> While watching the vehicle, Agent DeBoer witnessed the front seat passenger, later identified as Rusty Fagg, snorting a substance while sitting in the front seat. Just after that, the agent saw Mr. Fagg put a needle into the arm of the driver, later identified as Darlene Fagg, Rusty Fagg's mother. Ms. Fagg was found to not suffer from any medical conditions that would require a shot.

The officer made contact with the occupants of the vehicle and observed Darlene Fagg passing Rusty Fagg a hypodermic needle and Ms. Fagg's arm was bleeding from the place the needle was.

Ms. Fagg was lethargic, had trouble speaking and standing and it was obvious she was under the influence of some sort of narcotic. Due to the extreme intoxication she appeared to be under Ms. Fagg was not given field sobriety tasks.

Rusty Fagg was found to have a hypodermic needle in his lap and was also arrested.



Ninth DTF continue to rake in methamphetamine makers, users and promoters by just keeping an eye on local drug stores in the area. Three men were charged after meth components and ingredients were found in the vehicle they were in Wednesday.

Jeremiah Scott Kriner, 25, Johnston Street, Sweetwater was charged with driving on revoked and promoting the manufacture of methamphetJoey Lee Roberts, 44, Red Pond Road, Sweetwater was charged with promoting the manufacture of methamphet-amine.

Stephen Tyler Rucker, 19, West Lamar Alexander Parkway, Friendsville was charged with promoting the manufacture of methamphetamine.

According to affidavits filed by Agent Jonathan Yates, 9th Drug Task Force; on March 23rd, 2011, around 12:00 PM, the 9th DTF conducted surveillance in the area of Rite-Aide in which officers saw a gray Saturn with three males inside acting in a suspicious manner.

Agent Yates followed the vehicle and watched as it turned onto Roberson Springs Road and into a driveway. The agent knew the people who live at that house and knew the occupants did not belong there.

The agent approached the passenger side of the car and made contact with Joey Roberts, who stated they were looking at a car that was for sale.

The officer asked the driver, Jeremiah Kriner, to step out of the vehicle, which he did, before being asked for his drivers license. Mr. Kriner gave a different reason for being in the area and told Agent Yates the passengers in the car had items to "make drugs."


Kriner's Tennessee identification card was checked through dispatch and found to be revoked for frequent traffic violations.

The officer then made contact with the back seat passenger and identified him as Stephen Tyler Rucker.

Kriner gave consent to search the vehicle and the lawmen uncovered ingredients for manufacturing methamphetamine, which included a box of 20 count pseudoephdrine based cold medicine, one gallon jug full of muriatic acid, a quart of unopened Coleman Fuel, a container of drain cleaner, 2 packs of unopened lithium batteries, unused coffee filters, two empty glass bottles and an empty 2 liter plastic bottle.

All three men were taken into custody and transported to the Loudon county Jail. 9th DTF Agents Brendan Deboer and Jeff Vittatoe were also on

scene.



Upon speaking with the passenger, William Hout, Hout advised he purchased 19 suboxen from Mark Manchester at the Rite Aide.

Mr. Hout stated he arranged and made the purchase for his former girlfriend, Natalie Lee, who was the drive of the vehicle.

Upon speaking with Natalie Lee, Lee eventually told investigators she had 18 suboxen pills hidden in private areas of her person.

Officer April Farmer, LPD responded to the scene and was given the pills by Natalie


