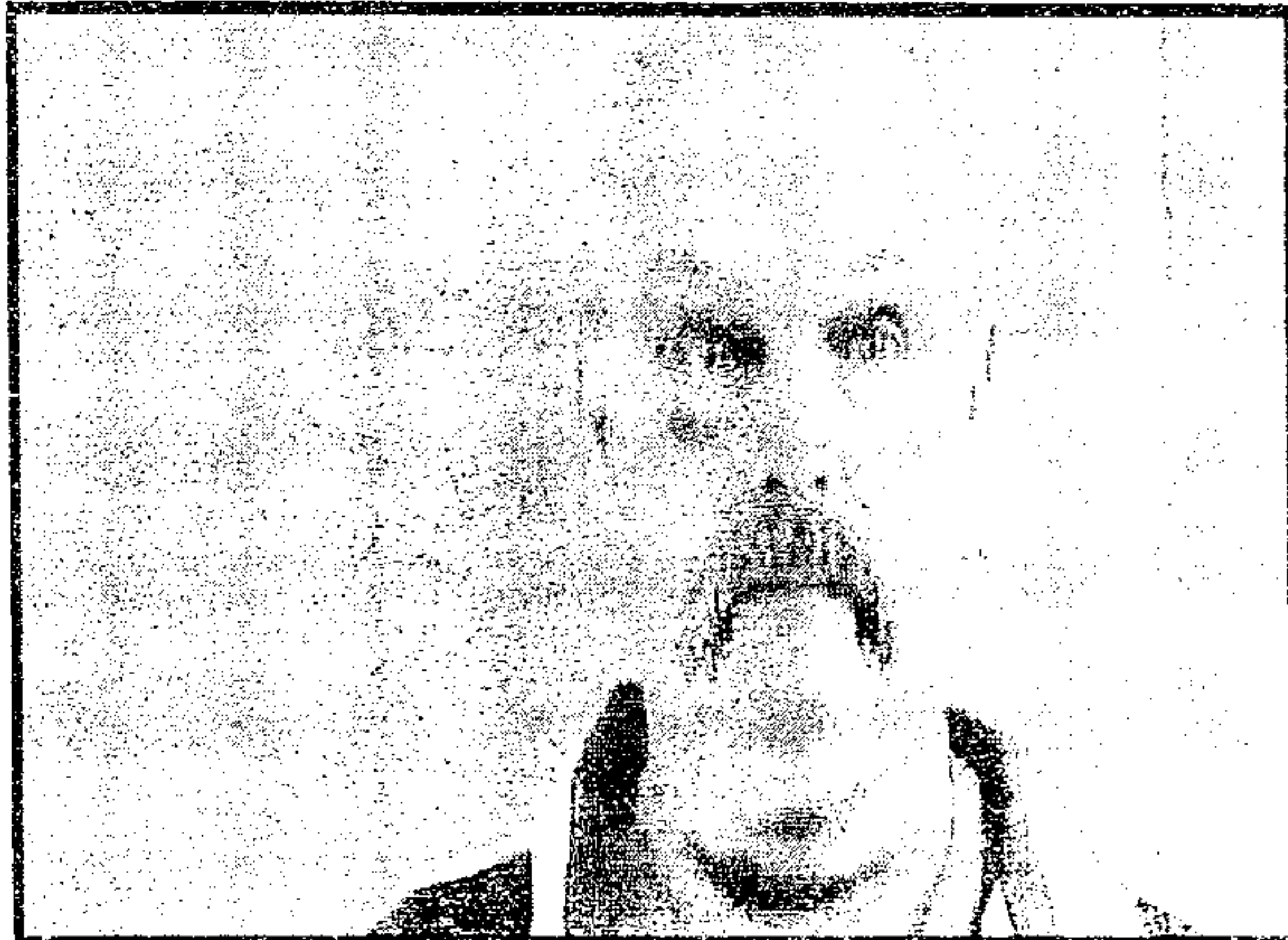

During this conversation Andrew stated that he wasn't very confident of his relationship with Christ and wasn't quite sure where he would spend eternity if he died this week (as another inmate did this past week). Andrew didn't choose to make a decision for Christ during our conversation but I am confident that he is thinking about it.

God is obviously softening the heart of this young man and inviting him into a relationship with the Savior. My request to you is this; Pray that God will continually remind him this week of the eternal condition of his soul. Pray that Andrew will realize that Jesus loves him and wants to have a relationship with him

that will change his life forever.

I am praying that Andrew can't sleep at night and that he can't focus on anything else but the fact that he needs Jesus and Jesus is calling out to him for salvation. I am praying that God will give me the words to say to him and that he can see the love of Christ in Blondie and I both.

Will you join me in praying for my new friend Andrew? Pray that he realizes his need for Christ and that God will reveal Himself to Andrew in a powerful way this week. Pray that Angie and I are faithful to share the gospel message with him in a clear and simple way. I ask you to pray and then to believe!! God is always glorified when a lost person calls upon Him for eternal salvation. You can easily participate in what God is doing here in Montana if

you will. I ask you to pray all week for Andrew. Thank you.
