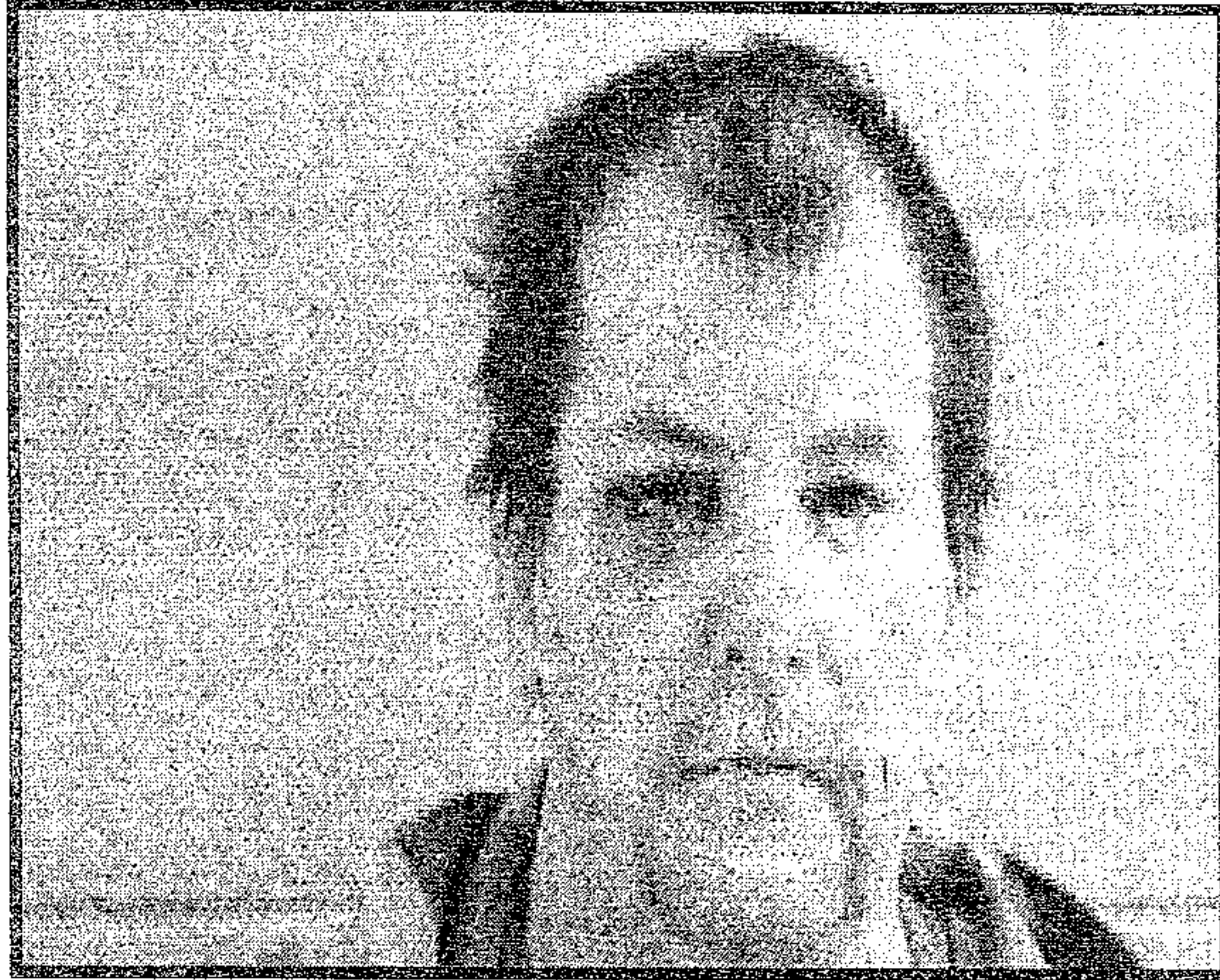

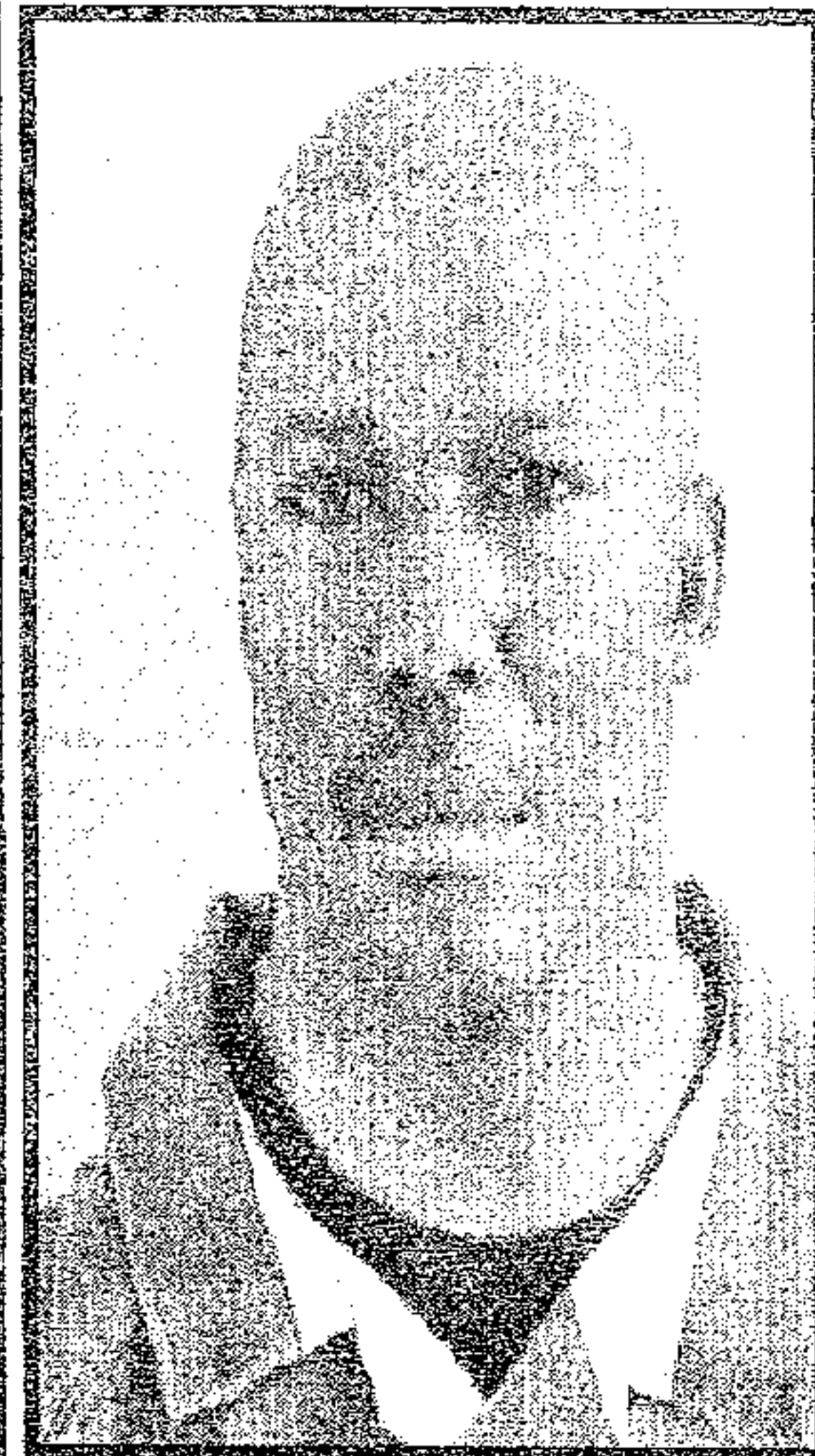

