Misti Dotson, 40, Coyote Canyon Way Knoxville, was charged with Criminal trespass, Disorderly conduct, and Poss. of SCH. III drug. Deputy JC Schultz LCSO, answered a disturbance call at Eleven Estates Drive. Upon arrival Deputy came in contact with Misty Dawn Dotson whom was yelling and crying loudly in the front lawn/parking area. After providing a breath sample Knowles admit that he felt intoxicated and he normally drinks beer not vodka as well as he was drinking due to a personal issue that he is currently having.
