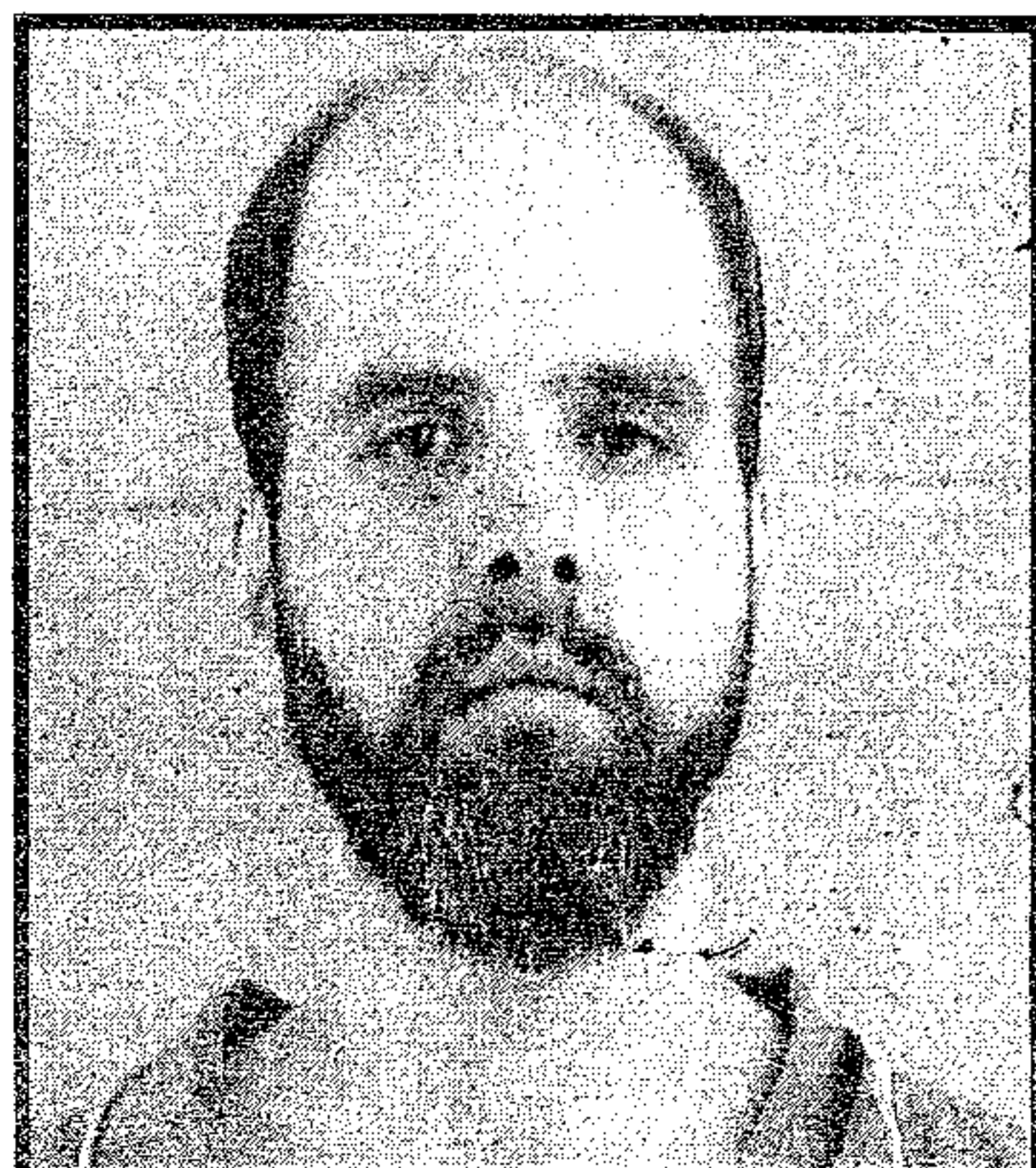

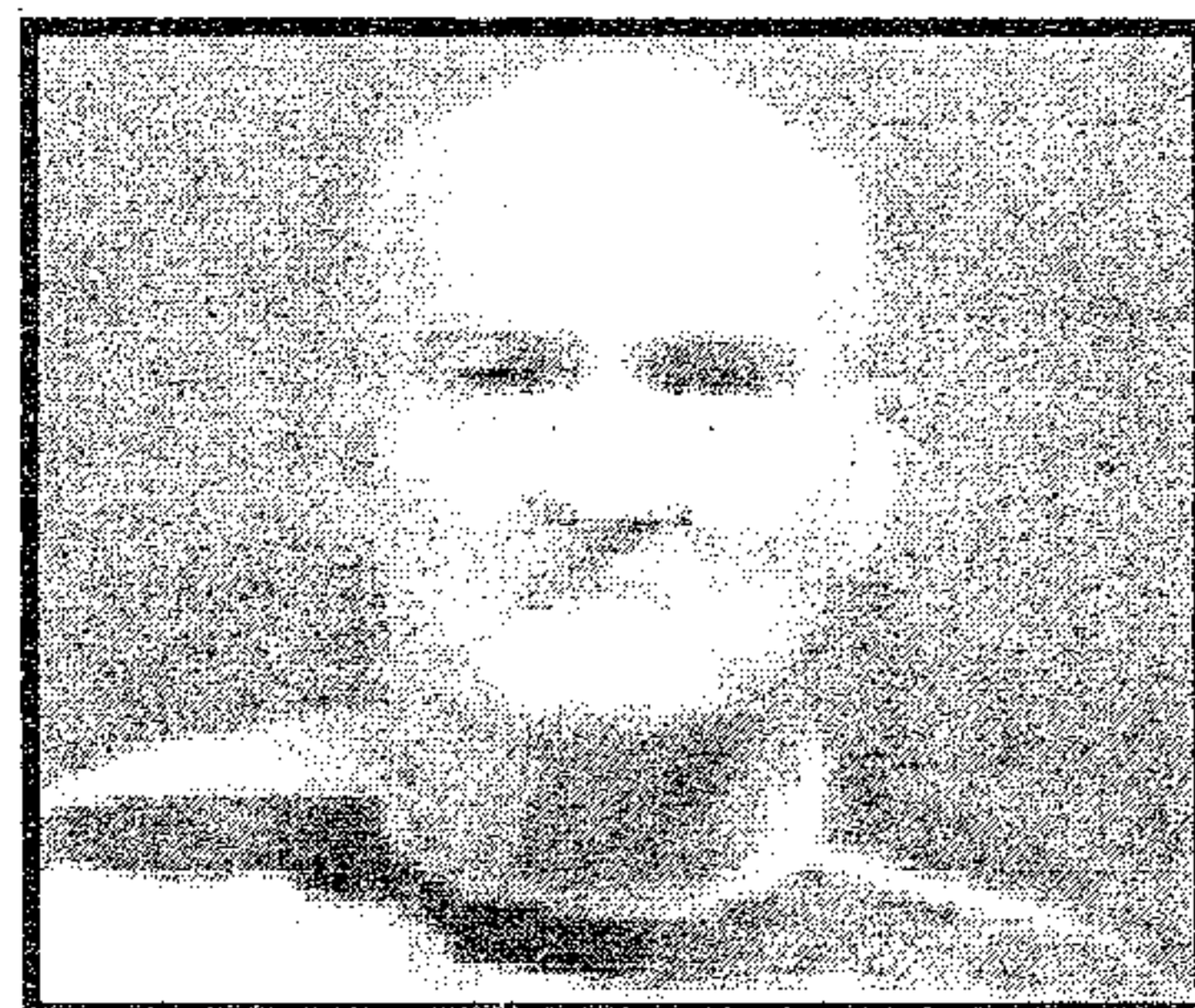

## LC Man Arrested for Alleged Threatening Calls to Virginia Congressman

Glendon Swift, 62, of Lenoir City, Tenn., was arrested late yesterday for allegedly making threats against the family of Rep. Eric Cantor, R-Va. Neil H. MacBride, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia, and Michael F. A. Morehart, Special Agent in Charge of the FBI's Richmond Field Office, made the announcement.

