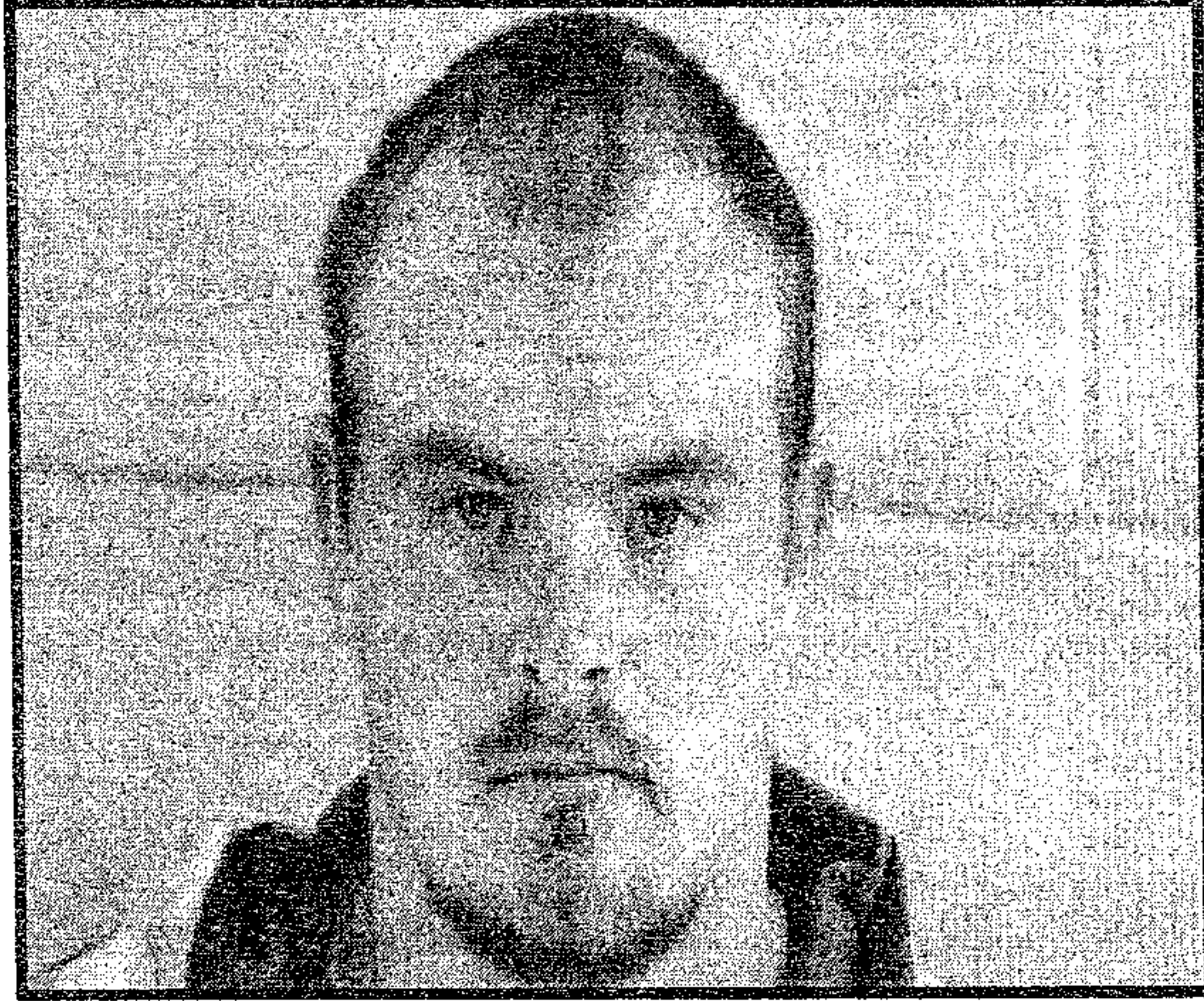

Sexual battery charge