In addition to their prison sentences, Carvaial was ordered to forfeit a residence in Loudon, \$376,152 in seized funds and received a money judge-ment against him for \$7,859,000. Valdez-Morales was ordered to forfeit \$630 in cash seized by federal investigators and received a money judgement against him in the amount of \$2.5 million. He will also be subject to deportation to Honduras upon his release

from prison.

The offenses of Carvajal and Valdez-Morales were part of a scheme that involved the use of phony identification documents for the submission of fraudulent federal income tax returns in order to obtain refundable tax credits. The scheme resulted in the theft of more \$10.8 million from the U.S. taxpayers. Other who were previously sentenced for their roles in these conspiracies included: husband and wife Bertha Del Pilar Vargas, 48, and Martin Ayala, 45, both of Knoxville, Tenn.; Mayra Edith Blair, 41, of Knoxville, Tenn.; and Nery Irrael Grande-Jinenez, of Durham, N.C.

Agencies involved in this investigation included the Internal Revenue Service, Homeland Security Investigations, U.S. Postal Inspection Service, and Tennessee Highway Patrol Identity Crimes Unit. Assistant U.S. Attorneys Frank M. Dale, Jr. and Jennifer Kolman represented the United States.


