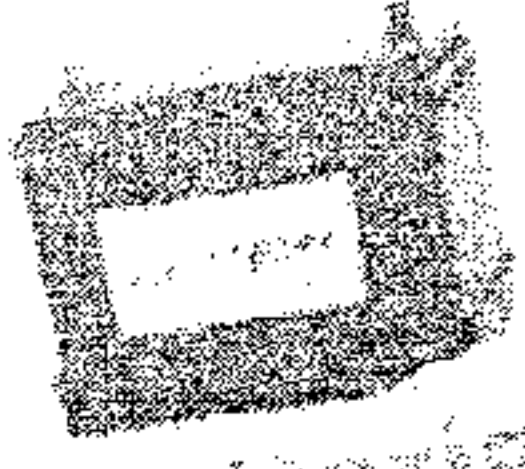
recovered inside the vehicle were five packs of steaks that Basler stated she had stolen from Ingles in the same date. Basler was taken into custody.
