## GYFO sweeps Central

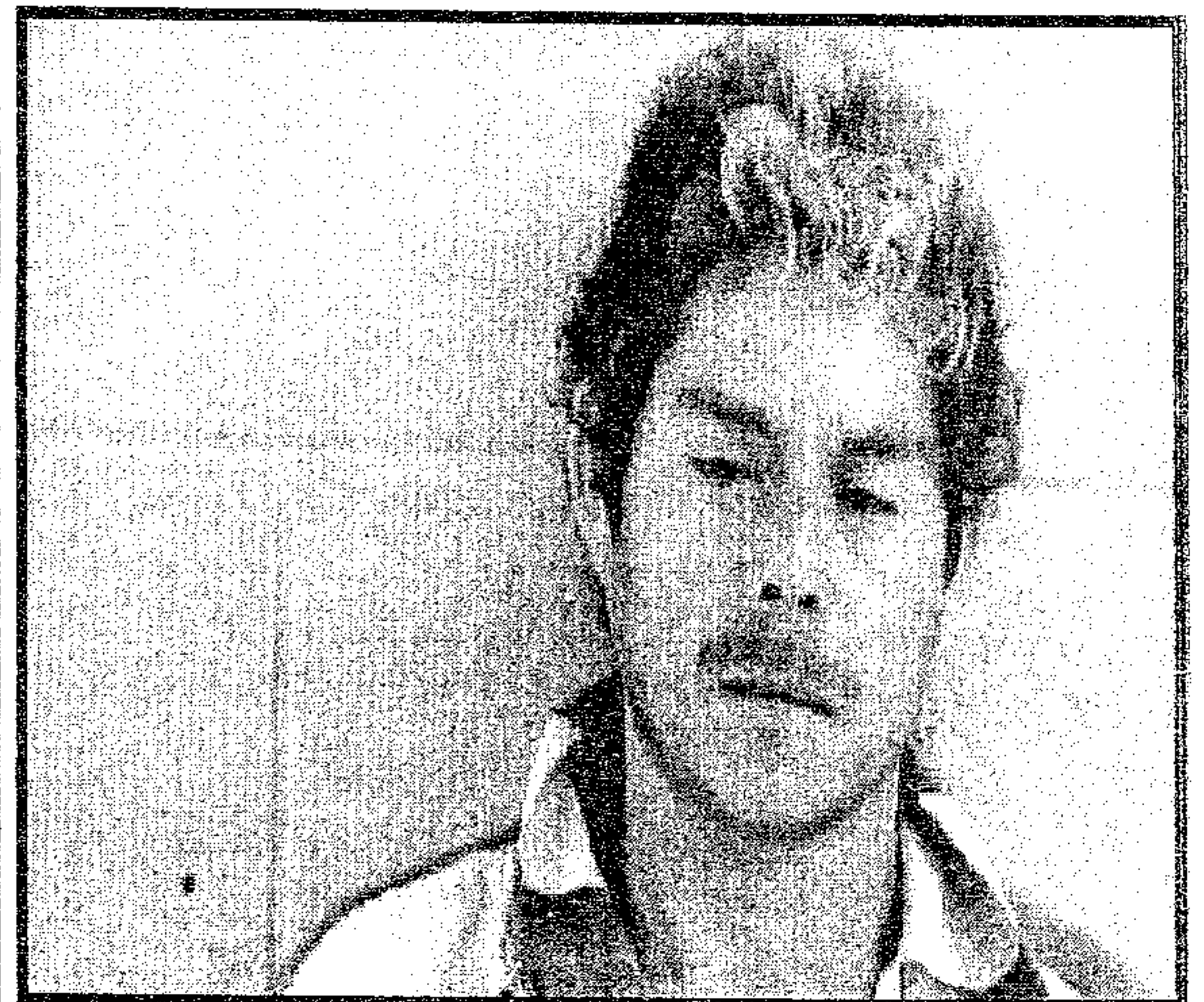
The Greenback Youth Football Organization (GYFO) hosted Central Saturday and posted 4 wins.

Quick action from Deputies with the Loudon County Sheriff's Department stopped a reckless driver on the interstate after receiving several calls about the driver. After they stopped the vehicle they discovered the female driver to be in possession of meth and more after a search was conducted.

