

in the bottle. Anthony was then mirandized. Trooper Adam Bowman THP made the arrest.



described how we were going to begin fishing in a new style called "Team Effort". I would cast the line, hook a trout and then hand him the rod and he would land the fish. Before long we both had our limit of fish and left for home with our sanity intact. Eventually, he grew enough to begin catching fish for himself and now can fish as good, if not

better, than his old man! I share these treasured memories and this fishing strategy with you today because I believe it contains the same value when applied to Christianity. I am convinced that young Christians, and even older Christians who have not been exposed to effective discipleship training, can easily get hung up in the rocks of life and the snags of the enemy. Without using "A Team Effort"

to teach and encourage them, these folks will have difficulty becoming great fishers of men and may eventually quit fishing altogether.

We have been skimming the highlights of the Book of James for several weeks now and this will be the last message in this series. Although it's the last one, it is possibly the most important lesson throughout the whole book. Here it is from James, the half-brother of Jesus Christ:

James 5:16-20 (NKJV) (16) Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective fervent prayer

of a righteous man avails much. (17) Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. (18) And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit. (19) Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, (20) let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.

For many years I was a Christian that chose to

surround myself with non-Christian or non-Christian acting friends. I didn't attend church regularly, I didn't spend time with the Lord in His word or in prayer and I didn't share my struggles or temptations with folks who would pray with and for me. As a result, my spiritual life was in shambles, my heart was very cold and my attitude was pitiful at best. I couldn't achieve happiness in my own life and took out my frustration on anyone and everyone who crossed me. Do you know anyone like this? Are you in this condition now?

If so, I am happy to announce that it doesn't have to be that way any longer. The moment I fell to my knees and cried out to the Lord for mercy, forgiveness and peace, He began to teach me the effectiveness of true prayer. Jesus did have