"Threatening to harm the family of a public official is a very serious charge, and we

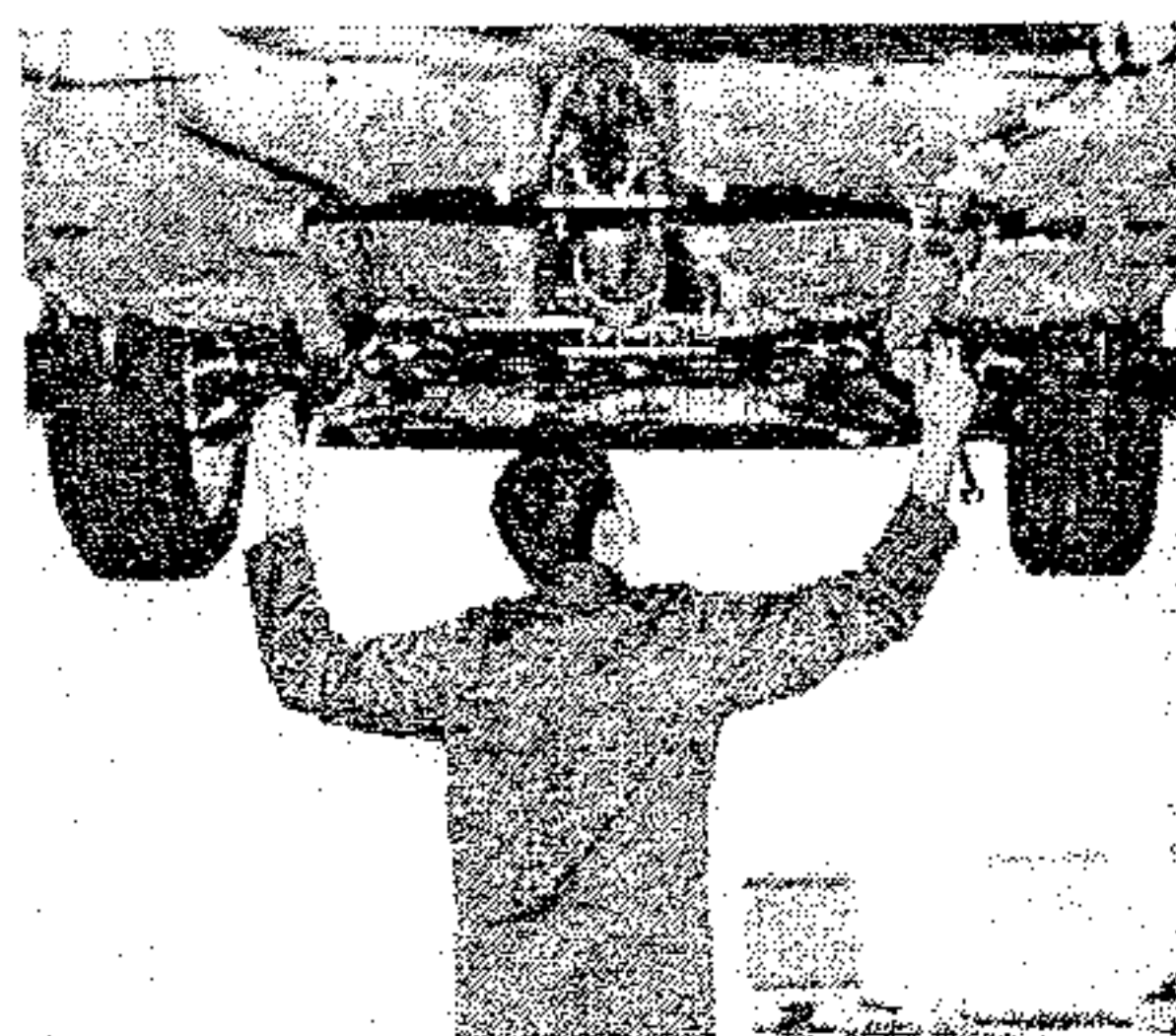

Many people may not recall the exact date but can describe in detail what it was like to be saved. When God saves someone He immedi-

