


## Dad sees man expose himself to little girl


## LC man goes off, assails mother, vandalizes van

Chief Davis conducted a traffic stop and identified the driver as Daniel D. Bright.


Mr. Bright advised he had suspended license and a check through the state confirmed he did have a suspended license. He also had a previous conviction for driving on suspended in 1996.



A female was on the




