

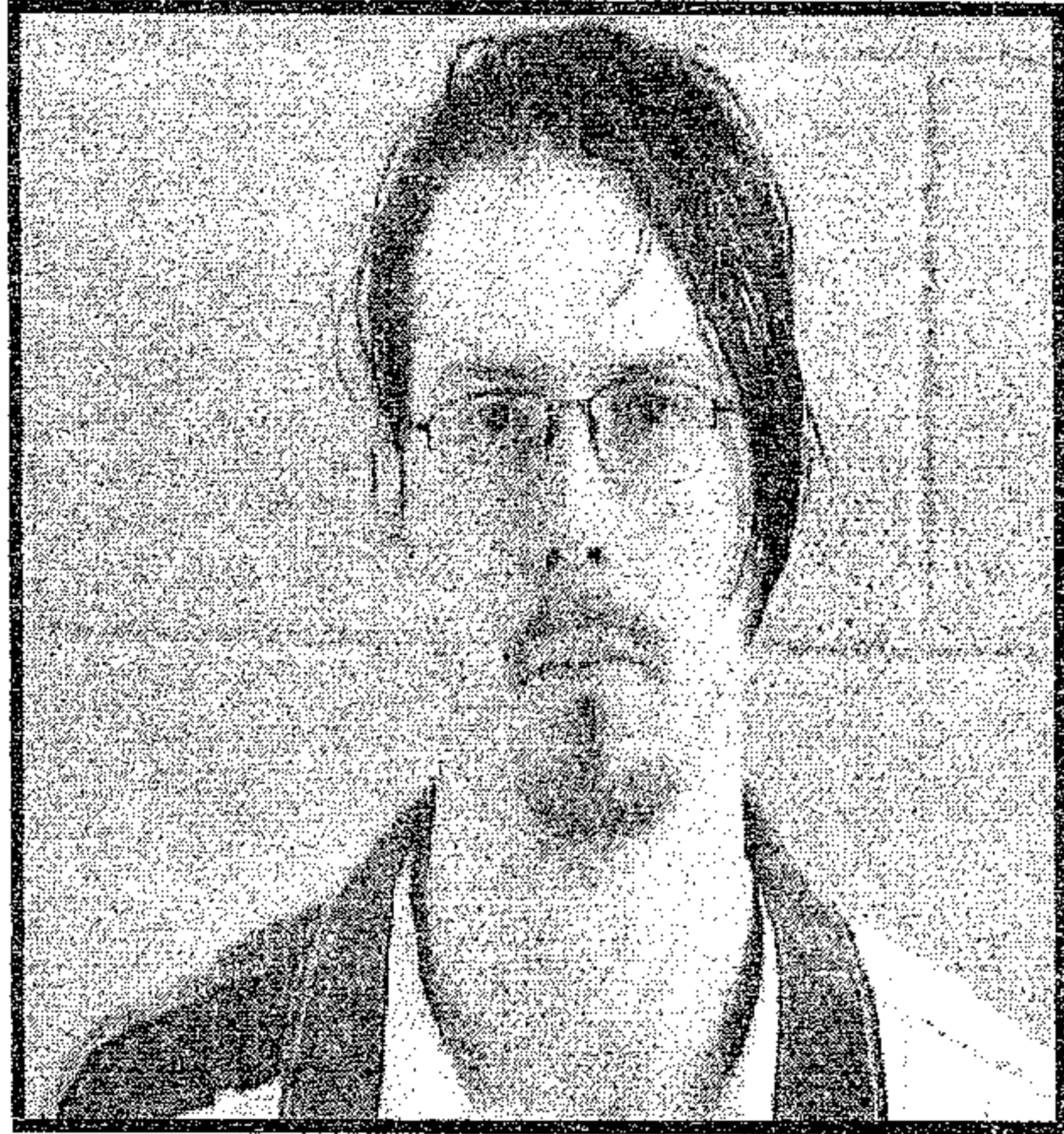

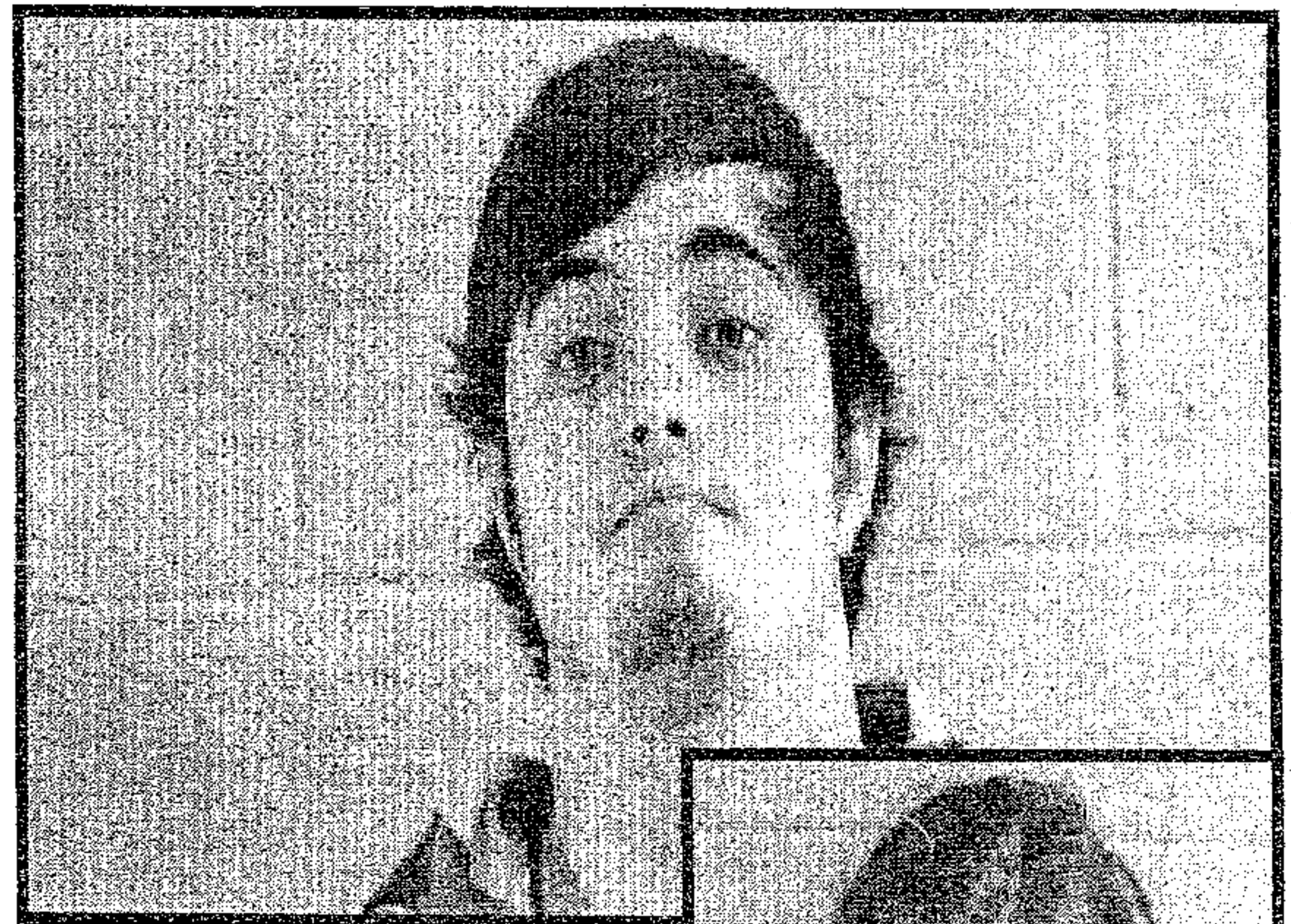
LCPD investigating teen death

Hill was causing a disturbance by yelling and kicking the hospital door.


