Krzysztof Romot, 25, Mealer Road Lenoir City, was charged with DUI.

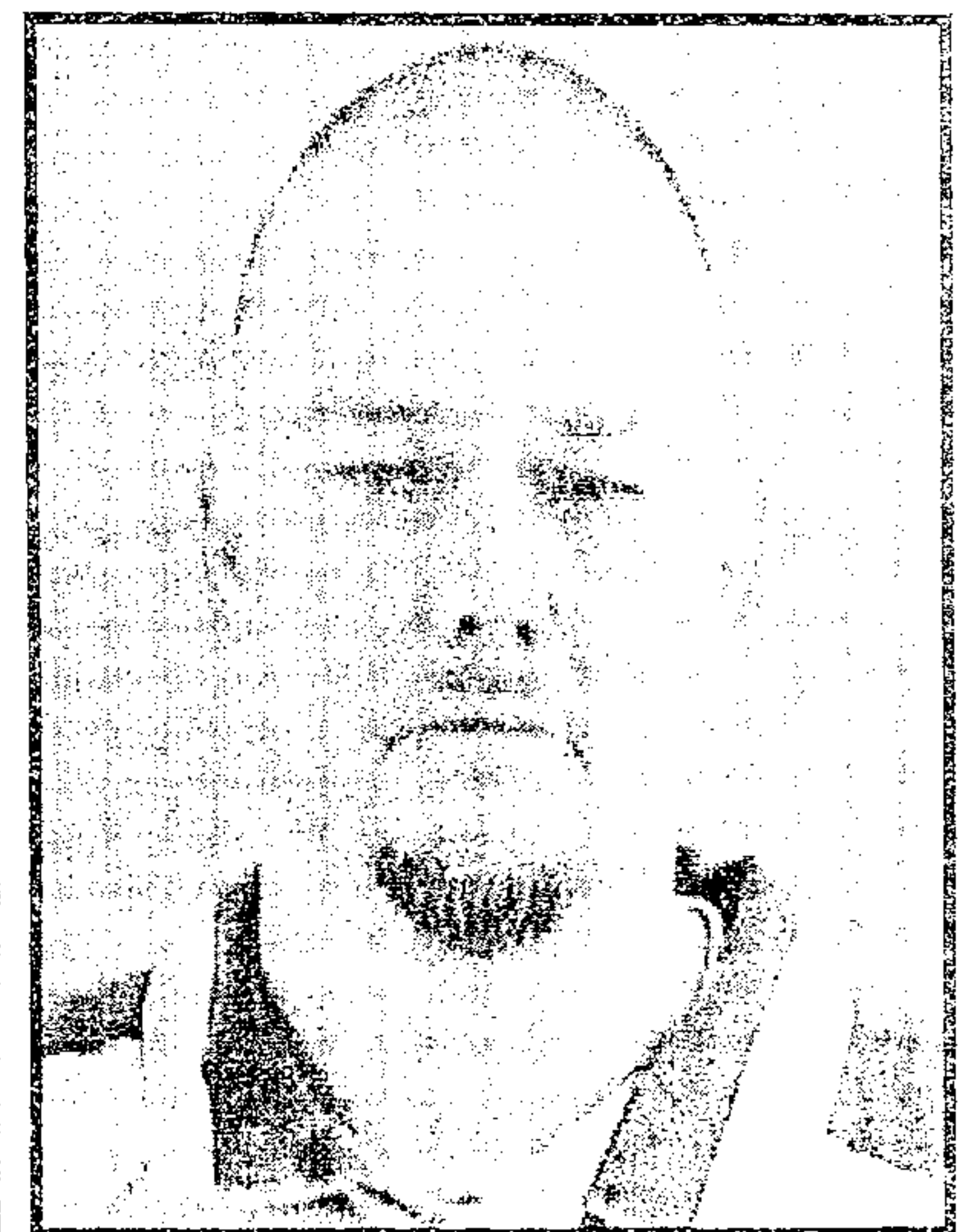

Officer observed Mr. Coker stumbling around outside and screaming profanities. Officer found him to be drunk and a public nuisance. He was

