Tallent

According to the warrants, Derek Ethan Tallent did attempt to escape from the Loudon County Jail by climbing above a suspended ceiling in a holding cell where he was being housed pending court disposition for two counts of felony burglary.

The ceiling did collapse under his weight causing him to fall through and onto the floor. Significant damage was done

to the ceiling as a result of Mr. Tallent's actions that included the ceiling frame and tiles to be destroyed and a light fixture fell from the ceiling and had to be removed.

The damage is estimated at over \$500.

Derek Ethan Tallent, 29, of North Point Road, Sweetwater, was charged with attempted escape from penal institution and felony vandalism. Sgt. Detective Charles Cosner, LCSO made the arrest.

According to the report, Investigator Jeff Russell, LCSO CID responded to the jail to investigate an escape from a temporary holding cell.

When the investigator arrived he found the inmate in the cell was Jonathan Viars. Upon talking to other inmates and corrections officers it was found that Jonathan Viars had removed a ceiling tile and had climbed into the crawl space

between the false ceiling and the roof.

The ceiling tile had fallen with him due to the weight on the tile causing damage to the ceiling approximately \$500 worth.

Jonathon Viars, 19, of Old Hwy 95, Lenoir City, was charged with escape and vandalism.

Investigator Jeff Russell, LCSO CID made the arrest and filed the charges.







What if they were only evaluating your words? Have you said or done anything in the past week that might have helped that person consider trusting in Jesus?

am convinced that many Christians reading today would be embarrassed if they really had to answer those questions. sometimes look back at my day before going to bed at night and ask myself if I made a difference for Christ that day. There are days when I felt like I walked with Jesus and looked for opportunities to share the gospel with others, but unfortunately there are days that I can't recall one action or one sentence that was meant to glorify our Savior.

In today's text, James is telling Christians that evi-

in our actions and that claiming to have faith but not acting through faith makes our faith worthless, possibly even nonexistent. In other words, if you say you are a Christian, but nothing in your life or actions resembles Christ, you may not be a Christian at all!

James 2:14-26 (NKJV) (14) What does it profit. my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? (15) If a brother or sister is naked or destitute of daily food, (16) and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warm and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? (17) Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. (18) But someone will say, "You have faith, and

me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by

my works. (19) You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe- and tremble! (20) But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? (21) Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the alter? (See Genesis 22:1-19) (22) Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect? (23) And the scripture was fulfilled which says, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God. (24) You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only.(25)



TGN ctd. from pg. 7 Likewise, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out another way? (See Joshua 2:12-21) (26) For as the body without the Spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Let me clarify one point; contrary to the beliefs of some "religious" groups around us, I do not believe that one can get to heaven by simply being a good person. Regardless of how nice you are, or how many people you help along the way, God's word tells us plainly that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth and the Life, and that NO man can come to the Father except through Him (John 14:6). Jesus also said in John 3:3, "unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

I do believe that when we invite Jesus into our heart and life that He saves us. If, at some point after that, our faith is not reflected in our actions, it means one of two things; we have either allowed sin into our lives and need to repent and get back on "Team Jesus", or we have never really surrendered our lives to Him at all!

If your faith is not evident in your works, in which category do you fall? Regardless of which applies to you, the answer to either situation is still the same; call on Jesus! Ask Him to forgive you and make you whole. Romans 10:13 says that, "whosoever will call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

If the faith of every Christian in our community was reflected in the words and deeds of each Christian, then our com-

munities could begin to see change that has an eternal impact! It is our own fault that Christianity is on the decline in America and that "coexisting" is quickly becoming the norm.