for Loudon man by LPD

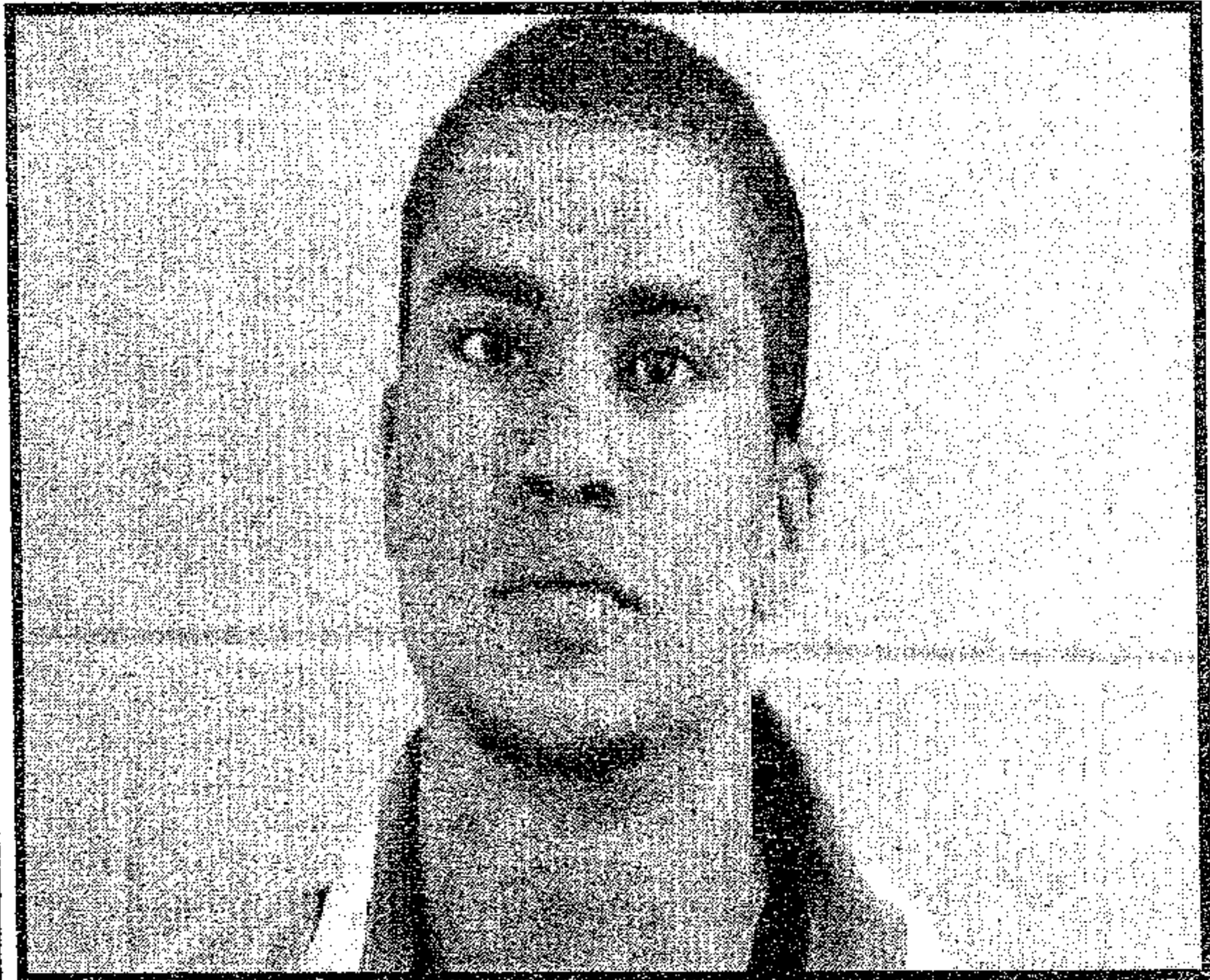