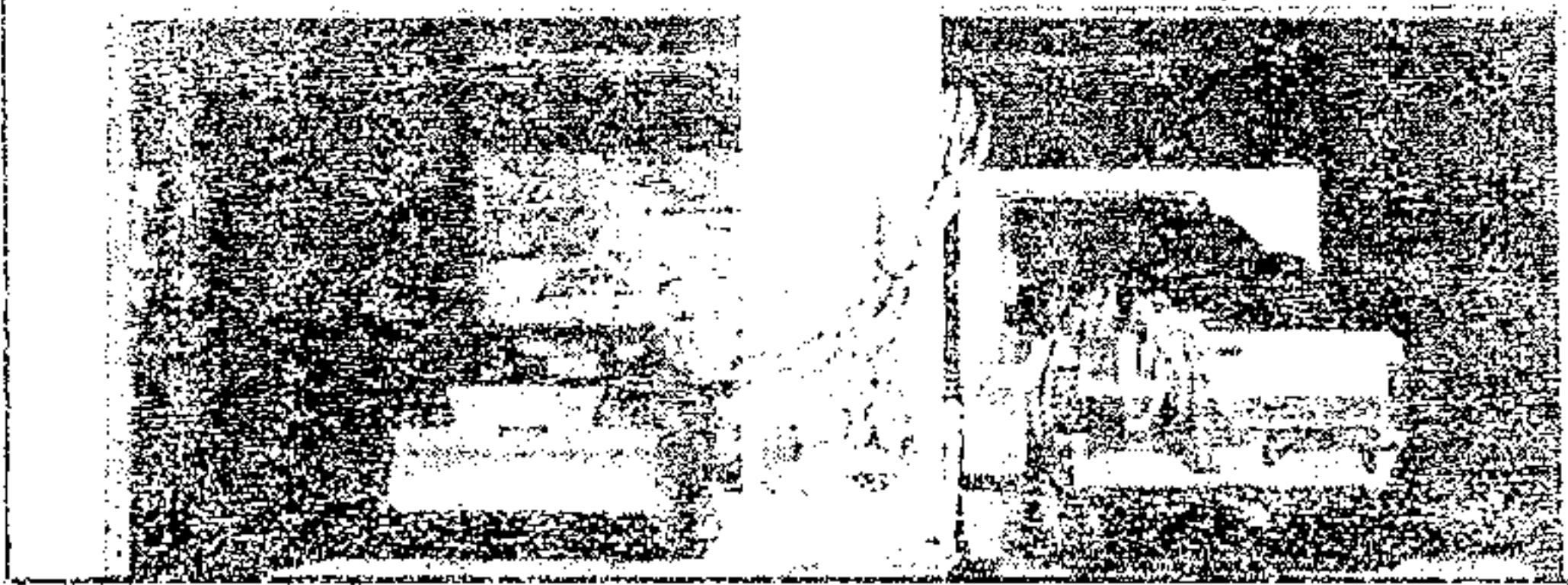
unable to care for himself and posed a threat to himself and others if left in his condition. He was arrested for public intoxication and transported to jail.

Minor

Kody Millikan, 23, Sandpiper Drive Vonore, was charged with Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor.

According to the report, Deputy Chris Hutchens did observe the above vehicle traveling south on Hwy 411 at what appeared to be a high rate of speed. Deputy in vehicle did initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle at the above location and did identify the driver as Kody Millikan, and he did have a female passenger who was found to be 17 years old.

Millikan stated that he and his passenger were returning to his residence from a party at a cabin in Gatlinburg. Millikan's passenger who he described as his "friend" did have an odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and appeared intoxicated. Both stated she had consumed a "few" drinks on this evening. Also inside of Millikan's vehicle was found

a 6 pack of beer, one of which were open and half consumed that his passenger had been drinking. Millikan was arrested for contributing to the delinquency of the minor and transported to the Loudon County Jail. Deputy Chris Hutchens LCSO, made the arrest.

Duo

Paige Rogers, 41, County-side Way Georgia, was charged with Public Intoxication, and Simple Possession of Drugs.

David Rogers, 35 County-side Way Georgia, was charged with Public Intoxication.

