

Ryan Rustad, 55, Hines Valley Road Lenoir City, was charged with Aggravated Assault.

Deputy Brandon Burley did respond with Deputies Smith, Wright and Hines Valley Hutchens to Road for the report of domestic violence. Upon arrival this Deputy did encounter Ryan Rustad in the living room of his residence and victim sitting on the stairs. While Deputies Smith and Vance spoke with Rustad this Deputy did speak with victim who stated there was a firearm that Rustad had pulled out on her and threatened to use upstairs.

Deputy Hutchens did locate on the bed, in the only bedroom, a loaded Ruger P95DC. This weapon did have the hammer cocked back, a round in the chamber and a magazine inserted. While speaking with victim this Deputy did observe her to have a deep laceration to the inside of her left knee, as well as marks on the right side of her face. Victim stated to EMS (Priority Ambulance Service) that she did loose consciousness for an unknown amount of time when she was being struck by

Rustad. Victim stated the injury to her knee came as a result of Rustad striking her with a barstool, which was observed to be broken in the corner of the living room and having blood on it.

Victim stated the marks on her face and the subsequent loss of consciousness came as a result of Rustad striking her only after Rustad went into the bedroom, unlocked his gun safe (Rustad is the only person with access to the safe) removed the pistol and pointed it at her. Victim was transported by EMS to Ft. Loudon E.R. where she received stitches and is undergoing a CAT scan for possible head trauma.
