

Sex offender nabbed after assault and aggravated burglary

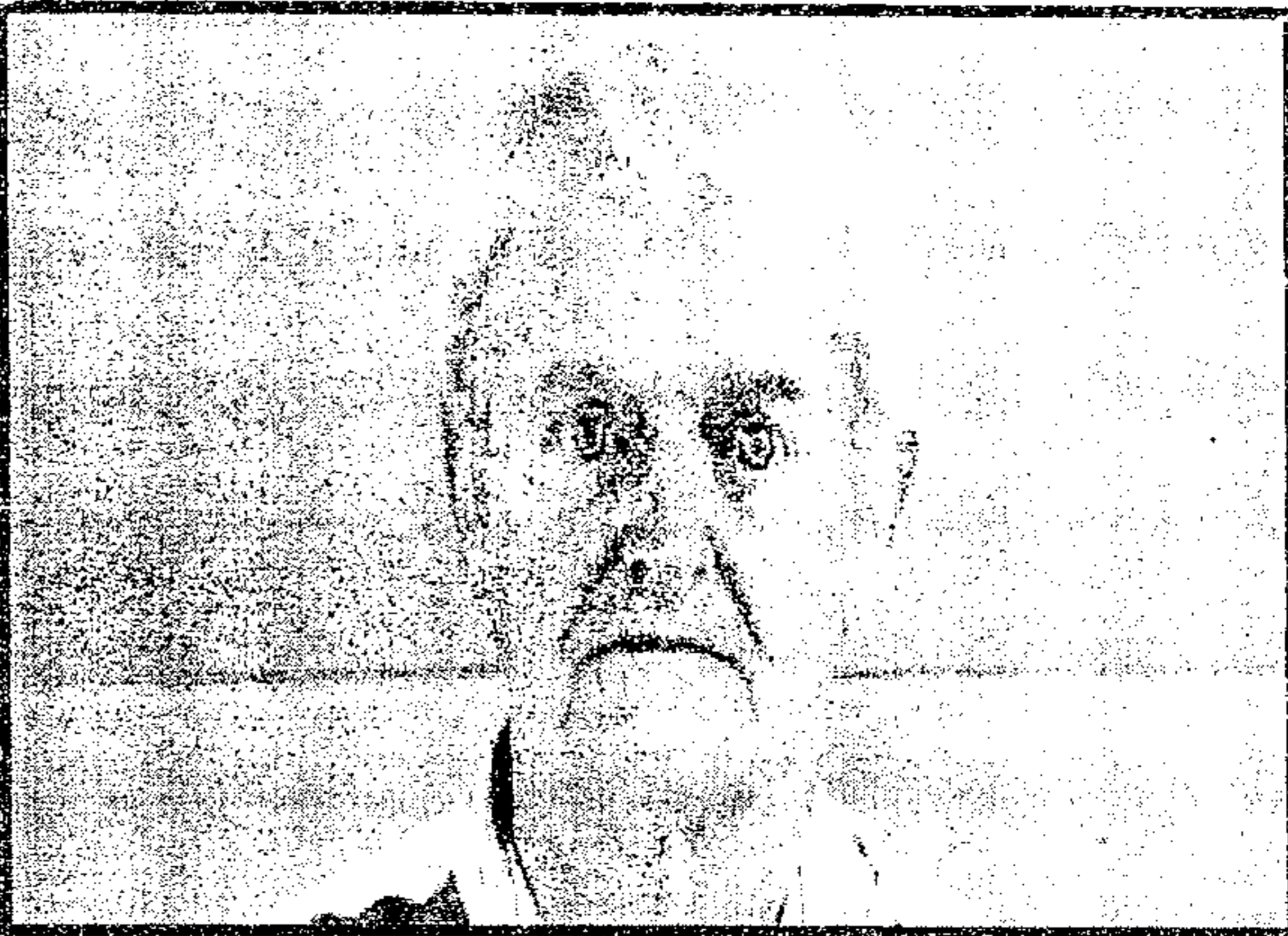
