### Be Still, and Know that I Am God

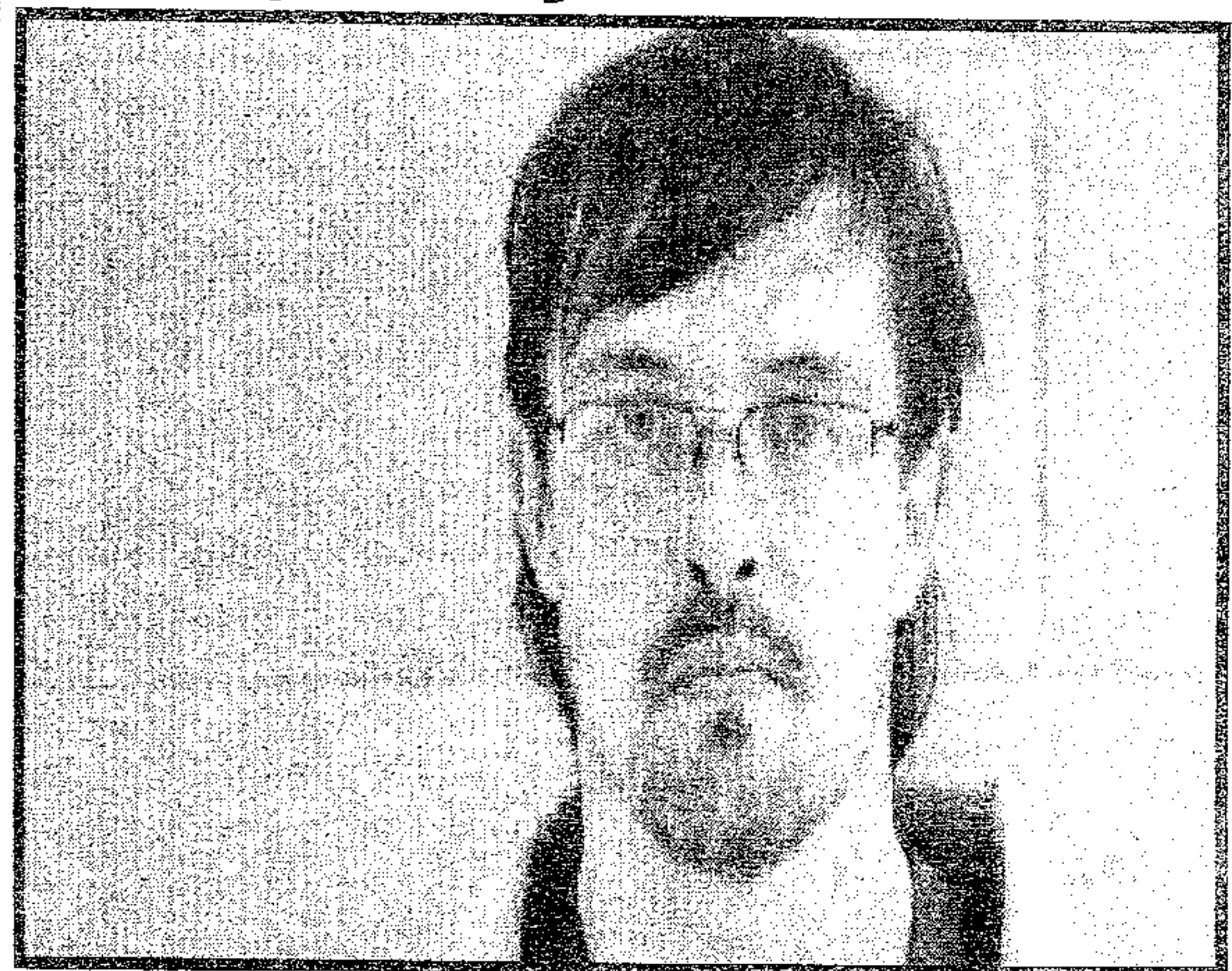