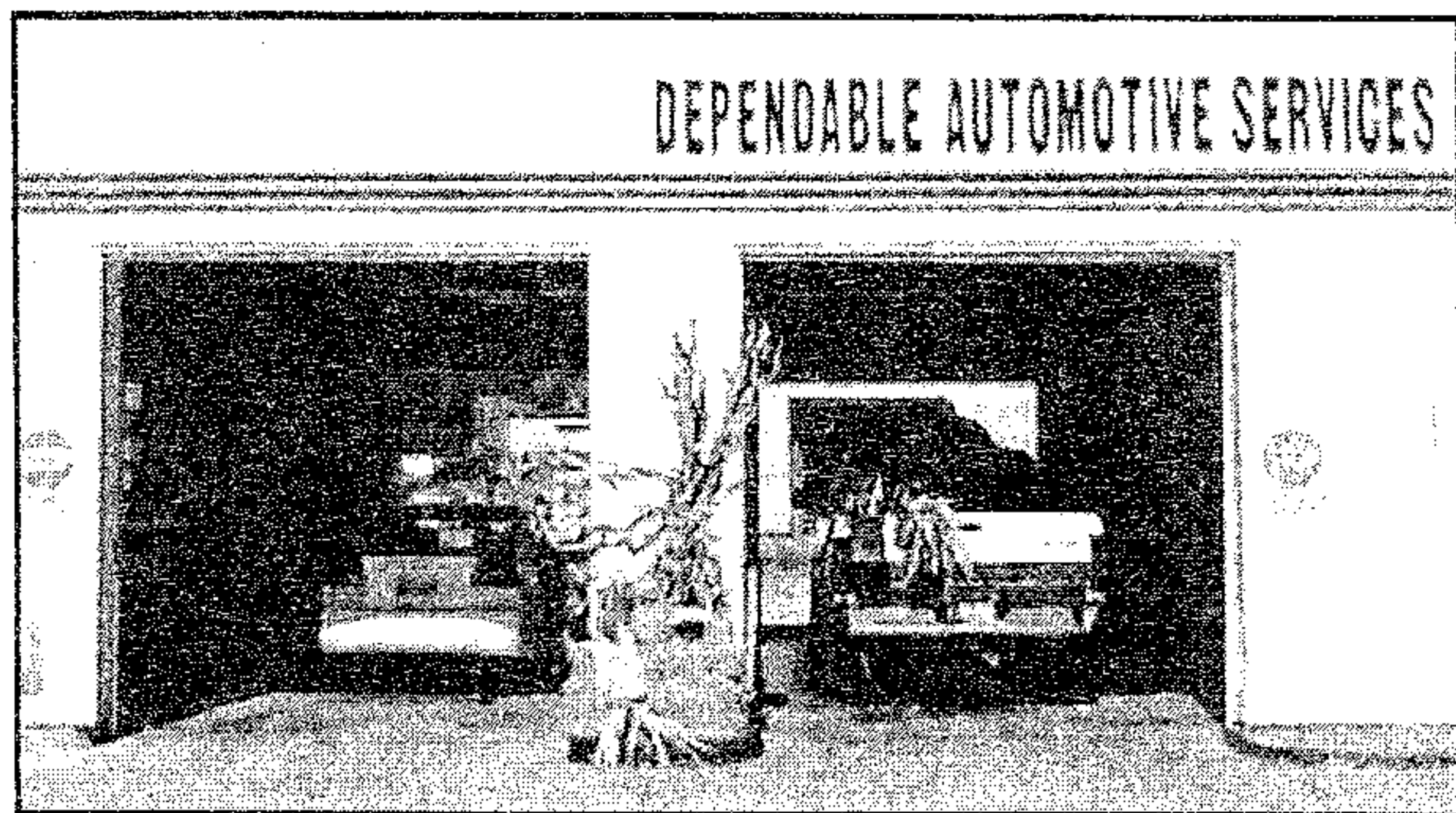

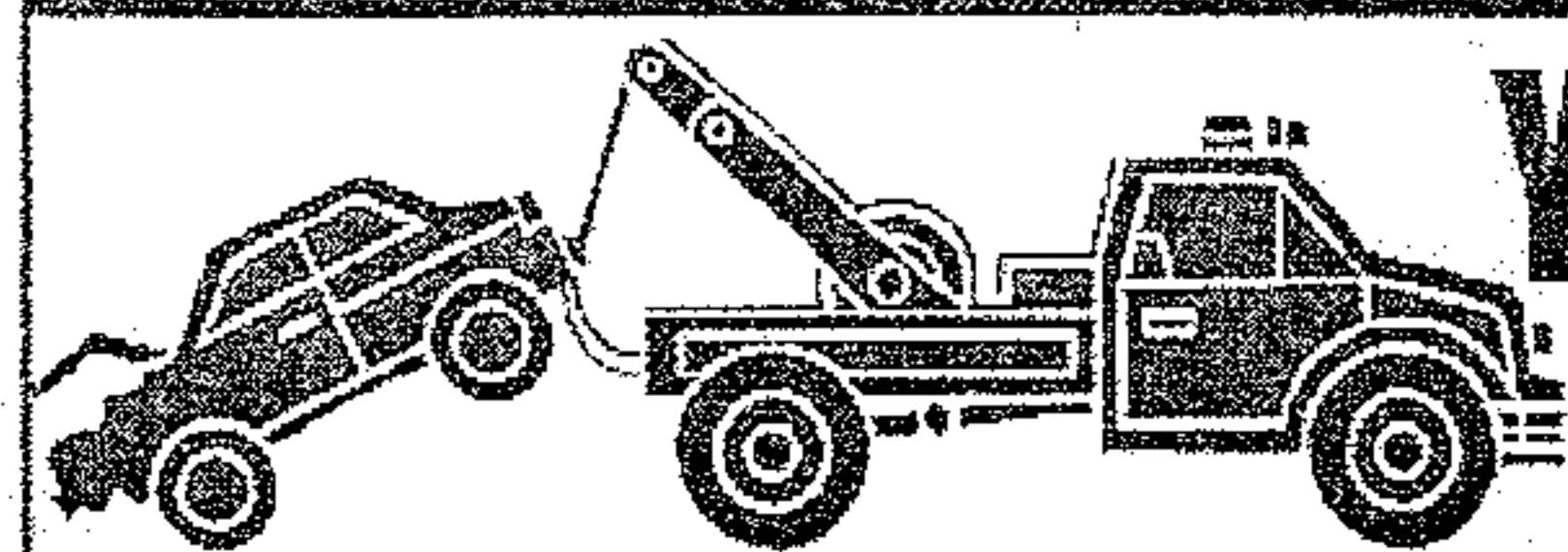

edly violating the conditions of his probation even though man tried everything in his power to resist, including sitting on the ground and laying stiff-legged in the patrol car.

John Allen Sentell, 34, of Simpson Road, Lenoir City was charged with violation of probation and resisting arrest.

According to the report, Deputy Mickey Patterson, LCSO responded to ETHRA Probation Office to a report that John Sentell was at the office and the deputy had an active warrant for violation of probation. The deputy arrived at the ETHRA office and made contact with Mr. Sentell.

The deputy asked the man if he was John Sentell and Mr. Sentell asked the deputy, "Do you

know me," and "I don't have to talk to you."

Deputy Kevin Parks arrived on the scene and had dealt with Mr. Sentell before. He confirmed the man was John Sentell.

Both deputies talked to Mr. Sentell in an attempt to get him to comply. At that time Mr. Sentell took an aggressive posture in the chair he was sitting in.

All the people in the office were asked to exit the waiting room in case Mr. Sentell did not comply and the deputies attempted to talk to him again in an effort to make it an easy process, but after a few minutes Mr. Sentell kept refusing to comply with verbal commands.

Deputies Patterson and Parks had to physically control Mr. Sentell's arms to handcuff him and after about a minute's struggle

Mr. Sentell was handcuffed.

Mr. Sentell was advised they were going to walk to the patrol car and he had to be physically lifted and walked to the car. Upon getting about four feet from the patrol car, Mr. Sentell fell to his bottom under his own power and continued to sit on the ground.

The deputies talked to Mr. Sentell a couple

of minutes and Sentell refused to comply. Mr. Sentell had to be physically lifted about four feet to the car and would not comply and walk.

Mr. Sentell had to be lifted while struggling to be put in the car.

Mr. Sentell was laying in the back seat of the car after about a five minute struggle and he refused to bend his legs to shut the door. He was advised

to comply several times, but refused and at that time Mr. Sentell had to be drive stunned with the Taser to get him to comply with the officer's orders.

