


n Oct. 3, 2016, Ricky Anthony Lanier, 49, and his wife Katrina Reshina Lanier, 43, both of La-Grange, N.C., were sentenced to serve federal prison terms of 48 months and 30 months, respectively, for conspiracy to commit wire fraud, wire fraud, and major fraud against the United States. The couple were found guilty of these offenses on Dec. 17, 2015, following a 13-day jury trial in U.S. District (see stop pg. 7) Court.
