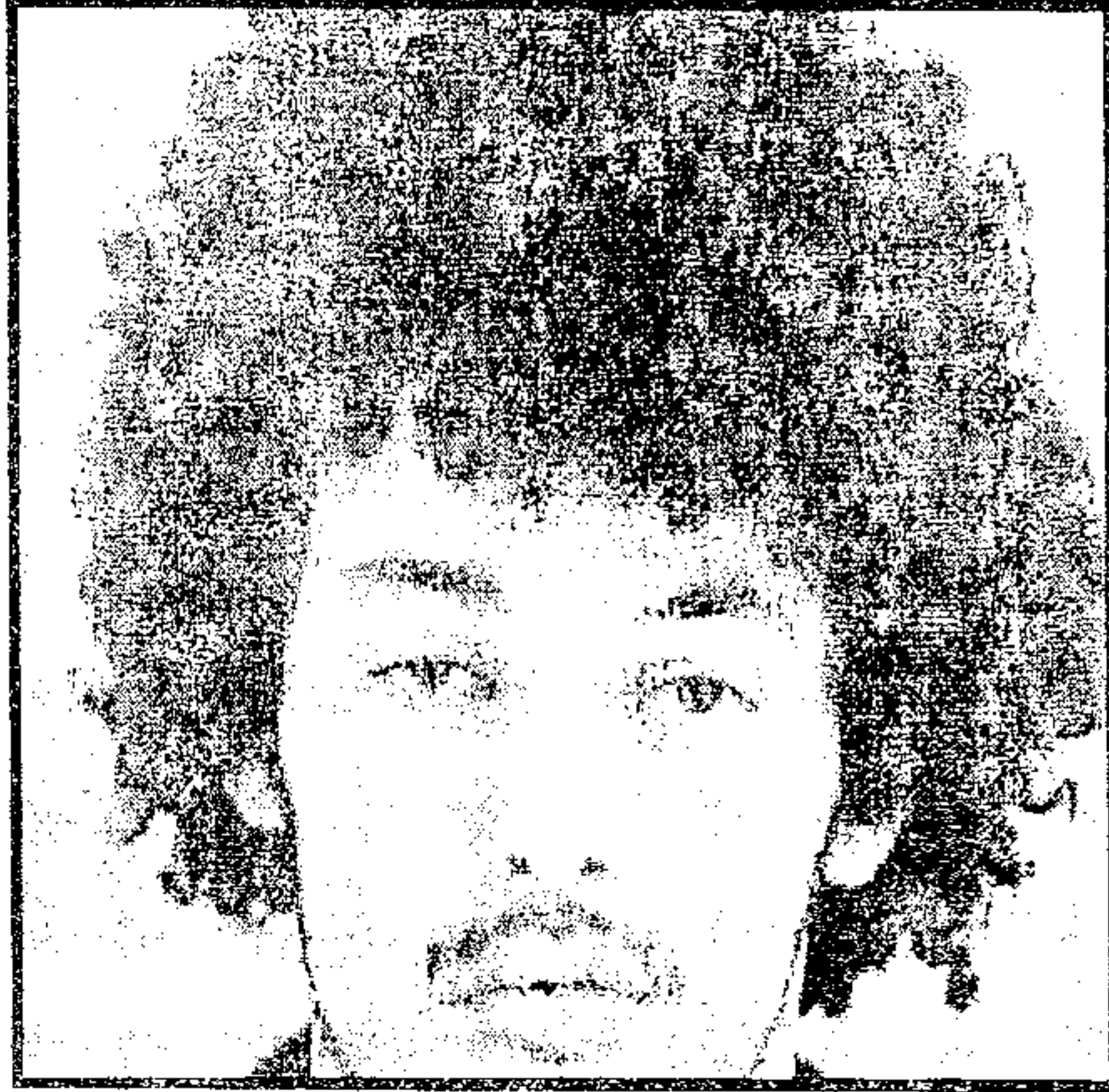

parolees for life outside of prison. The request I shared was for every willing Christian to pray that our new friend would make a decision to accept Jesus as his Savior.

