



When selecting a contractor, it is also important to:

Remember that legitimate contractors will not appear at your home, claiming to have noticed damage to your roof or property. A "contractor" demonstrating this behavior

should immediately raise a red flag.

•Get several bids. It's best to get at least three bids and check references.

•Get a written contract that includes the company's name, address and telephone number.


