**DUI**

Sean Anderson, 28, Forest Heights Circle Lenoir City, was charged with DUI.

According to the report, Deputy Chris Hutchens LCSO, did respond to the intersection of Muddy Creek and Highway 11 for a wreck that Inv. J. Russell came upon after observing a person walking down Muddy Creek just down from the crash scene.

The subject walking was identified as Sean Anderson, and he identified himself as the operator of the crashed vehicle. Mr. Anderson did have a strong odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his person, unsure balance and bloodshot eyes. Mr. Anderson admitted to consuming alcohol this evening, and that he was negotiat-

ing the turn onto Muddy Creek from Hwy 11, when his truck broke and "fell into a ditch". Mr. Anderson had went off the road to the left and struck a fire hydrant, knocking it over.

Mr. Anderson did perform standardized field sobriety tasks, and he did perform poorly. Mr. Anderson was then arrested and advised of the Tennessee Implied consent law in which he did agree to provide a breath sample, resulting in a BAC of .20%.

Deputy Chris Hutchens LCSO made the arrest.

**Robbery**

Hayworth, 23.

Hayworth is accused of

robbing the Burger King in Lenoir City on January 30 and stealing a Jeep Wrangler as a getaway vehicle.

Officers spotted Hayworth at 100018 Bob Gray Road where they say he ditched the Jeep and ran into a nearby house. He was chased out by the homeowners and their dog.

Deputies say from there, Hayworth went to Double Tree Road where he saw a woman outside. He knocked her down and stole the keys to her Ford Escape.

She ran after the vehicle because her puppy was inside. The woman held on to the dog and the vehicle as Hayworth dragged her about 20 feet.

She suffered numerous cuts and was taken to the hospital as a precaution because she is pregnant.

Hayworth lost control of

the vehicle at the entrance to Windamere where he crashed into a tree. He then ran to a house on Gray Creek Lane where he was located hiding behind a couch.

He was taken into custody around 6 p.m.

Hayworth was also wanted for violation of probation in Loudon County.

A Knox County sheriff's deputy who was on his way to the scene lost control of his vehicle in a curve on Schaad Road and crashed. Officials say the vehicle slid across the road and landed on its side.

The driver, Deputy Russell Kuhlman, was not injured.

The Knox County Sheriff's Office utilized K-9s and Airwatch in the search for Hayworth. The FBI was also involved because Hayworth was wanted for a crime in another jurisdiction.