Deputy Matt Fagiana was on routine patrol on Interstate 75 inside Loudon County, Tennessee. Deputy was stationary on the NB shoulder at the 72 MM, when he observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed in the fast lane of the NB

lanes. Deputy utilized my radar to confirm what he thought to be a high rate of speed. Radar revealed a speed of 85 mph in a posted 70 mph zone. Deputy initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle at the 74 MM. Upon approaching the vehicle, Deputy noticed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. Deputy also noticed several empty "Budweiser" cans sitting in the passenger floor board. The driver, a female later identified as Paige R. Rodgers, admitted that she and her passenger, David M. Rodgers, had been drinking beer since about 1700 hours this evening, prior to leaving Georgia and traveling into Tennessee. Female subject was given a variety of SFSTs and was found to be unable to perform those as instructed and poorly. She was taken into custody and charged with Public Intoxication. The male passenger, David M. Rodgers, was removed from the vehicle

so that it could be inventoried and towed to a safe location. The male subject, who also admitted to drinking about "8-10" beers prior to being stopped, was too intoxicated to leave in public, on the interstate, without possible being a harm to himself. He was taken into custody and also charged with public intoxication. Upon searching the female subject at the LCSO intake facility, she was found to be in possession of a bag of green leafy like substance believed to be marijuana (sch VI). Female subject was also charged with simple possession/casual exchange. Deputy Matt Fagiana LCSO, made the arrest.

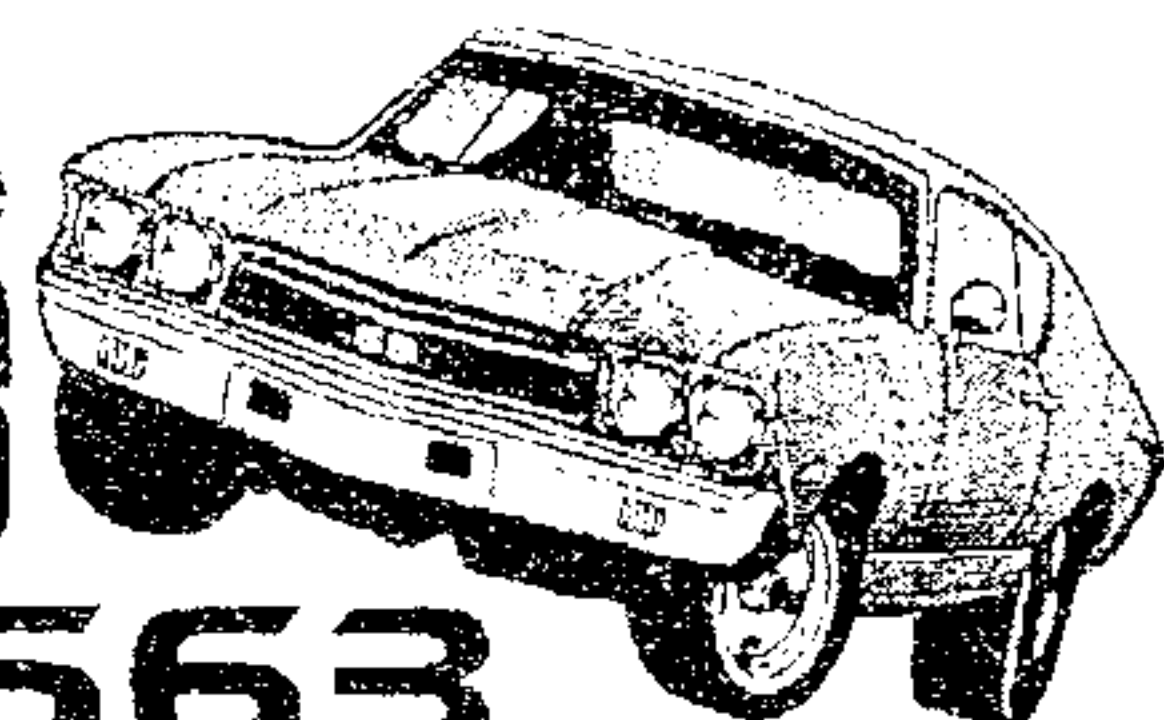

Devanta Mader, 19, Markwood Road Loudon, was charged with Underage Consumption, and Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor.

Ryan Peterson, 18, Atlas Lane Knoxville, was charged with Poss. of Drug Para., Simple Possession, and "Underage Consumption, see narrative on Devanta Mader.

