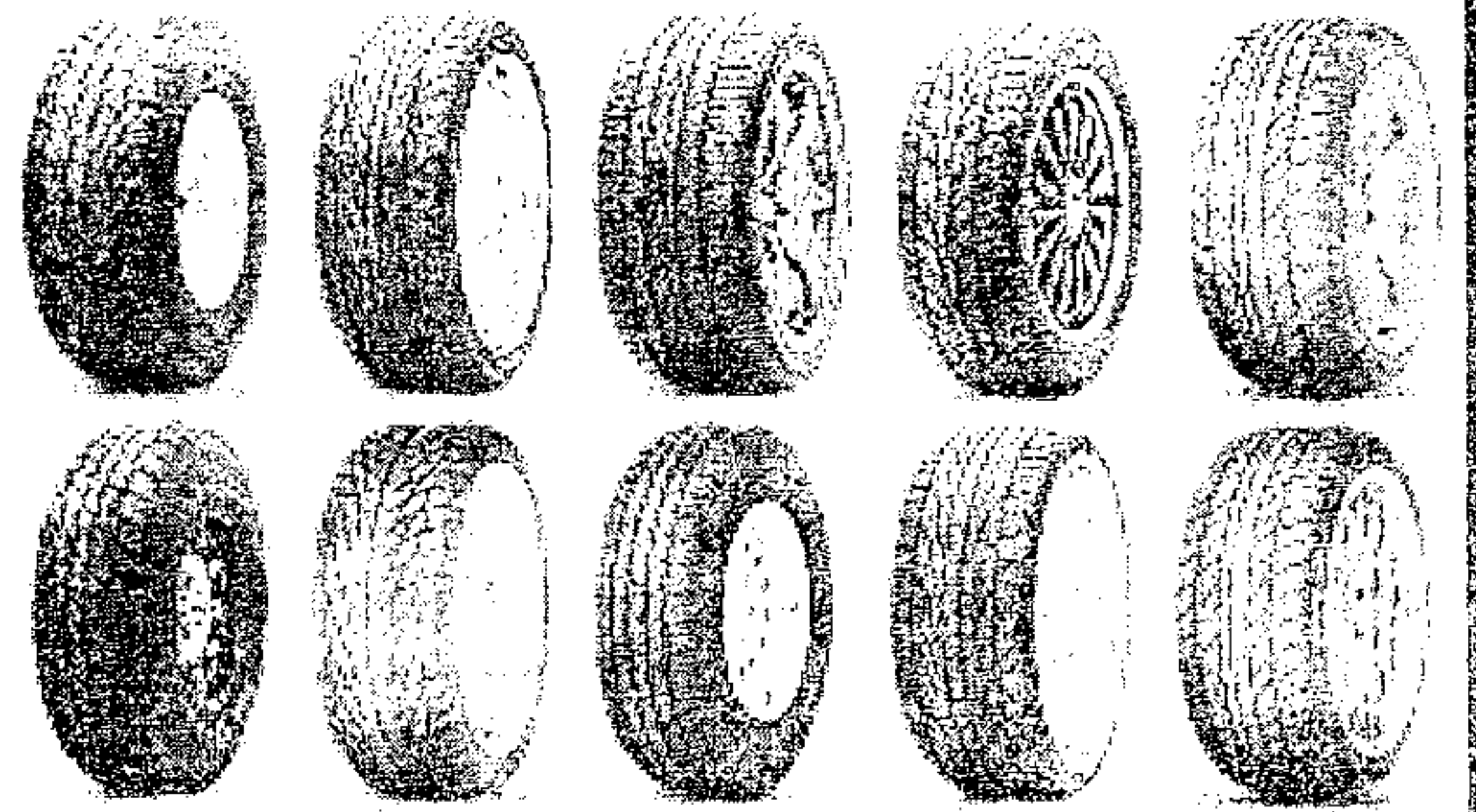
These services are provided to people of Monroe County who are experiencing a crises situation.
