





bottle was found in his left rear pocket with 6 blue oval pills identified as alprazolam.

Mr. Smith was given field sobriety tasks in which he did poorly. He was then placed under arrest. A check of his driver's license through NCIC showed Mr. Smith's license was suspended for DUI with a previous DUI conviction on September 23, 2011.

During a search of the vehicle, five white round pills identified as lorazepam and three yellow round pills identified as clonazepam were found in the passenger side floor.

There was also two empty alcohol contain-


