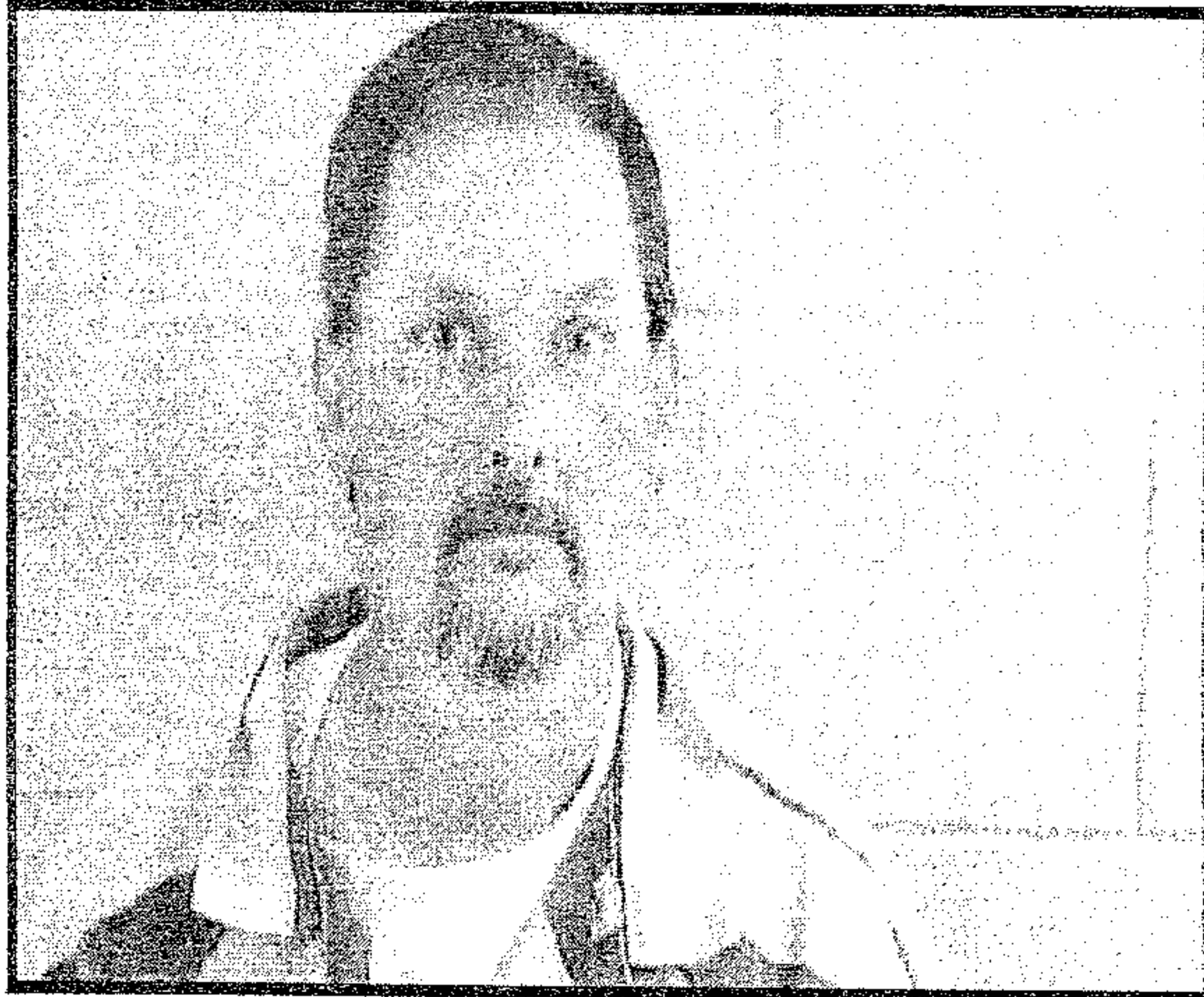
## Petty thief charged after stealing from Loudon church
