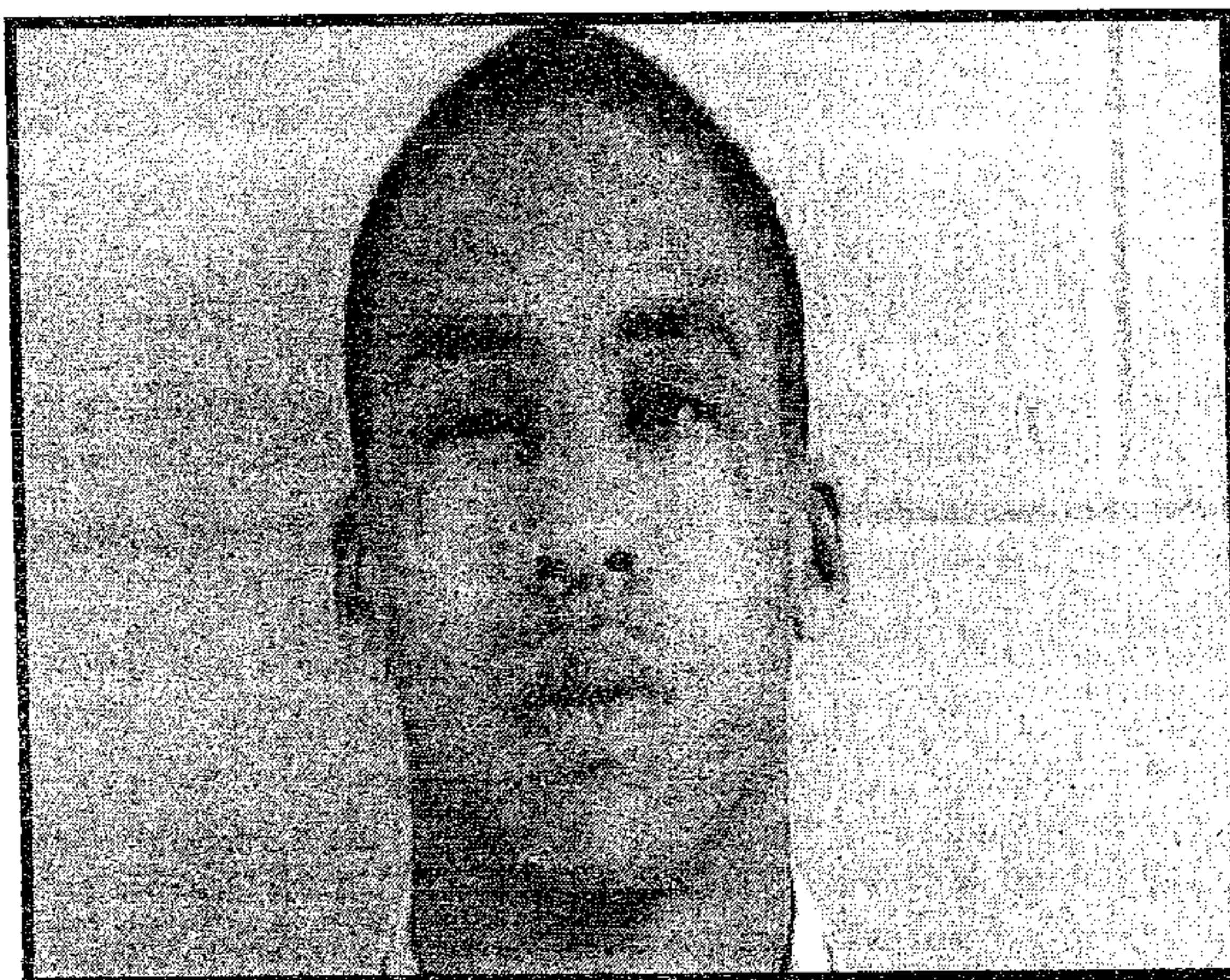

## Morton sentenced to over 7 years in prison for distribution of child pornography

On Sept. 3, 2014, James Robert Morton, 46, of Rockford, Tenn., was sentenced to serve 88 months in prison by the Honorable Leon Jordan, U.S. District Judge. Morton pleaded guilty in August 2013 to federal charges of knowingly distributing child pornography.

Upon his release from prison, Morton will

serve a life term of supervised release during which his activities will be supervised by the U.S. Probation Office. Morton was further ordered to pay \$4,000 in restitution to victims whose digital images were distributed by him. Also, as a result of the conviction, the federal Sex Offender Registration and Notification