Brother vs. brother; 1 charged with agg. assault

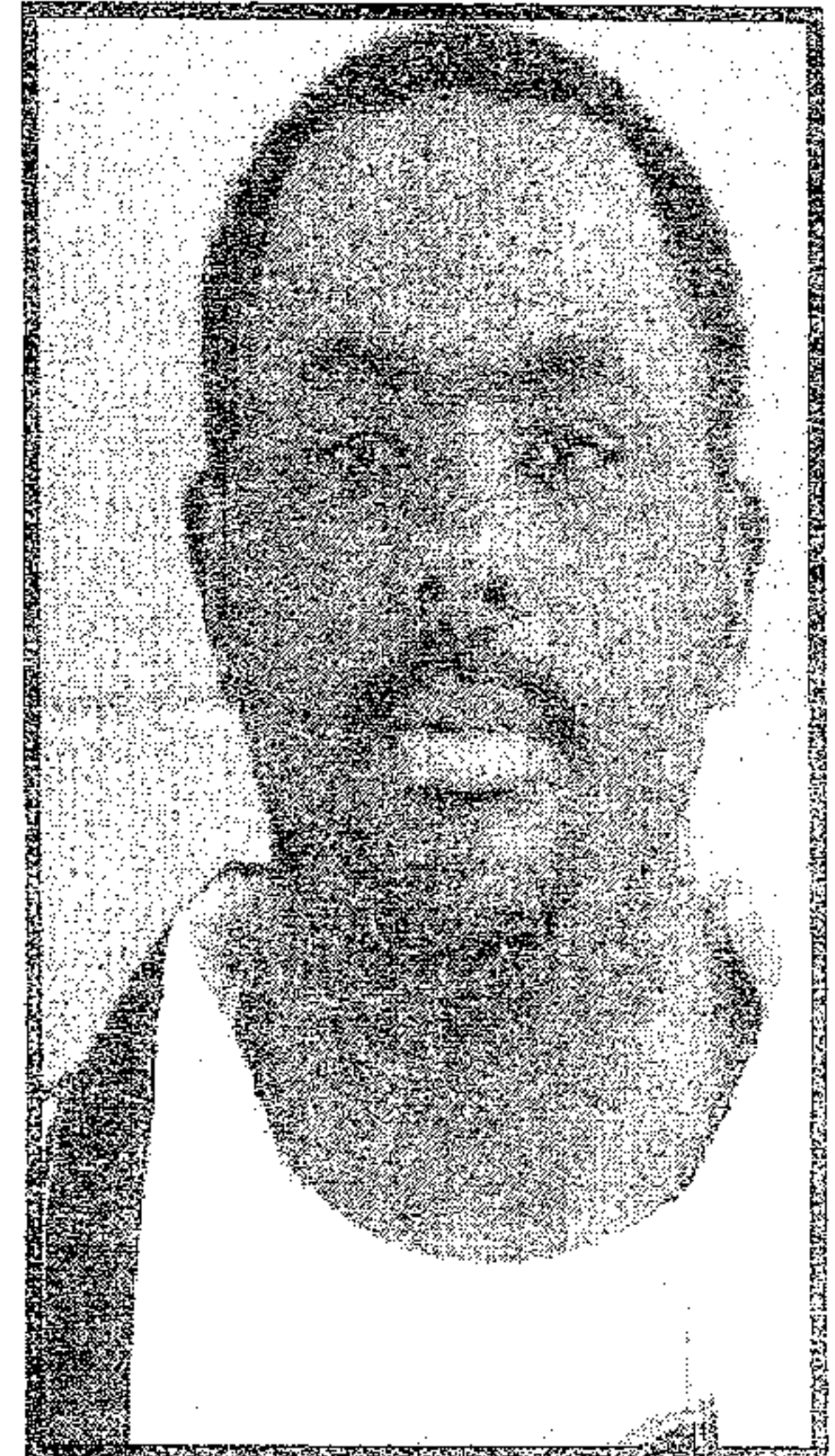

Trespassing
