





Jailbirds Charged

Philip Lawrence Jenkins, 27, Bussell Ferry Road, Lenoir City was charged with assault.

Travis Blake Langley, 27, Coffey Circle, Lenoir City also was charged with assault.

According to affidavits filed by Mr. Rodney Hoskins; while incarcerated as an inmate in the Loudon County Jail in F Block, Hoskins was on the phone on January 19th, at approximately 12:35 PM, and was talking with his mother. Hoskins said he was speaking loudly, so his mother was able to hear their conversation.

Inmates Philip L. Jenkins and Travis B. Langley began to mock Mr. Hoskins for how loudly he was speaking to his mother on the phone.

At that time, Jenkins and Langley jumped off their bunks and approached Mr. Hoskins and began punching him with closed fists.

Hoskins fell to the floor and Jenkins and Langley started kicking him. Mr. Hoskins stated he didn't do anything to provoke the attack and sought medical treatment with the jail nurse.

Hoskins, 44, was incarcerated on a charge of assault by domestic violence when the incident occurred.

Berry

was charged with simple possession and theft under \$500.

According to reports, Wednesday, around 4:38 PM, Officer Kevin Condee, LCPD made

contact with Bryan Berry on a traffic stop. He was seen acting suspiciously in Walmart prior to the stop.

Mr. Berry admitted he stole a hat from Walmart valued at \$10. Further investigation revealed Berry was in possession of a bottle of schedule II prescription pills for which he didn't have a prescription. He was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail.



accepted at any TWRA license agent, TWRA regional office, or online at the TWRA website at www.tnwildlife.org.


The areas available for the hunts are listed on the instruction sheets. Hunters may have up to 12 choices,

but will be drawn for only one. Applicants may not use the same hunt code more than once. There are a total of 19 hunts listed. No person may apply more than once.

A permit fee will not be charged to Annual Sportsman (Type 004),

Lifetime Sportsman (Types 401-406) license holders or Senior Citizen Hunters (Type 166) with an Annual Senior Citizen Permit (Type 167). TWRA will pay the agent fee for these transactions. For all other license holders, the cost is \$10 per

permit, plus the agent fee. When applying at a license agent, hunters must remain at the location while the application is processed. Hunters will receive a receipt with a confirmation number when the application is complete.



scales and discovered one of them also had a handgun in his possession when he stopped the vehicle they were in for speeding on Oakland Road.

Timothy Burton Isbill, 31, Roy Road, Sweetwater was charged with driving on revoked license, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of a weapon with

intent to go armed, and simple possession of marijuana.

Nicole C. Cockrum, 30, Roy Road, Sweetwater was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia.

According to records, Monday, at approximately 1:07 PM, Deputy Billy Hall, LCSO stopped a blue Dodge pickup for speeding 66 mph in a 45 mph zone on Oakland Road in Loudon. Prior to the stop the deputy noticed someone reach towards the rear seat of the

truck.

While talking with the driver, identified as Timothy Isbill, Hall smelled the odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle and reported Mr. Isbill kept reaching towards the rear of his back and acting nervous.

The passenger, Nicole Cockrum was removed from the vehicle and appeared very nervous as well.

Deputy Hall frisked Mr. Isbill and discovered an empty holster in his waist band. Mr.

Isbill and Ms. Cockrum were detained and a search of the truck produced a 9mm mag on the front seat and a 9mm handgun in the rear seat area.

There were several hand rolled marijuana cigarettes found in the ash tray. A set of scales with marijuana residue and a large amount of small ziplock bags, some with marijuana residue in them, were located in the rear seat area of the vehicle.

A search of Ms. Cockrum's purse revealed approximately five needles, a spoon, and several pieces of cotton.

There was also a set of scales with mariju

na residue and a marijuana grinder with marijuana residue found in Cockrum's purse.

Ms. Cockrum stated she used the needle to shoot up meth and pain pills.

A check of Mr. Isbill's license showed they were revoked for failure to pay a citation. Mr. Isbill stated just prior to pulling over he removed the 9mm pistol from the small of his back and placed it in the rear of the vehicle.