According to the report, Deputy M. Fagiana LCSO, responded to a residence is which other deputies had knowledge that there was numerous under age minors drinking alcohol and using marijuana. Upon arriving at the residence, Deputy knocked on the door and were met by Offender #1, Devanta Mader. Mader, who we had a previous encounter with just one week prior for supplying alcohol to under age individuals. Mader had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about his person and red watery bloodshot eyes. Mader is 19 yoa, and admitted to having consumed some alcohol. Mader was placed under arrest for Under Age Consumption. Of-

fender #1 then asked to be able to go back inside his residence and get some clothes since he was in his boxers, prior to being taken to Intake. We explained that we would have to accompany him into the residence for our safety and since he was already in custody, to which he agreed. Upon entering the house, we also made contact with Offender #1 father and homeowner. The homeowner immediately offered consent to search the house for more under age individuals as well as any alcohol or illegal drugs. Several more under age minors were found to be under the influence of an alcoholic beverage and or marijuana, and admitted to the use of those. Upon contact with Offender # 2, Ryan Paul Peterson, he admitted to having illegal drugs, and handed over approx. 4-6 grams of a green leafy like substance believed to be marijuana, a grinder with marijuana residue and a pipe also containing marijuana residue. Peterson was placed in custody and charged with Simple Possession / Casual Exchange of marijuana. Mader was

also charged with contributing to the delinquency of a minor after it was determined that this was the second known "party" that he

had thrown within a week where under age minors, some as low as 16 years of age, were given alcohol and/or drugs.

Both Peterson and Mader were placed in custody and transported to Loudon Jail. Deputy Matt Fagiana LCSO, made the arrest.

Deputy asked Mr. Romot how much he had to drink at which time he stated about three or four beers. Mr. Romot also had a hard time remembering where he lived.

Deputy then asked Mr. Romot to exit the vehicle. While speaking with Mr. Romot Deputy could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person. Deputy asked Mr. Romot if he was willing to do some field sobriety task at which time he stated yes. Mr. Romot did perform poorly on all field sobriety task. 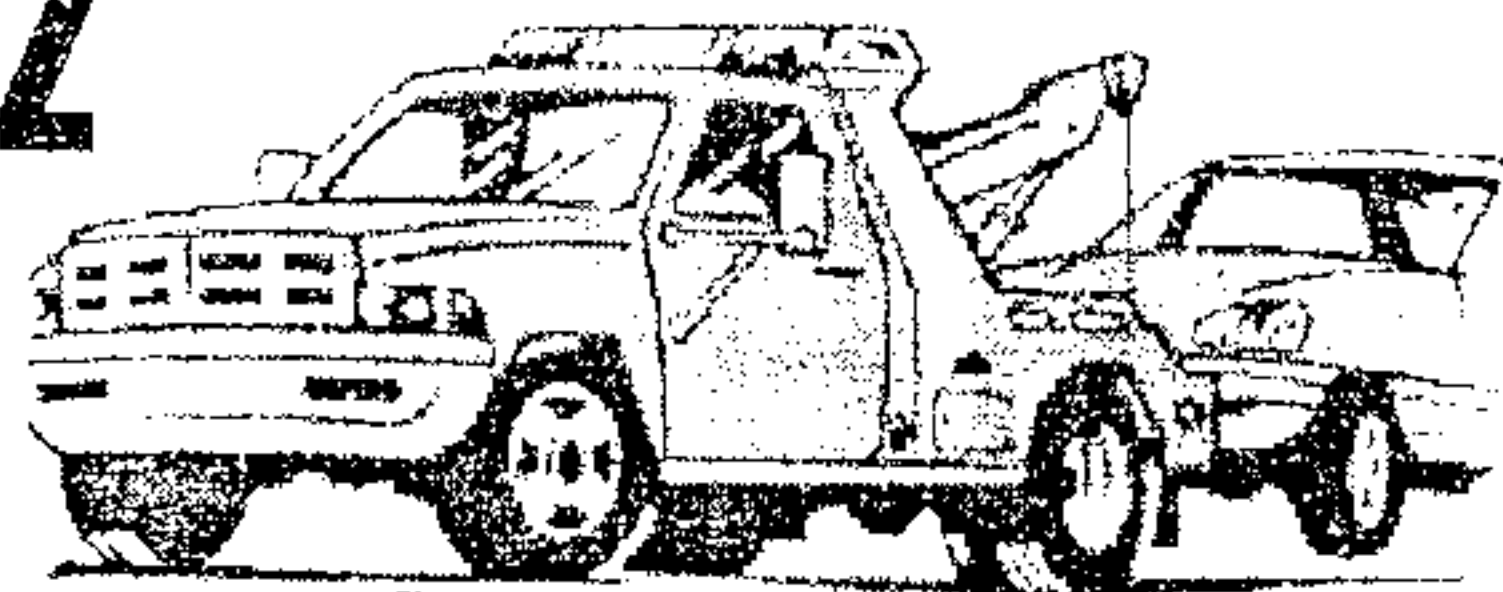
