ture of any proceeds of the offense and the obligation to pay restitution.

plea agreement on file with the U.S. District Court, Wright admitted to conspiring with codefendants Joyce Allen, Kay Thomas and Dona Rector to obtain a mortgage loan by providing false information to a lender. This information consisted of an asset verification letter from Allen that falsely stated that Wright had an investment with Benchmark Capital.

The indictment against Wright was the result of an investigation by the Internal Revenue Service, U.S. Postal Inspection Service, and Federal Bureau

of Investigation. Assistant United States Attorney Frank M. Dale, Jr. represents the United States. Under the limit but
