Kimberly Seiber, 41, McFerrin St. Woodbury, was charged with DUI, and Poss. of a SCH. IV Drug.

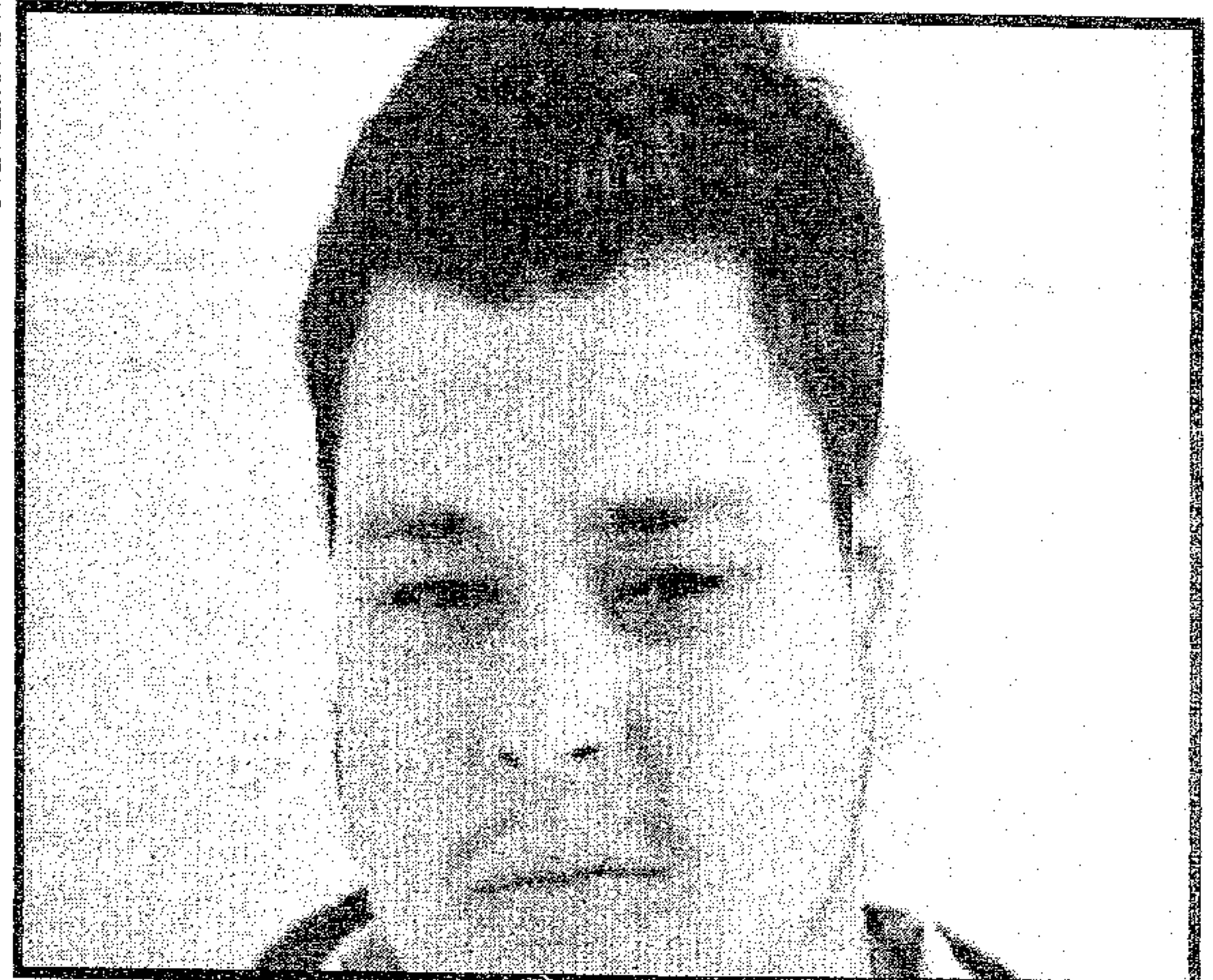

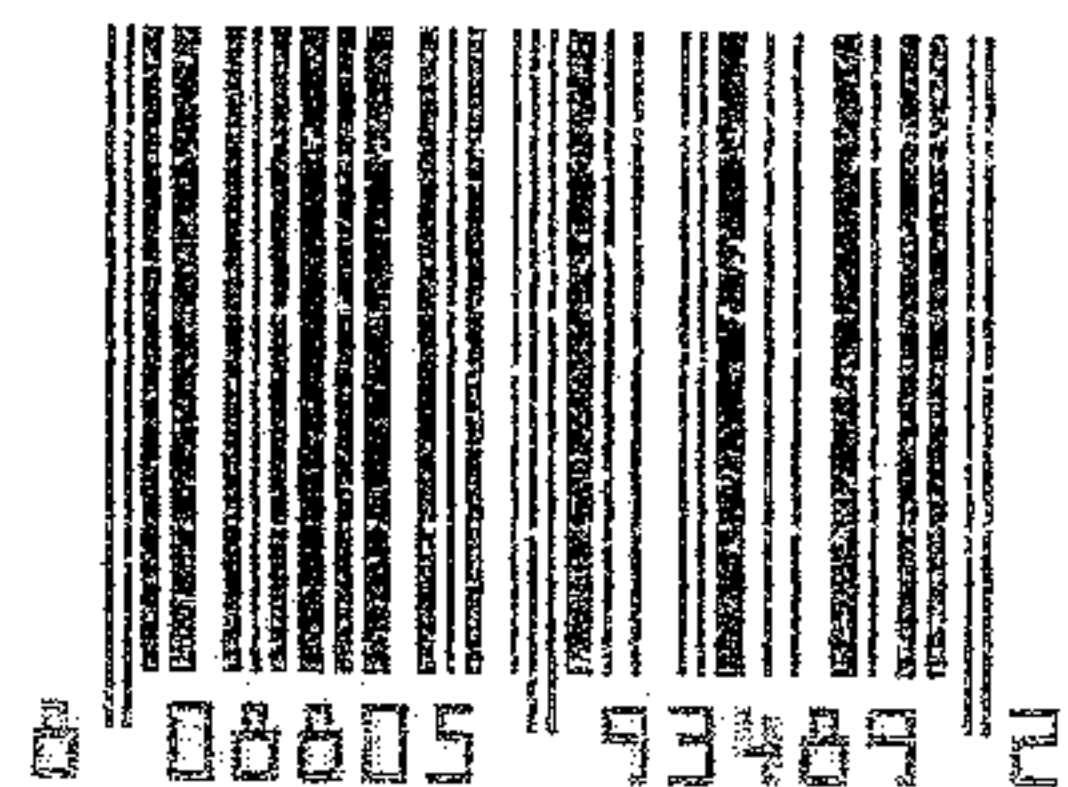

Deputy Brandon Burley LCSO, did respond to a report of a possible intoxicated driver at the Pilot in Lenoir City. The clerk had spoke to William Lopez who was purchasing alcohol and asked him on multiple occasions if he was going drive when he left. Lopez stated on multiple occasions that he was not; however, the clerk did inform Deputy Hutchens of his intoxicated state.

Deputy Hutchens then observed Lopez get in the driver seat of his vehicle and start the ignition in the Pilot parking lot. Deputy Hutchens and Deputy Burley did conduct a traffic stop on the Lopez vehicle a red Toyota Celica in the Pilot parking lot. Lopez who had a strong odor of alcoholic beverage upon his person with red / watery bloodshot eyes, slurred speech stated that he had 6 beers then 8 beers and eventually 9 beers, during

