**Loan officer pleads guilty to conspiracy to commit wire fraud**

On July 29, 2014, Paulynn Wright, 42, of Knoxville, Tenn., pleaded guilty in U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee at Knoxville, to conspiracy to commit wire fraud. Sentencing has been set for 2:00 p.m., on Dec. 3, 2014, before the Honorable Thomas A. Varlan, Chief U.S. District Judge.

Wright faces a potential term of up to 20 years in prison, along with the forfei-

ture of any proceeds of the offense and the obligation to pay restitution.

In a plea agreement on file with the U.S. District Court, Wright admitted to conspiring with co-defendants Joyce Allen, Kay Thomas and Dona Rector to obtain a mortgage loan by providing false information to a lender. This information consisted of an asset verification letter from Allen that falsely stated that Wright had an investment with Benchmark Capital.

The indictment against Wright was the result of an investigation by the Internal Revenue Service, U.S. Postal Inspection Service, and Federal Bureau

of Investigation. Assistant United States Attorney Frank M. Dale, Jr. represents the United States. **Under the limit but also underage**

Michael Martin, 19, N Monticello Drive Knoxville, was charged with Underage Consumption, Underage Driving while Intoxicated, and Lighting Devices on Vehicle.

Taylor Currier, 19, MapleCrest Lane Knoxville, was charged with Underage Consumption and Public Intoxication. On 07/26/2014 Deputy Brandon Burley LCSO, did observe a red Ford F150 on East Coast Tellico Parkway with only one operational rear taillight. Deputy did conduct a





How much alcohol he had consumed and he also stated "3 beers" but Currier denies smoking marijuana. Deputy then had Martin to exit the vehicle and to perform standardized field sobriety tasks, which Martin did poorly on. Deputy did then speak to Currier who also had an odor of alcoholic beverage

upon his person which was more pronounced when Currier would speak. Currier was also unsteady on his feet and was a danger to himself and others. After being placed under arrest Michael Martin was read the Tennessee Implied Consent form which he agreed to provide a sample. While at the Loudon County Jail and

using the intoximeter Martin did blow a 0.077 BAC and a 0.078 BAC. Deputy Brandon Burley LCSO, made the arrest.

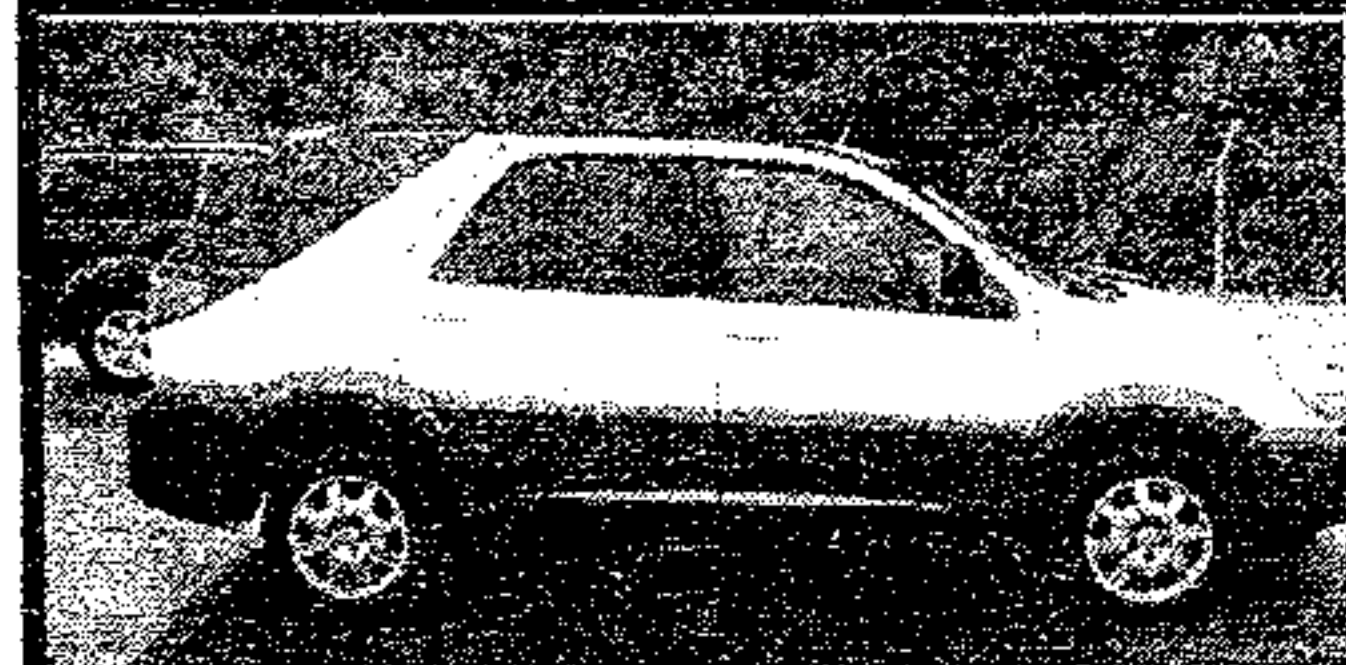
