You may ask yourself if this is really a possibility. Is this really what will happen when Jesus comes back? Well, let's see what the Bible says:







Justin Fuller, Chapel Road Laws Maryville, was charged with DUI.

Deputy Brandon Burley LCSO, did observe a black Kia sedan traveling 61 miles per hour in a 50 mile per hour zone on Highway 411.
