The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$20,000 for information leading to the identification and arrest of the subjects who committed these violent crimes.

On April 28, 2015, at approximately 8:15 a.m., a Y-12 Federal Credit Union employee and his family were kidnapped from their residence and held hostage at gunpoint. While the family was held hostage, the employee was coerced to attempt to remove money from the Y-12 Federal Credit Union, located at 501 Lafayette Drive, Oak Ridge, TN. After the robbery, the employee's family members were released unharmed at the Gettysvue Country Club parking lot in Knoxville, TN. The suspects fled and remain at large.


Mayor Buddy Bradshaw stated that the investiture of Judge Sledge "is an important historic even that will