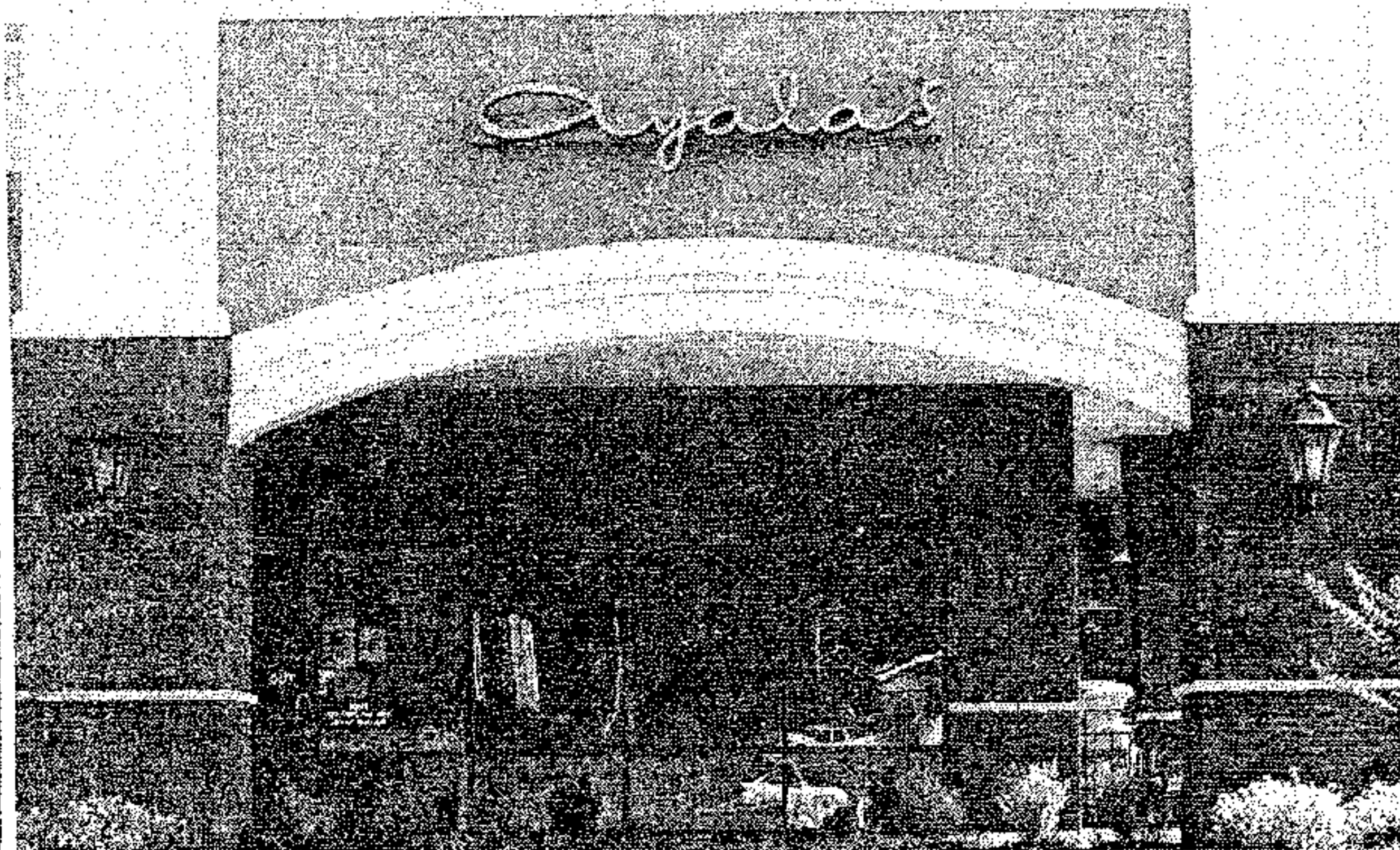
After about a 15 minute struggle Sentell was finally transported to jail.

for their quick action in this case," said U.S. Attorney MacBride.

Swift was charged by criminal complaint of threatening to assault or murder a member of

the immediate family of a United States official. If convicted, he faces a maximum penalty of 10 years in prison. He made an initial appearance before the Honorable C. Clifford Shirley, Jr.,

United States Magistrate Judge, in Knoxville, Tenn., this afternoon.

According to court documents, an unknown male left two voicemail messages with Rep. Cantor's Glen Allen, Va., office the evening of Oct. 27, 2011. The screaming, profanity-laden messages allegedly stated that the caller was going to destroy Rep. Cantor, rape his daughter

and kill his wife. A Congressional staff member retrieved the messages, alerted the U.S. Capitol Police, which sought the assistance of the FBI to identify and locate the individual who made the calls.

