for her safety. According to the victim Robinson ordered the victim to give her all of her money. Robinson then reached into the floorboard at the victims feet and grabbed the victims purse. Roberson fled the scene on foot. The victim observed Robinson getting into a white SUV parked on N A St. The SUV was driven by another female and drove away heading West on Broadway.
