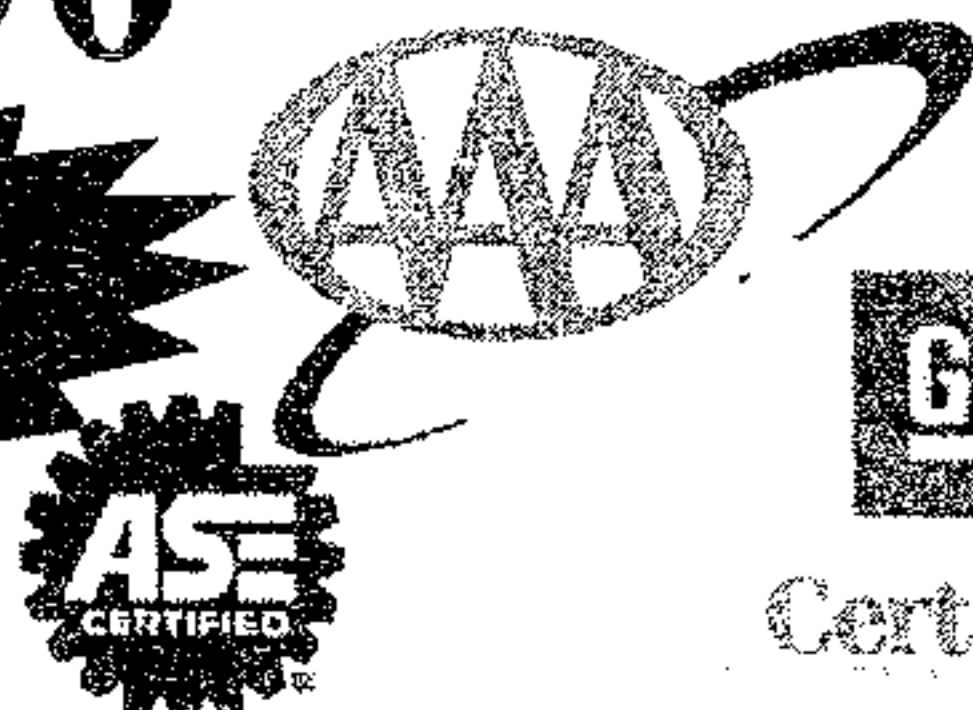

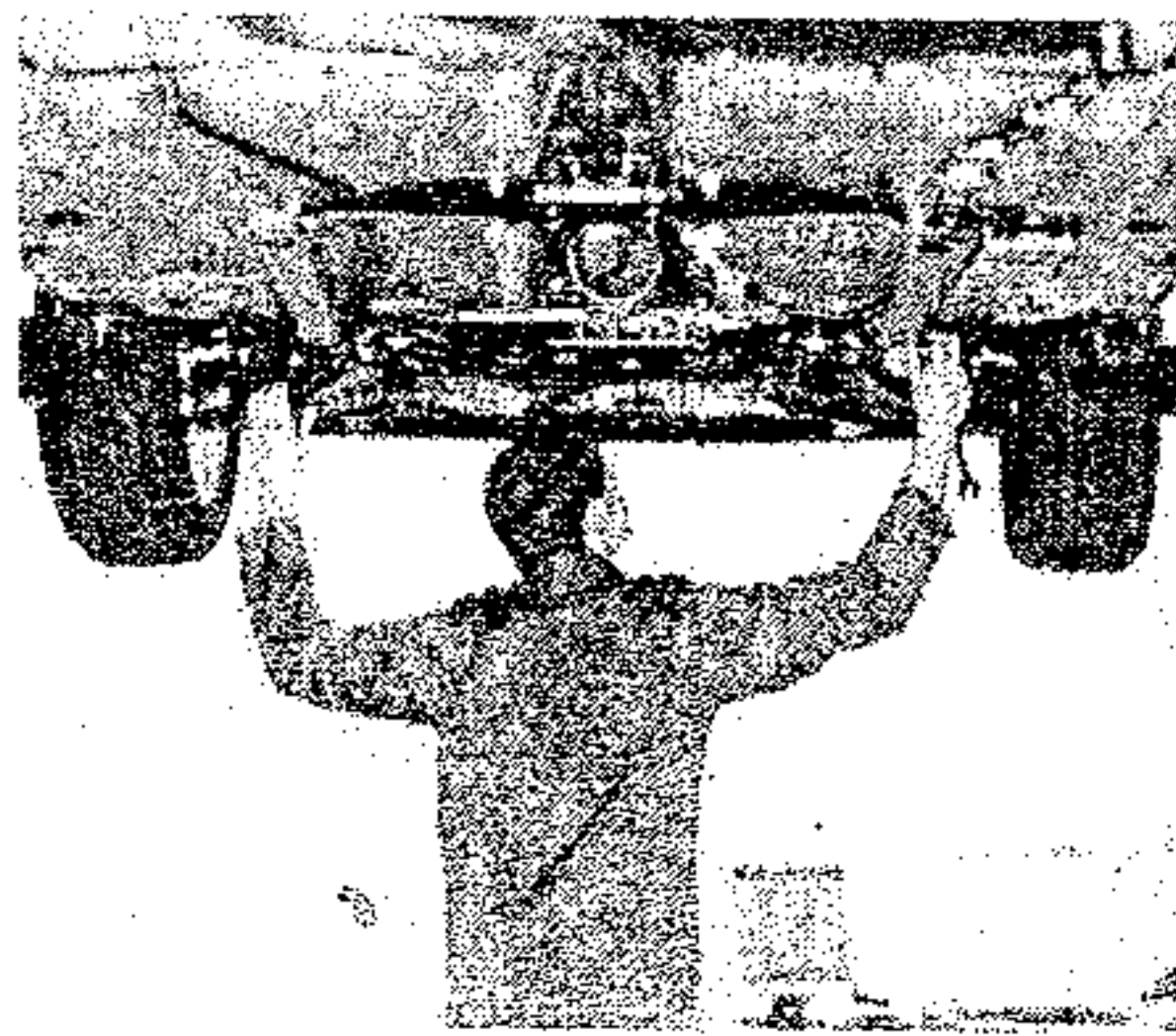

Stalking

Dana Lynn Spears, 56, Coffee Lane, Loudon, was charged with stalking.

According to the affidavit, filed by Detective Jack Fine, LCPD, on March 28th, 2012, at approximately 2:15 pm, Ms. Spears approached the victim while at Rock Springs Park in Lenoir City. Ms. Spears has threatened the victim and her children in the past and was advised not to, by law enforcement.

This encounter did place the victim in fear of imminent bodily harm and fear for her life and her children's safety.