Swift was identified as the individual who subscribed to the phone number used to make the call. He was arrested without incident on Nov. 2, 2011 by the FBI in Knoxville and the Lenoir City Police Department after having been interviewed by law enforcement, and allegedly admitted to making the threatening phone calls to Rep. Cantor's office.

The investigation was

conducted by the FBI's Richmond and Knoxville Field Offices, the U.S. Capitol Police, and the Lenoir City Police Department. Assistant United States Attorney Jamie L. Mickelson is prosecuting the case on behalf of the United States.

Criminal complaints are only charges and not evidence of guilt. A defendant is presumed to be innocent until and unless proven guilty.

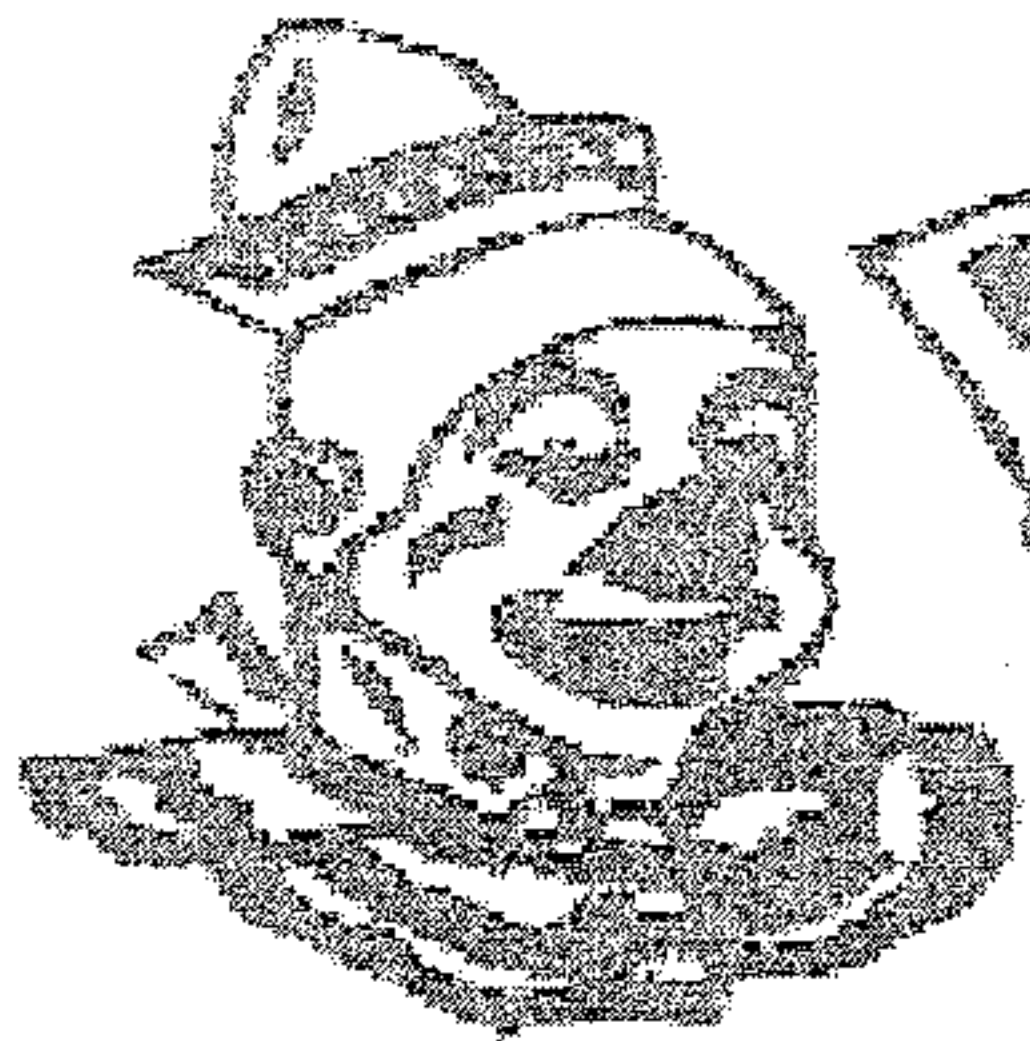
