Arrest made in Credit Union Robbery

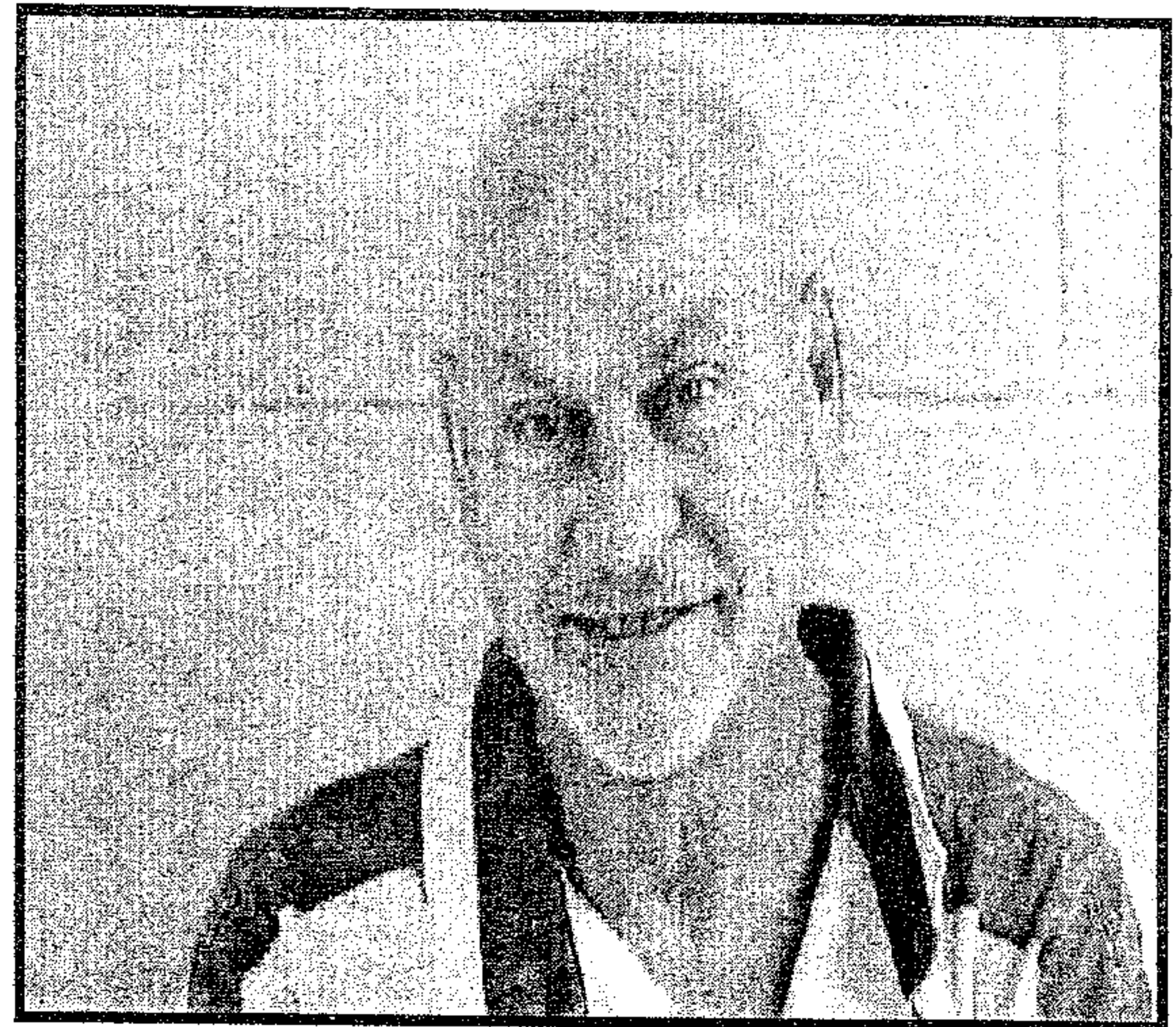

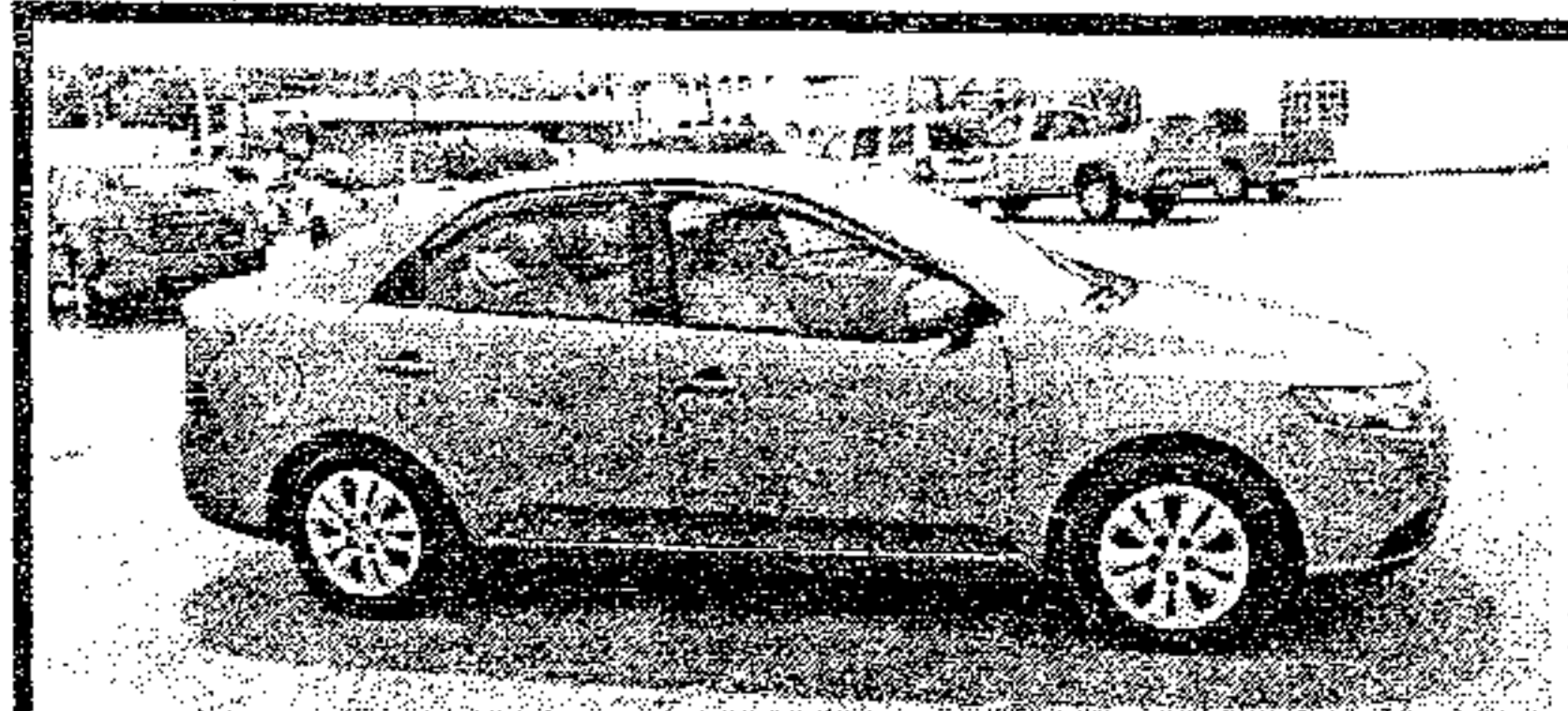

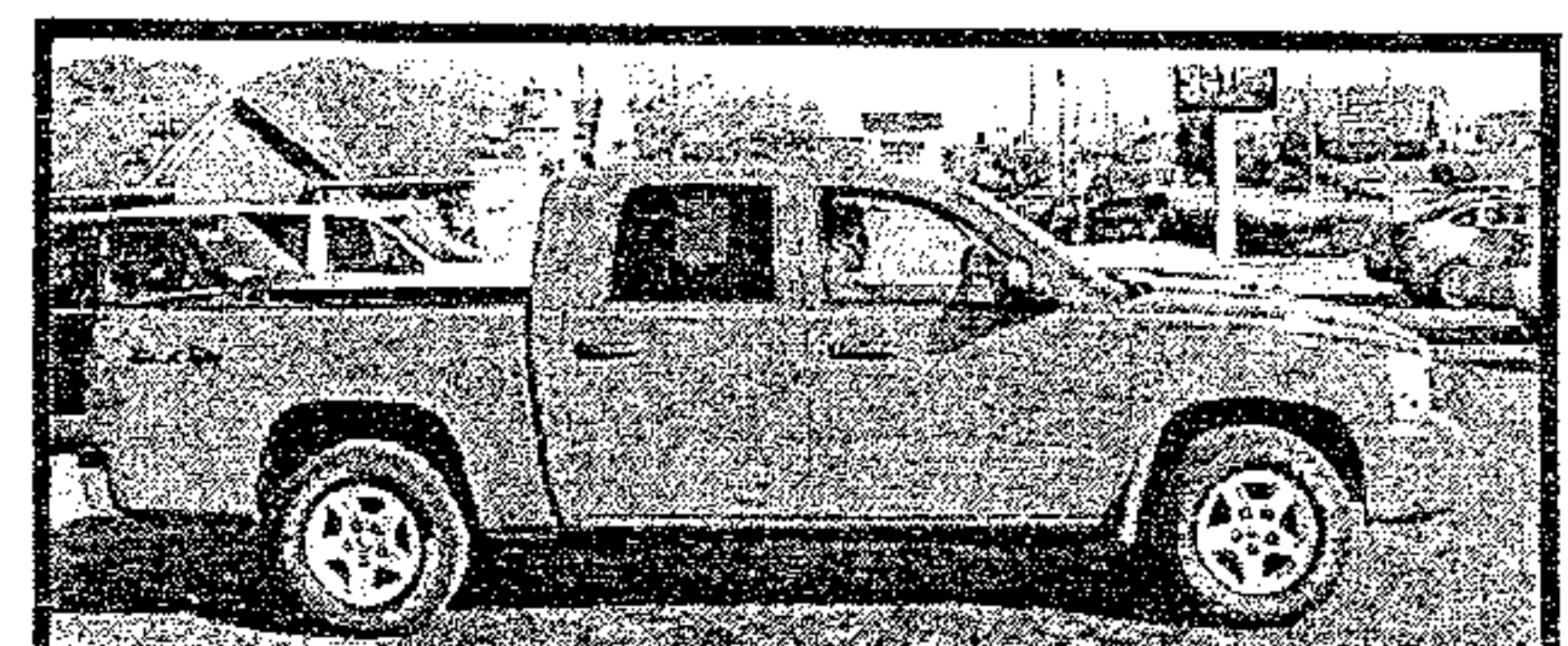

Loudon ER at 0340 hours which was 2 hours and

15 minutes after our initial contact. Deputy did after arresting West for driving under the influence and then spoke with Edwards. Edwards admit to having provided West with the keys to operate her motor vehicle (the afore mentioned vehicle) Edwards had knowledge that West had been drinking as she had been drinking with West throughout the evening. Edwards was the owner of the vehicle which she gave \$2,500 for to her father. Edwards knowing that West had been drinking alcohol did then provided West the ability to operate the motor vehicle. Deputy Brandon Burley LCSO, made the arrest.
