SMOKING REGULATIONS

A student will be allowed to smoke only at designated times and in the designated area. Smoking times will be before school, during the break following first period, during the lunch periods, and between 5th. and 6th. period. The only designated smoking area is the covered walkway adjacent to the bandroom and shop area. Each student must have in his possession a validated smoking permit at all times. Any violation of school smoking regulations will result in loss of permit.

DRUGS

Any student caught in possession of drugs or alcohol will be suspended and placed in the custody of the police.

ABSENTEES

I. Categories of Excused Absences

A. Bona Fide Notes

1. Doctor
2. Dentist
3. Court

B. Phone Calls by Parents

C. Exceptional cases handled by the Administration

II. Unexcused absences

- A. Absences that are not included in Section I. The unexcused admits will be written by the homeroom teacher.

III. Penalties for unexcused absences

- A. Three unexcused absences will lower the grade by one letter during a grade period.
- B. Six unexcused absences will constitute a grade of F during a grade period.
- C. Three unexcused tardies will constitute an unexcused absence.

STUDENT PARKING

Students are to park in designated areas only and each car must display a valid parking sticker in the back window. Parking stickers can be purchases from the Student Council for 50¢.

Students are urged to drive carefully and to obey all traffic rules and regulations.

Students are not permitted to sit in parked automobiles on campus.

Five minutes are allowed for the exchange of classes.

USE OF TELEPHONE

All personal calls and unlimited calls will be made over the pay-station telephones. Students will not be permitted to use the office telephones except in case of emergency. The teacher who gives you permission to use the phone will determine whether or not the nature of your call is an emergency and will send a permission note to the office.

LEAVING SCHOOL

In any case where a student must leave school before 3:30, he must bring a bona fide note to the office or be on the phone call list by 8:30. All students before leaving school must sign out in the front office.

Before being admitted to the clinic, a student must get a clinic pass from the teacher whose room he is leaving. If you are considered ill, you will be sent home. But before leaving you must take an excuse to all your teachers whose classes you will miss and sign out through the front office.

LUNCH PERIODS

No student will be permitted to leave campus to eat lunch, therefore, all students must eat lunch (even if brought from home) in the cafeteria. All students must move from their classroom to the cafeteria under the supervision of their teachers. Those students who do not wish to eat lunch will be dismissed at that time.

DRESS CODE

Dress will be left to the student as long as it is decent and neat. Shoes must be worn while at school. No hats are to be worn inside.
