Murder

On March 9, 2014 at approximately 2pm Officer with the Loudon Police Department responded to 121 Elm Lane in Loudon for a report of an attempted suicide. While in route they received updated information this incident would possibly be an attempted murder/suicide.

Upon arrival, officers discovered Casey Hogan, 24, to have uncontrolled bleeding from his left wrist. Hogan is both physically and mentally handicapped and unable to care for himself. Also present was Hogan's mother and sole care giver, Martha Brewer. Due to the nature of the call and evidence at the scene Officers called for a Detective to respond.

After interviewing Brewer, examining the scene and injuries to Hogan, the Loudon Police Department was able to develop probable cause and obtain warrants charging Brewer with attempted first degree murder of Hogan. Brewer is being held at the Loudon County Jail.

Martha Brewer, 51, Elm Lane Loudon, was charged with Attempted 1st Degree Murder. According to report on 3/8/14 Martha did with premeditation attempt to in-

tentionally cause the death of her mentally and physically handicapped son. Martha did give her son approx. 15 ten milligram zolpidem sleeping

pills in an attempt to cause his death. When Martha discovered him to still be breathing after a short period of time she then cut his left wrist with a small paring knife attempting to cause him to bleed to death. Martha was placed under arrest. Detective Brian Jenkins I.P.D., made the arrest.

Tracy Brown, 38, Simpson Road Loudon, was charged with Aggravated Assault, Driving on Revoked License, and Leaving the scene of accident.

Robert Brabson, 33, Simpson Road Loudon, was charged with Aggravated Assault.

Deputy Robbie Lane LCSO, was dispatched to Tinnel Ln. for a physical fight between two females. While on the way to the scene female caller advised that one female had left the scene in a silver Honda Accord going towards Highland Park School. About 1455 hrs. Deputy arrived on scene and made contact with victim who was walking up from Tinnel Ln. The victim stated that a silver Honda Accord was in the driveway at Tinnel Ln. and her dogs were outside and was behind the vehicle. The victim walked up to get her dogs and saw a passenger in the back seat of the car. The Victim stated that she was talking to the passenger and that the black female that was driving the car told her to move out of the way or she was going to hit her. The Victim stated that the driver who was identified as Miss Tracy Brown put the car into reverse and hit the gas. Victim had to grab a hold of the car and Miss Brown drove the car with victim hanging onto the side of the car into the yard at Tinnel Ln striking a rose bush and landscaping stones. Miss Brown jumped out of the car and started hitting victim in the face and grabbed her hair.

victim had a small cut on her left cheek and some bumps on her head. Miss Brown left the scene and drove down the street to the empty lot next to Highway 11 East. Miss Brown did leave the scene of accident with property damage. Miss Brown was ran with dispatch for her license status. Miss Brown came back revoked for DUI. Miss Brown did have a order for restricted license but was not driving to work or church at this time. This did put the victim in fear for her life and caused injury to her. Miss Brown was placed under arrest without incident and transported to the Loudon County Jail. A neighbor came running up from his house at Tinnel Ln and saw the fight. Mr. Robert Brabson jumped out of the passenger front seat of the car and showed a large black knife in a case that was on his

belt. Mr. Brabson put his hand on the knife and told the neighbor that he did not know who he was and he would use the knife. The neighbor stated that he was in fear for his safety. Mr. Brabson never pulled the knife but kept his hand on the knife the whole time he was out of the car. Mr. Brabson left the scene in the Honda and when officers found the car at Highway 11 East Mr. Brabson was outside the car putting his belt back on. The Knife was found in the trunk of the car and was taken for evidence. Mr. Brabson was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail by Deputy Brad Rayfield LCSO, without incident.
