


## Jefferson County Audit Reveals Theft from Planning and Zoning Office

The Comptroller's annual audit of Jefferson County government, released today, includes three findings, one of which describes a \$21,752 theft from the Planning and Zoning Office.

Last month, former employee Rhonda Michelle Reece was indicted on one count of theft over \$10,000, one count of theft over \$1,000, and

Robert Heath London sentenced to 51 months for possession of child pornography

On Feb. 22, 2016, Robert Heath London, 43, of Rogersville,

Tenn., was sentenced by the Honorable J. Ronnie Greer, U.S. District Court Judge, to serve 51 months in federal prison for the possession of child pornography.

According to the plea agreement on file with the U.S. District Court Clerk, London downloaded child pornography via the internet at his home in

Rogersville from 2011 to mid-2015. Law enforcement officers found a total of 799 still images of child pornography on London's computer.

In addition to 51 months in prison, Judge Greer sentenced London to serve 10 years on federal supervised release with special sex offender conditions of release and to register as a convicted sex offender under Tennessee law.

Law enforcement agencies participating in this investigation include Hawkins County Sheriff's Office and Sullivan County Sheriff's Office. Assistant United States Attorney Helen Smith represented the United States.

This case was brought as part of Project Safe Childhood, a nationwide initiative to combat the growing epidemic of child sexual exploitation and abuse launched in May 2006 by the Department of Justice. Led by U.S. Attorneys' Offices and the Criminal Division's Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section, Project Safe Childhood marshals federal, state and local resources to better locate, apprehend and prosecute individuals who exploit children via the Internet, as well as to identify and rescue victims. four counts of official misconduct.

Comptroller auditors were first alerted to this issue by officials from Jefferson County after a citizen received a past-due notice for his adequate facilities tax – a bill which the citizen could prove he had already paid.

Jefferson County's finance director, with assistance from the Comptroller's office, performed an internal review of the receipts and deposits of the Planning and Zoning Office and found the problem was more widespread.

The internal re-

view determined that \$21,752 in adequate facilities tax and building permit collections were unaccounted for. These unaccounted for collections were for the period September 2013 through June 2015.

The district attorney general was notified of the shortage, and the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation conducted an investigation, resulting in the charges against Ms. Reece.

by segregating money handling duties within its Planning and Zoning Office," said Comptroller Justin P. Wilson. "The county finance director has indicated that this weakness has been corrected, and steps are being taken to recover the cash shortage."