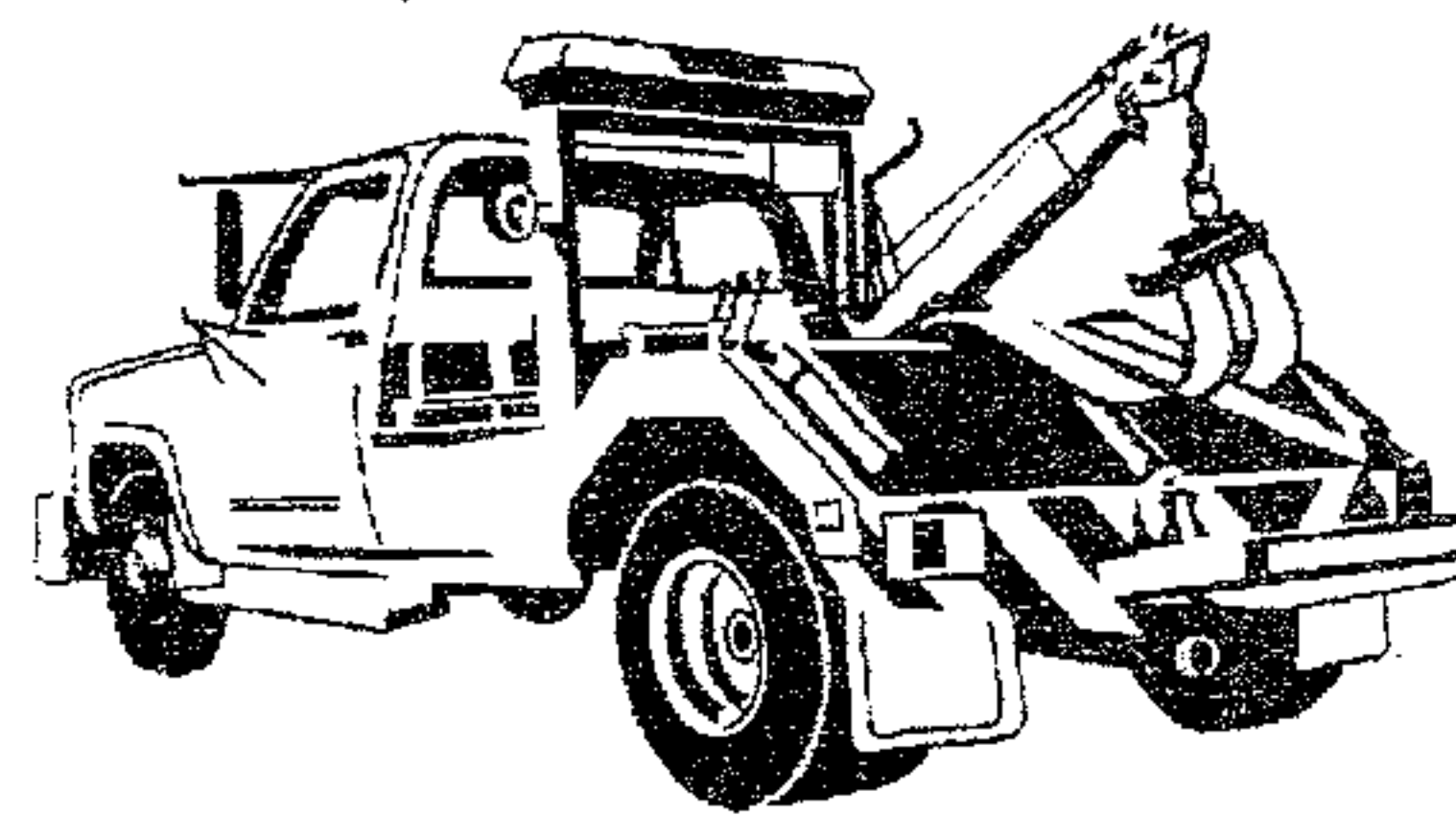

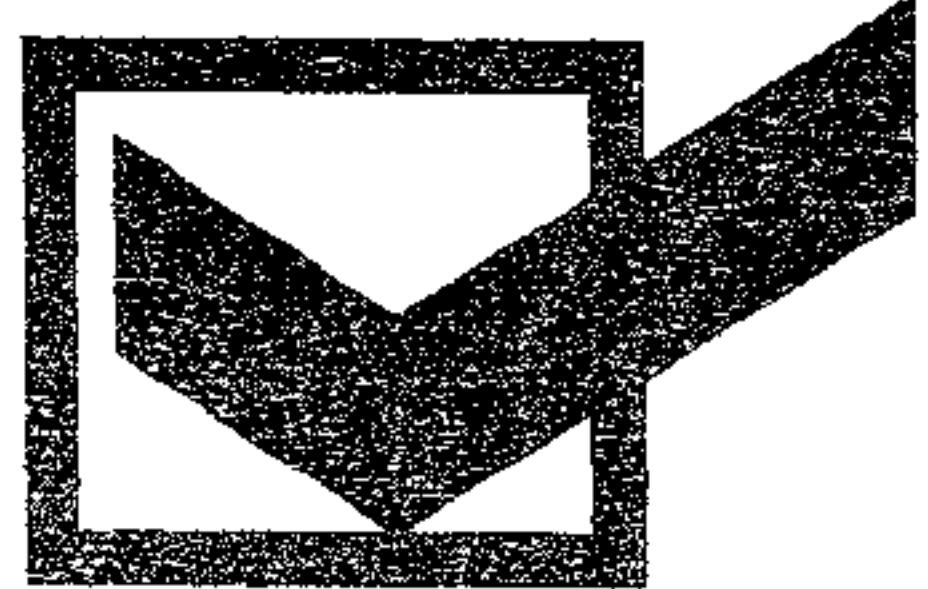
