All three males appeared to be under the age of 21 and there was a very strong odor of alcohol coming from all three males. Deputy also observed approximately 30 empty 12 oz beers in the immediate vicinity. All three males are under the age of 21 and admit to having drank multiple beers each. 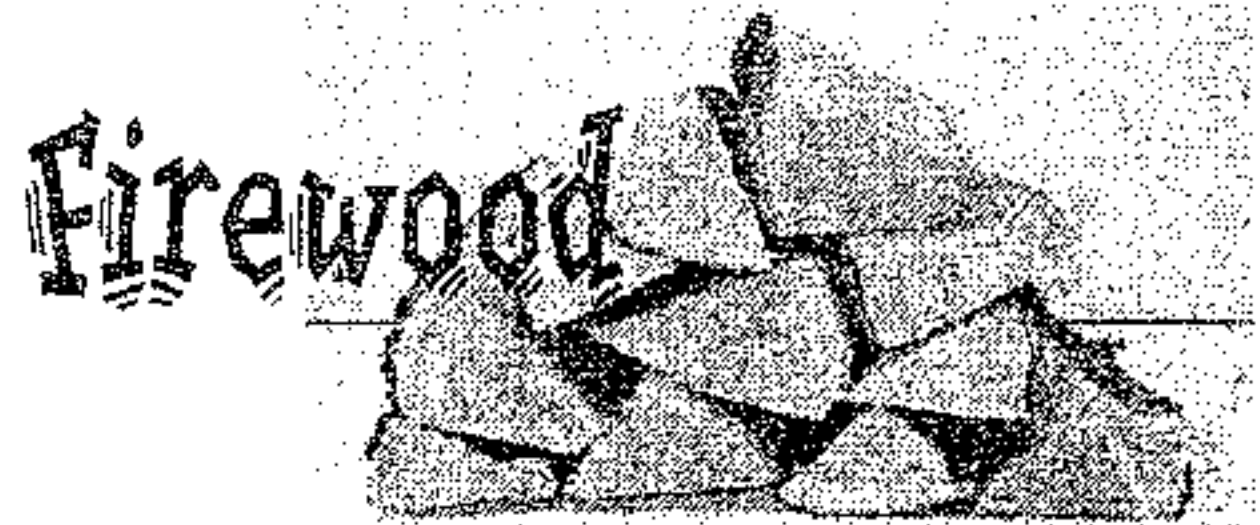
tial contact with Finger.

Deputy did locate multiple items commonly associated with marijuana including: a tin with a small amount of a green leafy plant like substance inside, a pocket knife with images of marijuana on them, a pack of zig zag rolling papers, a pack of black and mild sweets, as well as one metal pipe with a small amount of a green leafy plant like substance inside.
