Thousands in damage appears to be work of teens

Abbott Road Lenoir City, Vandalism. 06/12/2014 Deputy Brandon Burley LCSO, conducted a traffic stop on a red vehicle on Abbott Road. This vehicle did have the passenger side brake light out, and attempted to avoid this Deputy by circling Abbott's Crossing two

times before stopping at Abbott Road. During the initial approach this Deputy did observe a black baseball bat in the bed of the vehicle. This Deputy then made contact with the driver, as well as the three passengers. After determining that all four passengers were under the age of 18 this Deputy then

spoke with suspects who advised that all of the vehicles occupants as well as one female they had just dropped off had been striking mailboxes with the baseball bat, as well as they had shot multiple cars and road signs with paintball guns. Two paintball guns, as well as the black bat were recovered.

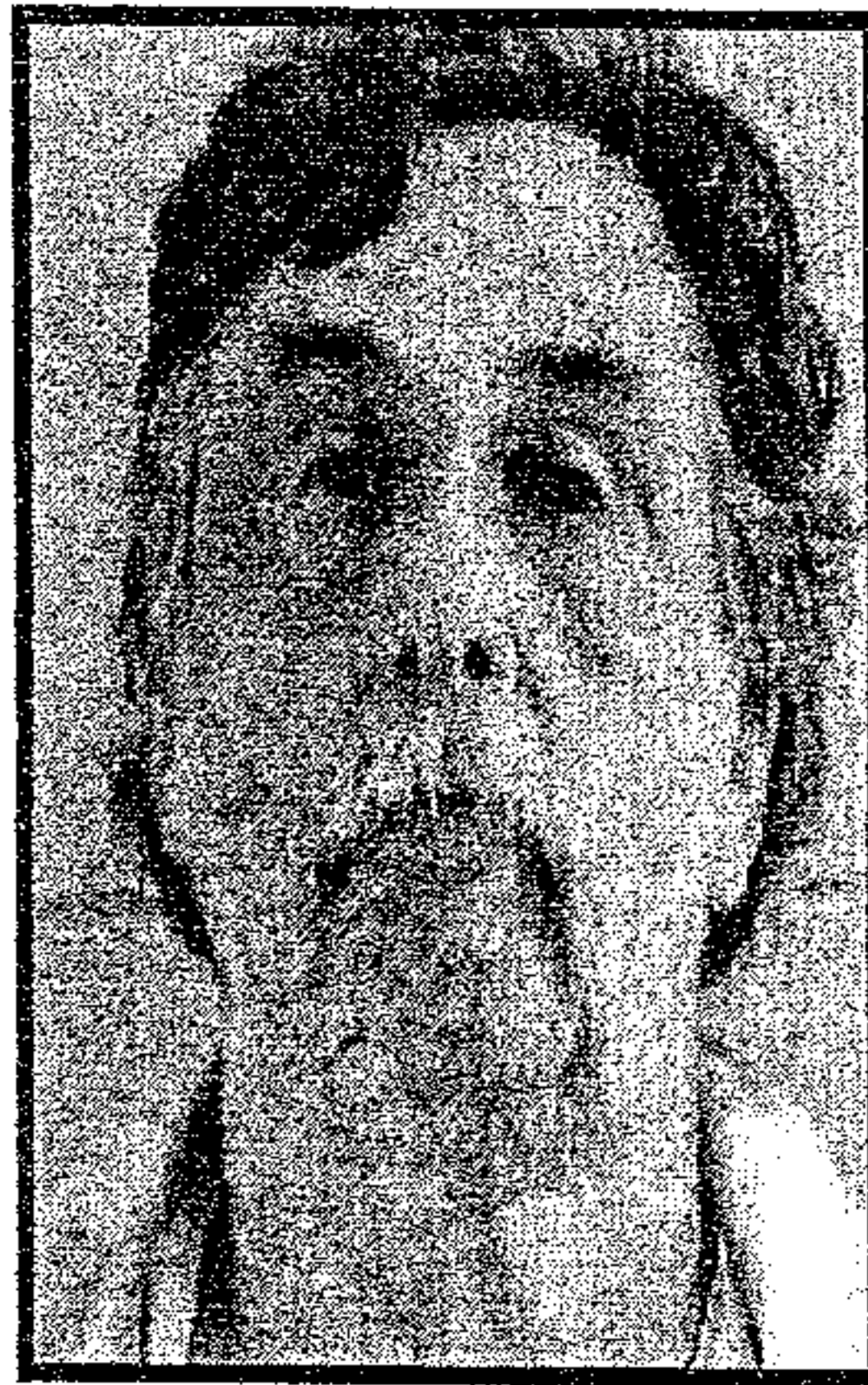

What is Your Mission?

