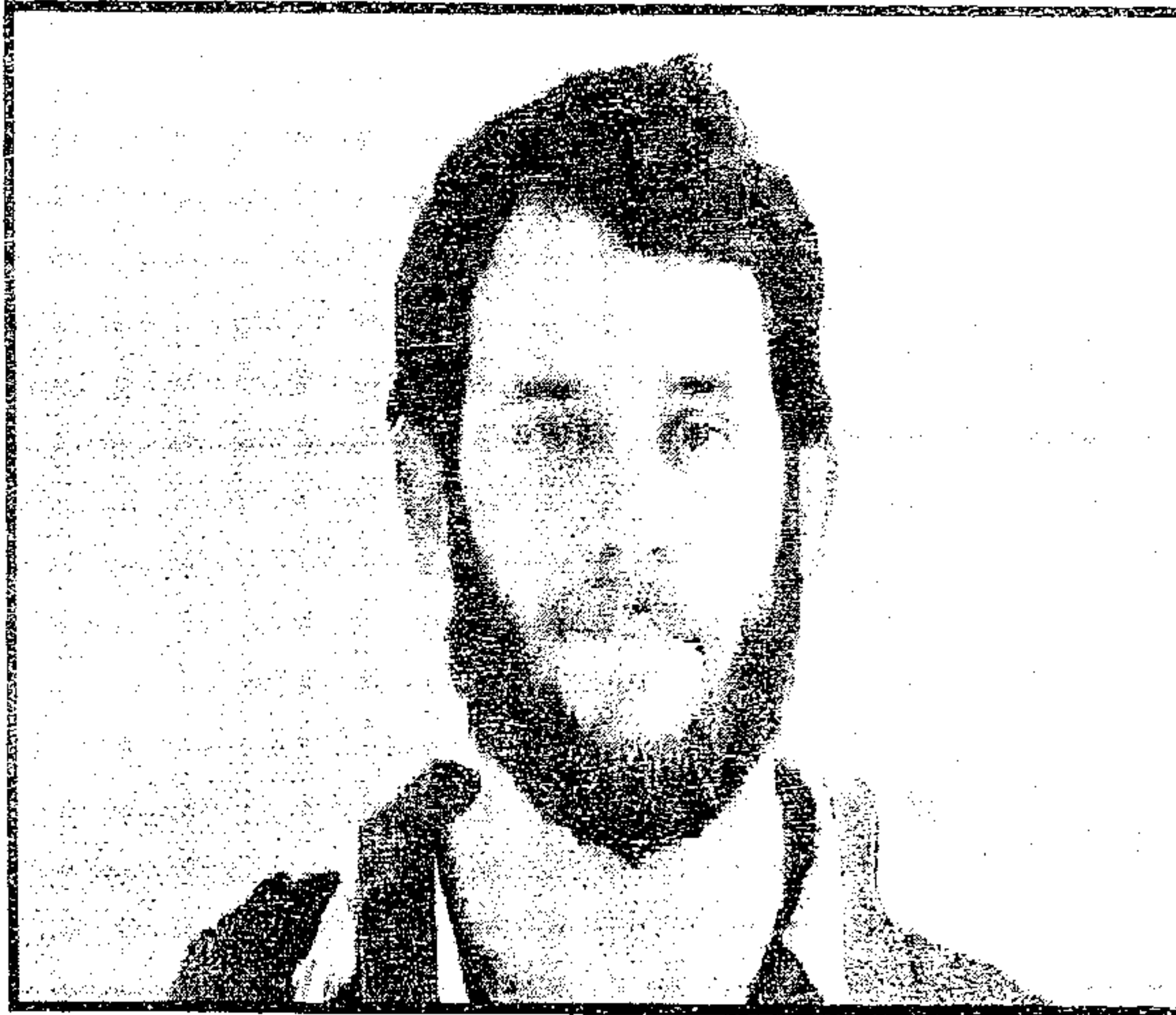

Wanted, DUI and revoked driver nabbed by THP

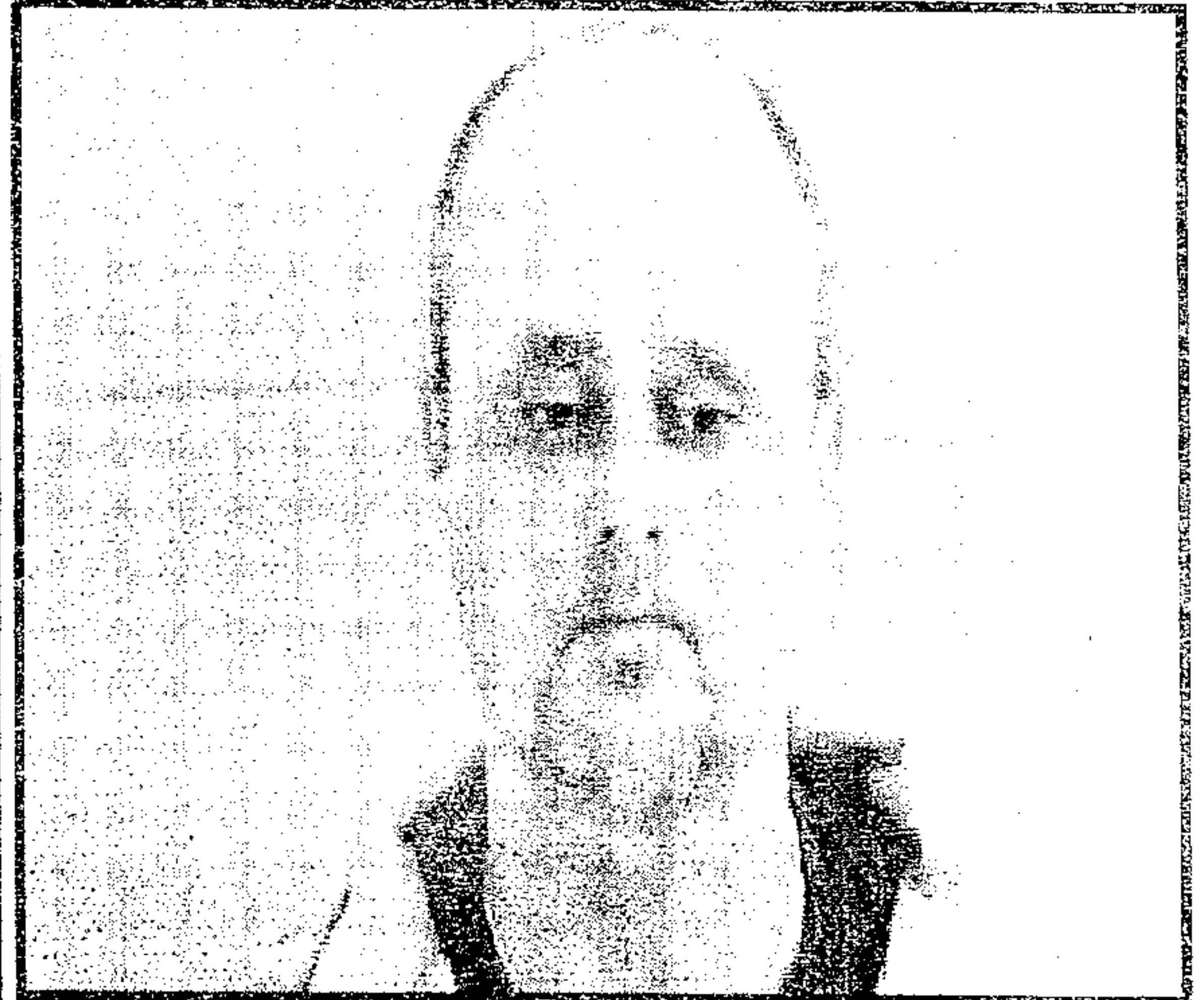





The Trooper Colby Huff THP, observed a tan vehicle failed to stop at the stop sign of Love's rest stop on HWY 321. The Trooper attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle as it was traveling on the I-40 W mm364 on ramp.
