
in us yearns jealously"? (6) But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."



question; are you giving your first 10% back to God? Are you then giving to others who have needs even if it causes you to suffer a little? Can God see that you love your neighbor as yourself?