Robin Gregory, 50, Little Pittsburg Road London KY, was charged with Poss. of SCH. II & VI Drug and Poss. of Drug Para. On this date 10-04-1014 Deputy Charles Huskin LCSO, was dispatched to a reckless driver call on I-75.

Deputy made contact with a gray Chevrolet Silverado traveling approximately 85 MPH and traveling on the center divider line on I-75 North bound just before the 76-MM exit. Deputy did make a traffic stop just after the 76 exit.

Deputy approached the vehicle, and made contact with the driver Ms. Robin Diane Gregory. Robin seemed very exited but stated that she had try to take a shoe off and she was sleepy. Deputy ran Ms. Gregory's driver license through NCIC,

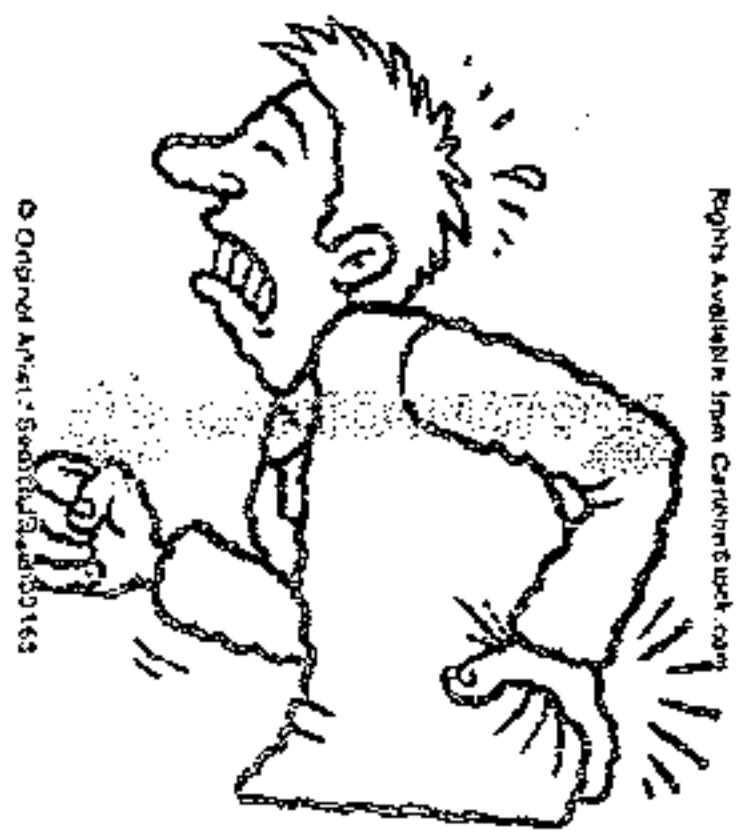

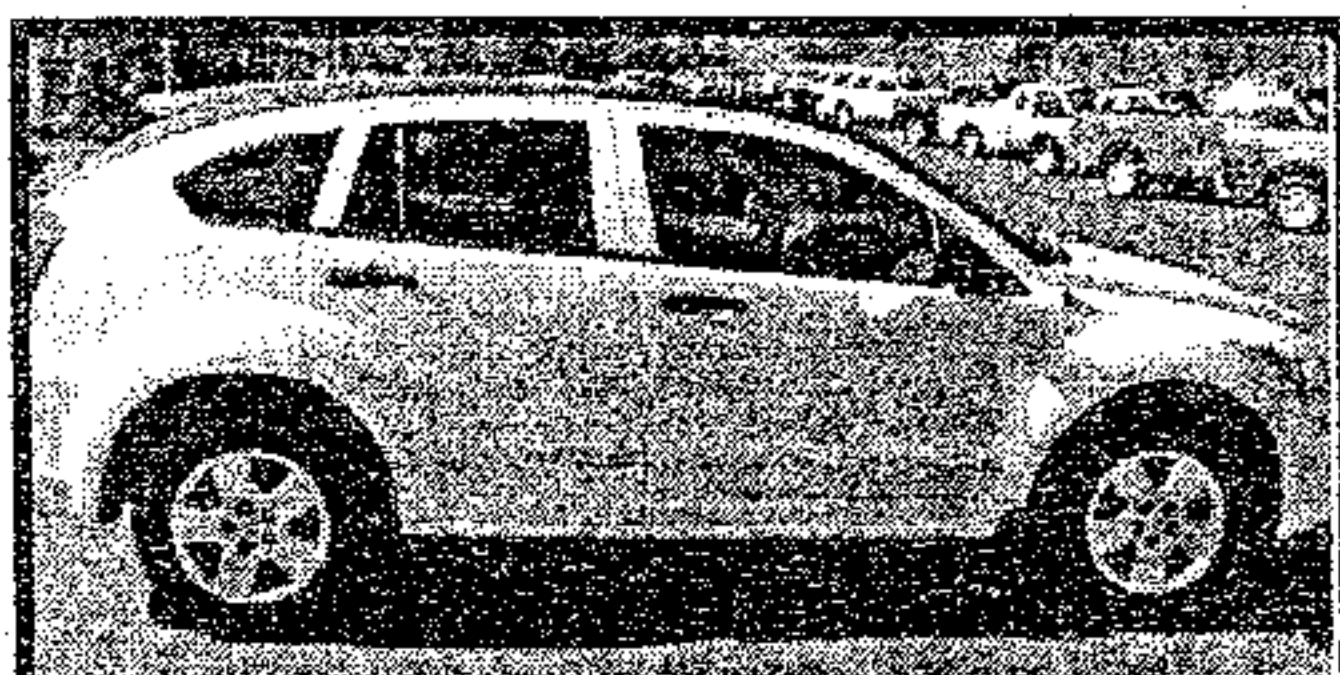

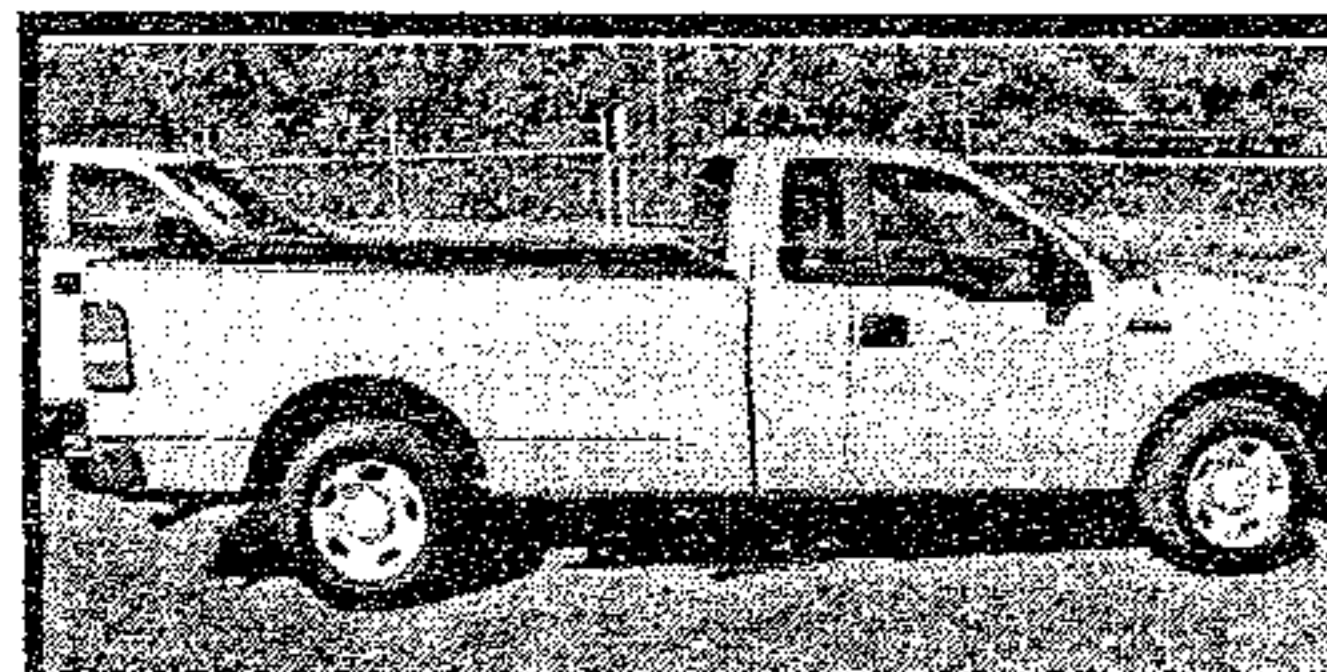