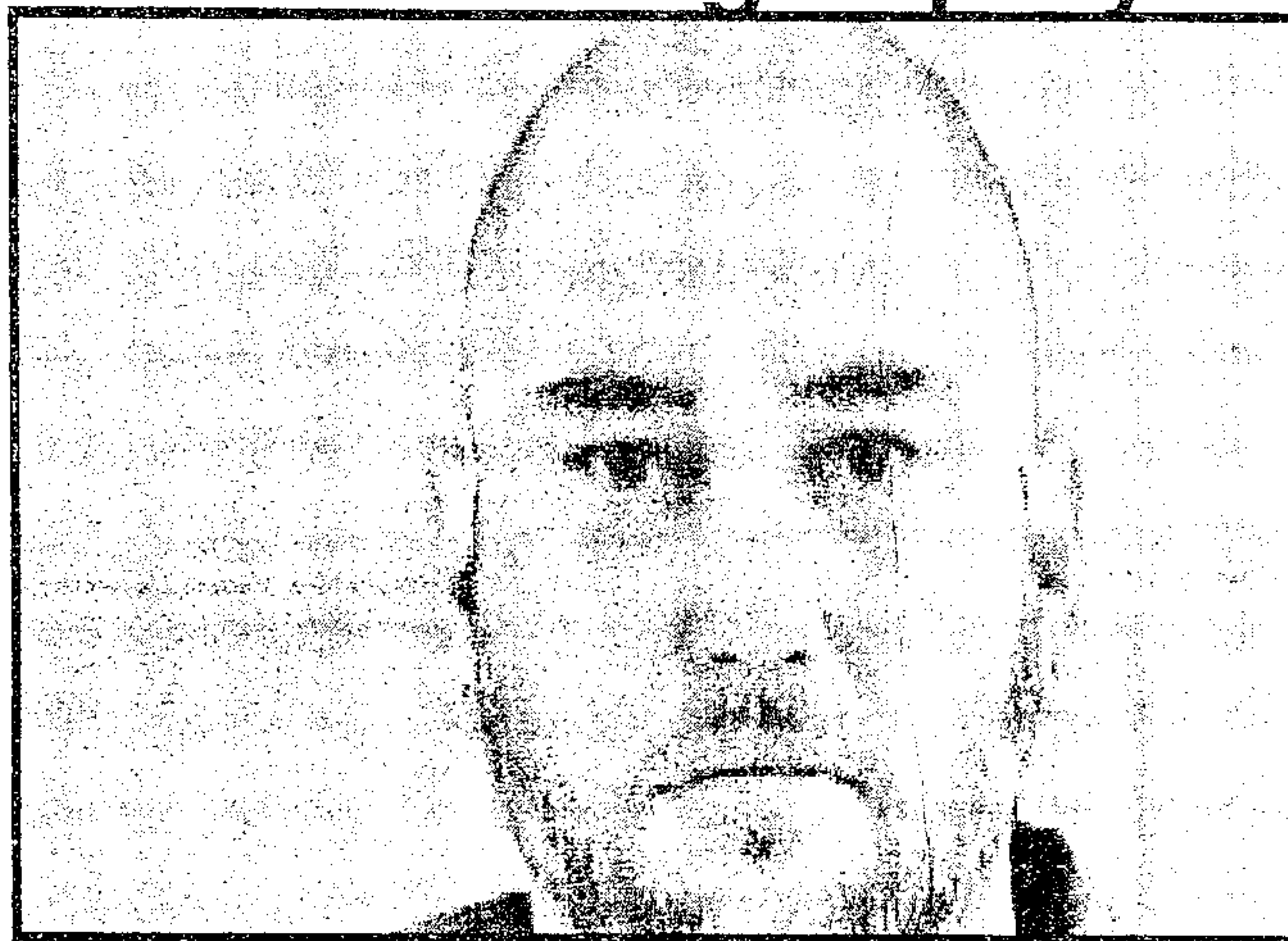

He attended church with us when permitted to do so by the pre-release and was finally paroled the day after Christmas. He has a job at a local fast food chain and has a small one bedroom apartment in town. He has continued to go to church with us and also attends our Sunday evening small group. He has consistently demonstrated his commitment to staying out of trouble and making the most of his life after many years of incarceration. Though his life was taking shape and we were proud of his accomplishments both in completing the pre-release program and as a new parolee, we continued to pray for his salvation.

I cannot count the times that our previous small group, church family, friends, fellow believers and hopefully some of you who read our prayer request article have lifted him up to the Lord in prayer. I suppose I have personally prayed for him well over a hundred times during this past year. I admit that I sometimes