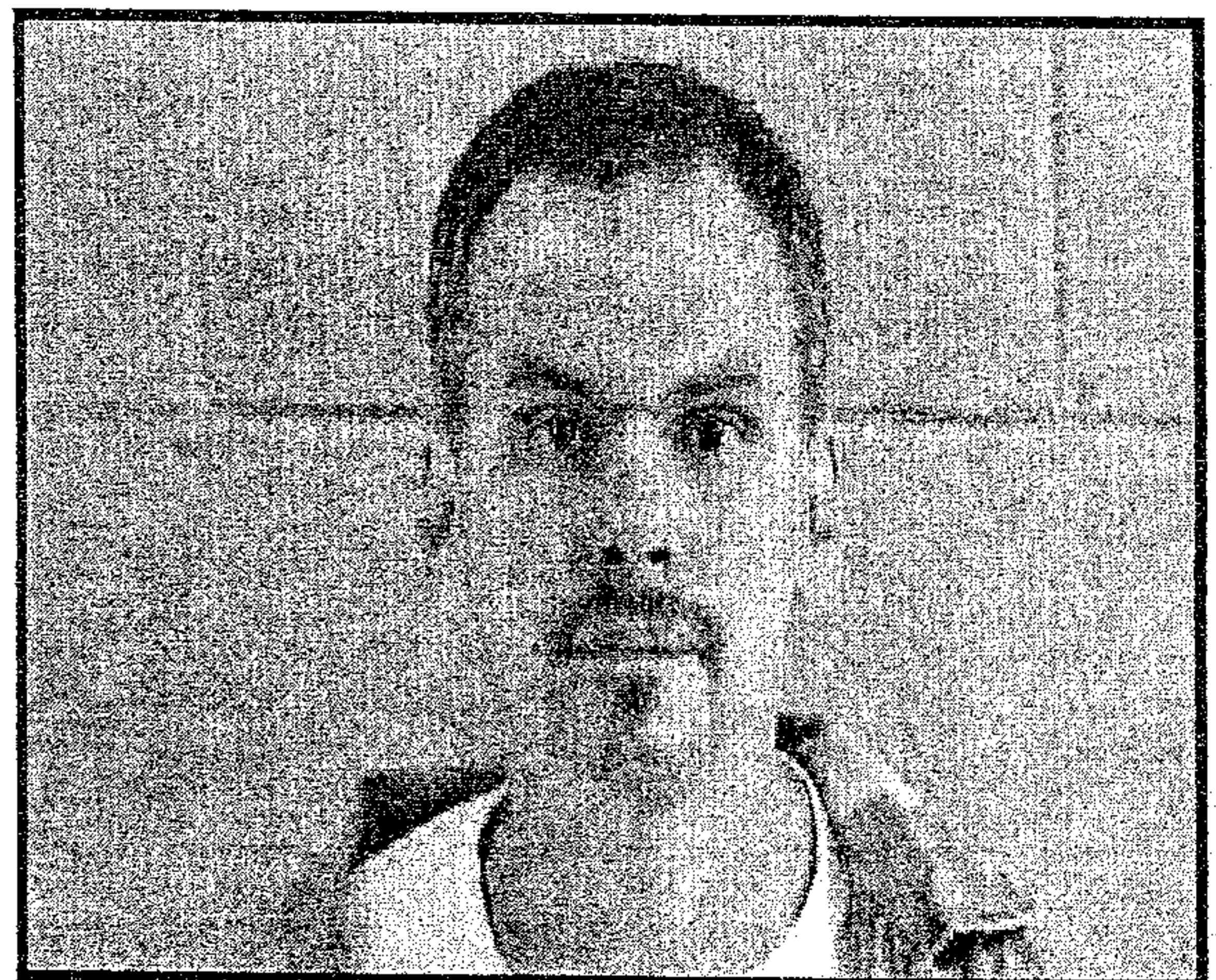

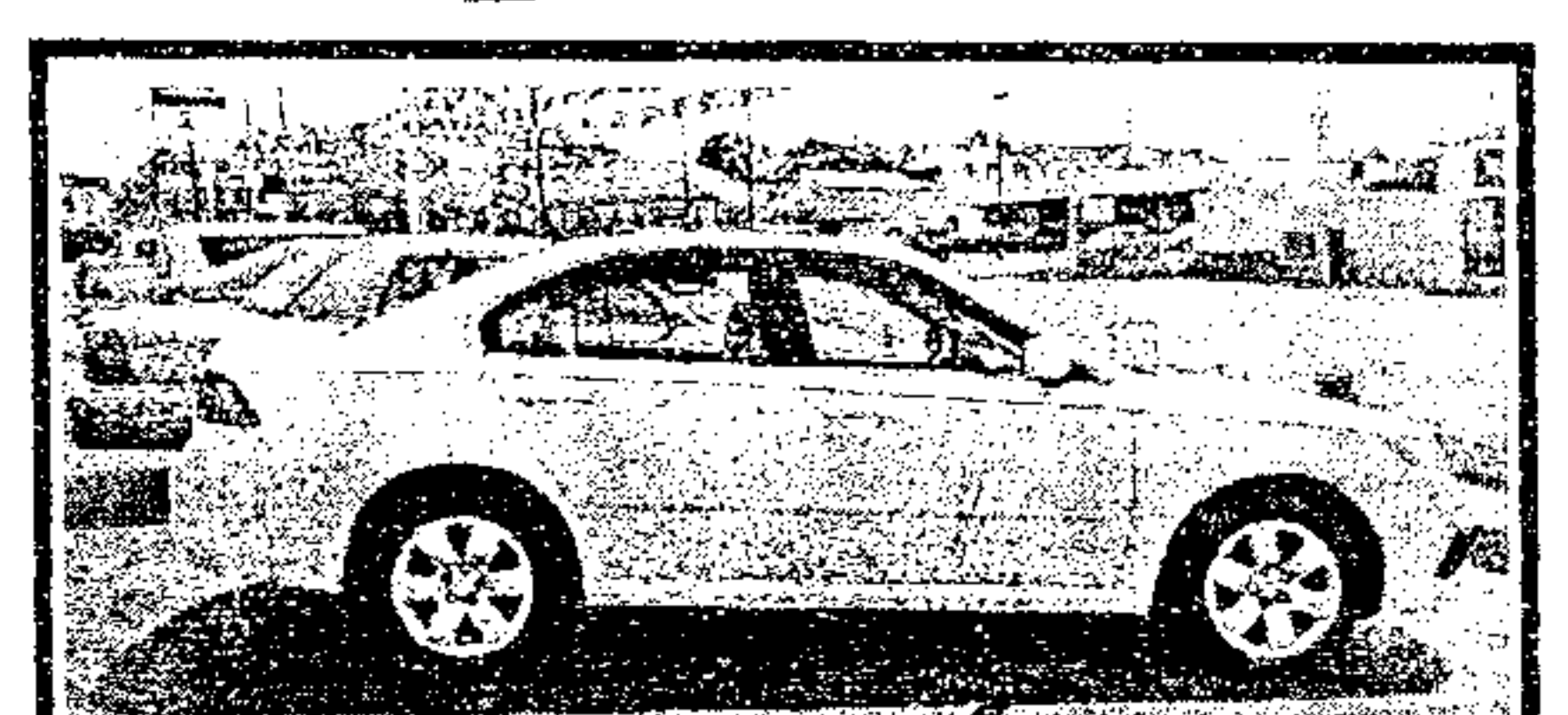

on your heart? Could it have been the Creator of the universe trying to include