





Narcotics officers executed a search warrant at McGhee Square Apartments, a complex located within a 1000' of a school, and arrested a resident on charges including marijuana for resale.

Phillip Jasper 'Phil' Davis, 30, Kelly Lane, Lenoir City was charged Tuesday with possession of schedule VI marijuana for resale, possession of drug paraphernalia, drug free school zone, and maintaining a dwelling where narcotics are possessed or sold.

The report states, the Loudon

County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit conducted a search warrant at an apartment in McGhee Square, which is the home of Phillip Jasper Davis. Investigators found approximately 20.3 grams of marijuana, marijuana roaches, rolling papers, scissors used to cut baggies, plastic baggies, three sets of digital scales, two plastic bottles converted into water bongs and \$43 in US currency.

All the items found in the residence are consistent with items used to package, sell, and smoke marijuana.

The home is within 1000 feet of Lenoir City Elementary School.

Investigator Marty Stanley, LCSO-ND made the arrest. Investigator Shane Ezell and Deputy Michael Watkins were also on scene.

When police conducted a traffic stop for a possible drunk driver Sunday, two persons were arrested. The driver for traffic violations and the passenger for having numerous pills in her possession.

Nancy Ann Chaney, 31, Old Poplar Springs Road, Kingston was charged with driving on revoked license and violation of probation.

Robyn Michele Orbesen, 27, Swan Pond Circle, Kingston was charged with possession of schedule IV and possession of schedule II x 3.

According to records, Sunday, around 1:09 AM, Officer Mike Hodges, LCPD responded to a possible drunk driver at Walmart on Highway 321. Upon arrival,

the officer saw the vehicle in question, a gold Ford Taurus, leave the parking lot and cross Highway 321 into the Food City parking lot.

The car sat at the green light for approximately 4 seconds before crossing the highway. Officer Hodges conducted a traffic stop on the Taurus and identified Ms. Chaney as the driver. Her license were revoked for an unsatisfied judgement.

Chaney also had an outstanding warrant in Loudon County for violation of probation.

Ms. Orbesen was a passenger in the Taurus. A pat down performed by Officer Emily Lawson, LCPD revealed a clear plastic baggie containing several different drugs, two zanax, three vicodin, four hydrocodone, one 15 mg. roxicodone and two 30 mg. roxicodone.

Orbesen also had two outstanding warrants out of Roane County for violation of probation.



"Frank Cruz". On record felony arrests include Criminal Sexual Conduct - First Degree Penetration, for which he was found guilty in Minnesota.

Additional information from other states shows several other aliases, warrants, and many other charges, including document fraud and falsely impersonating an officer.

Montana has presented himself to many in the area as an ex-marine, a 9/11 survivor as a firefighter, a law enforcement officer, and a pilot, none of which are true. He was also found to be in possession of a Master's Degree diploma from Eastern University in Pennsylvania which was confirmed to be forged, as well as false fire training certificates from the states of New York and Tennessee.

Montana was taken into custody on February 24th in Lenoir City at the residence of the fiancée. At the time of the arrest, Montana was given several verbal commands that inves-

tigators needed to talk to him about an ongoing investigation. He then kicked a padlocked door open in the basement area and tried to flee, but was apprehended by deputies. He was shown the book-in photo from the Minnesota charges and did admit it was him, but refused to answer any questions. He was taken into custody without further incident.

A 2000 Mercedes found at the residence, which was the vehicle that Mr. Montana had been driving, was registered to a second fiancée in McMinn County. When she was interviewed by investigators, she said that when she met him, Montana told her he had been a Marine for 30 years and had a photo of himself in uniform.

She also told investigators that she had given him over 100 guns and several expensive items of jewelry for safe keeping. She had recently asked him about those items and he told her he had them in a safe place.

On the date he was arrested he had told her he was in Florida working on some business deals. He has allegedly scammed her out of several thousands of dollars in weapons, jewelry, and vehicles, and instead of keeping them "safe" he was actually selling and pawning the items and allegedly selling on Craigslist. His past convictions would not allow him to even possess a firearm and therefore may have violated state and federal laws. To date only one of the weapons has been recovered.

Montana, who has claimed to have been born in Hawaii, is known to have lived in several areas of Florida, New York, New Jersey, Maine, Minnesota, Georgia and Tennessee and has a history in most of those states.

Other aliases found so far are Frankie Cruz, Frank Ernest Cruz, Antonio Francisco Montana, Frank Perez, Frank Anthony Montana, Frank Montana, and Frank Antonio Montana.

Montana also has warrants pending in Roane County on felony theft charges that stem from the investigation. His case is under review by the U.S. Attorney's Office for possible prosecution.

This investigation is ongoing and more charges may follow. Other charges could include federal firearms charges, theft of property charges, and failure to register as a sex offender.