questioned my efforts, thinking maybe I was not doing enough or saying the right things. I couldn't understand why my friend had not made a decision to secure eternal life in heaven by now.

I finally came to realize that it isn't my responsibility to save people in Montana. My responsibility is simply to honor God with my life and love on my friend like Jesus loves each of us. And to pray! I found peace in John 6:44, "No one can come to Me unless the Father, who sent Me draws him".

I am happy to report to you today that the Father chose this past Sunday to draw my friend Andrew to Himself for salvation and I am jumping up and down with joy that Andrew responded by invit-

ing Jesus into his heart in the living room of our small home in the North Valley of Helena, Montana! God may not answer prayers the moment that we send them up, but let me proclaim this day that God does answer our prayers!!!! 
will be there as well.

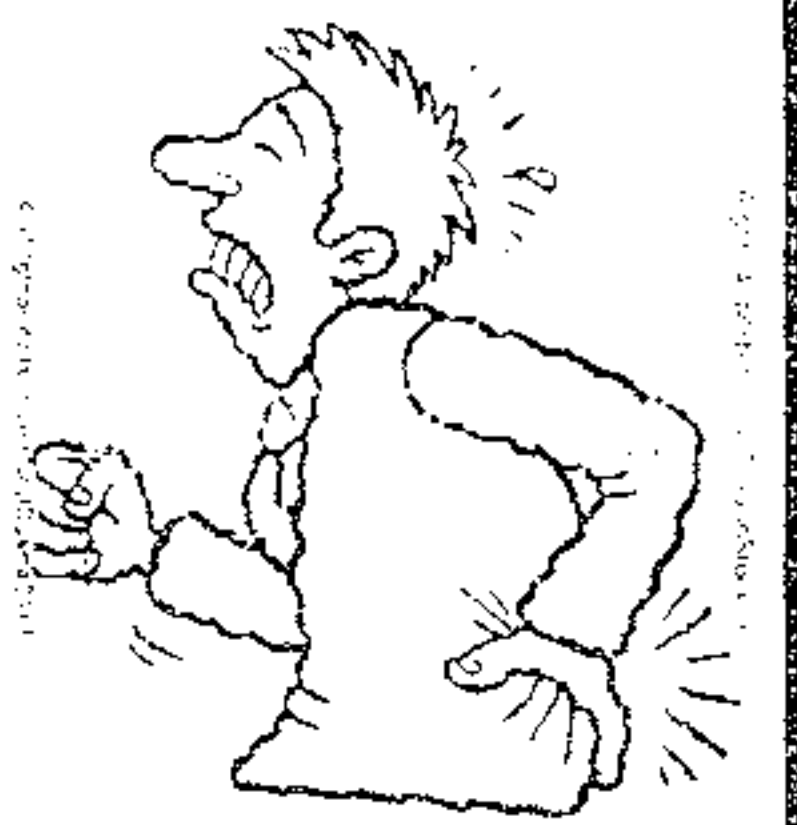