you in a small part of His BIG plan?

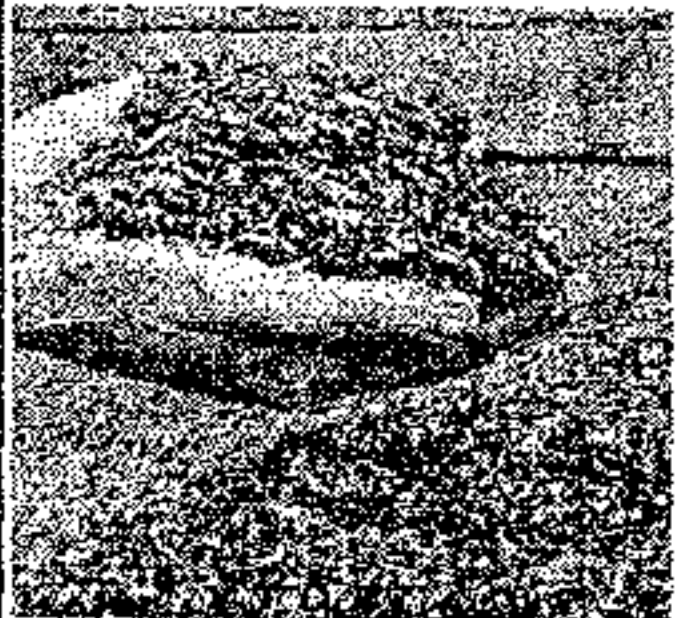
received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized.

To summarize this
